## INTRODUCTION

The purpose of the compilation of statistical data offered here is to present an accurate enumeration of enrollment patterns as they exist as of Fall 1972.

Over the past several years many changes have occurred in the structure of school enrollments. This is due to the decreasing birth rates that have been evidenced and also a variety of other factors including annexation. Commensurate with these changes the cost of education has continued to climb and is an issue of great importance to the public. Hopefully, through the presentation of annual research such as this an adequate level of public information concerning educational patterns can be maintained.

The data presented are divided into two sections. The first section concerns itself with elementary and secondary enrollments in the Omaha SMSA including basic information on "dropouts". The second section concentrates on higher education at both the Omaha SMSA and state levels and focuses on enrollment patterns and degrees conferred. The data provided in this report is presented as public information and the Center for Applied Urban Research accepts responsibility for its accuracy.

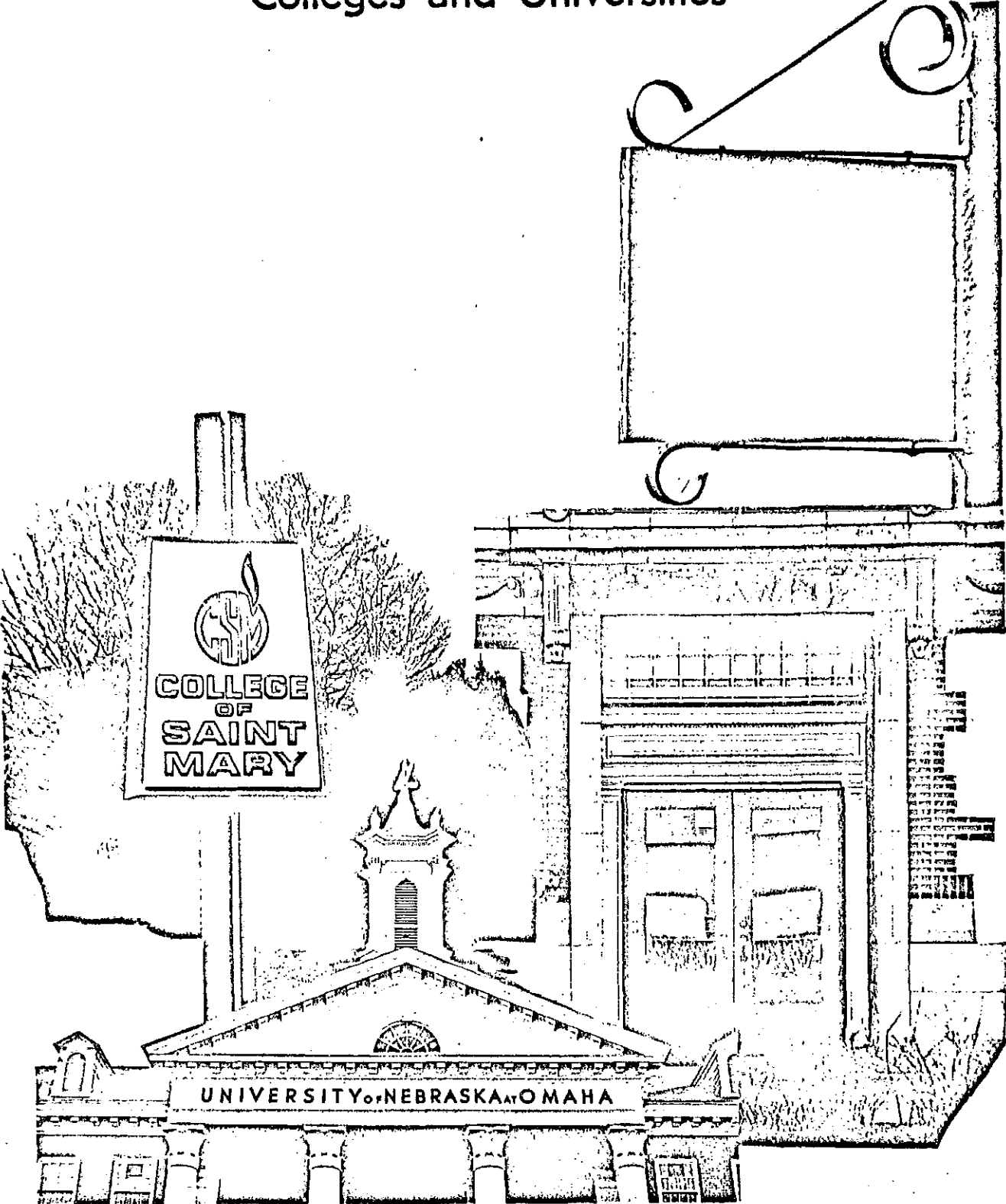

# Colleges and Universities



SUMMARY

Fall term 1972 total enrollment at 29 reporting collegiate institutions in Nebraska was 63,841 students. This is a decrease in enrollments of 1,092 or 1.7 percent from last fall, and there was no change in the number of collegiate institutions operating in the state. The distribution of enrollments as compared to fall term 1971 is shown below.

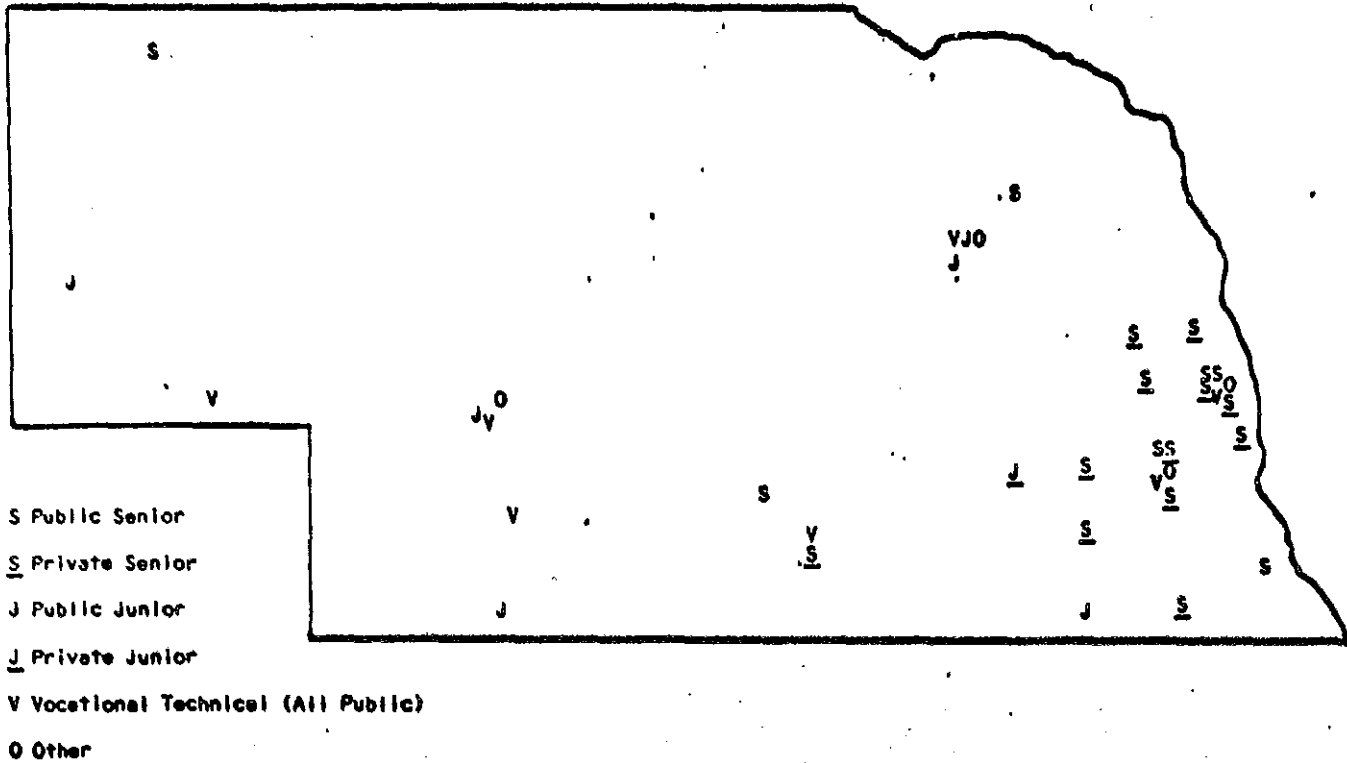
Enrollment in public-supported institutions equaled 50,152 students or 78.6 percent of the total college enrollment in Nebraska.

First-time entering freshman enrollment for this fall totaled 19,317 students, an increase of 5,234 students or 37.2 from fall 1971. First-time enrollments were distributed as follows.
