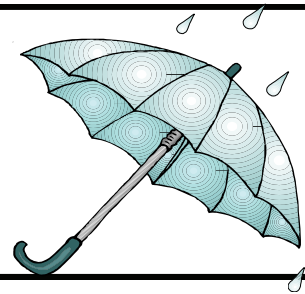

The hard work of our faculty scholars is evidenced by the over \$6 million in awards reported in this bulletin. April has also provided additional excitement for UNO and our faculty recipients of prestigious research and creative activity awards. Professor Michael Bishop of the Department of Geography/Geology won UNO's Distinguished Research and Creative Activity award for his globally recognized research in the assessment of mountain terrain and glaciers. The winner of this year's University of Nebraska system-wide Outstanding Research and Creative Activity Award is Professor G. J. de Vreede of the College of Information Science and Technology. Professor de Vreede's research into collaboration has earned an international reputation and is a pillar of UNO's unique Center for Collaboration Science. Congratulations to both Michael and G.J.!
