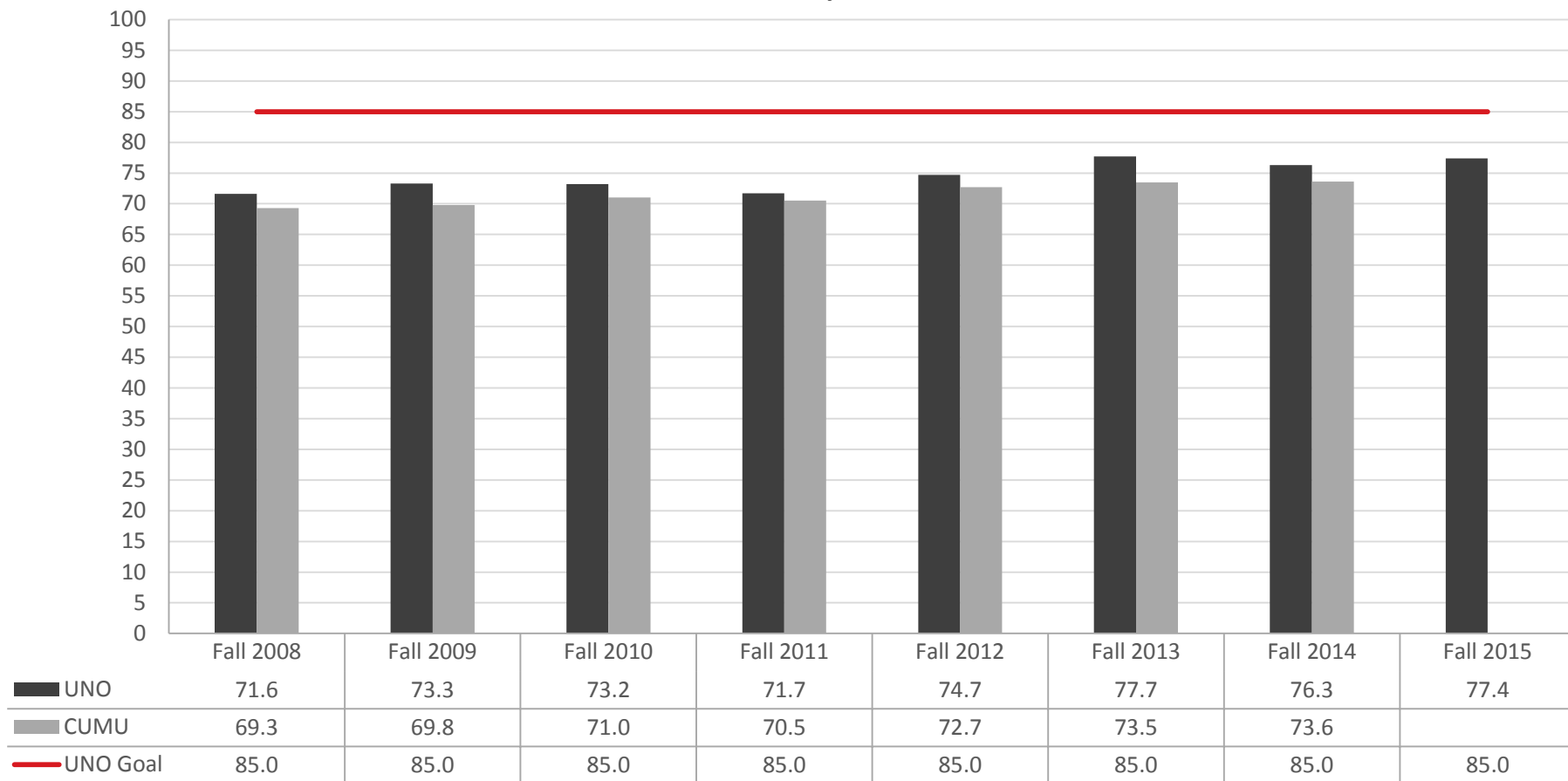

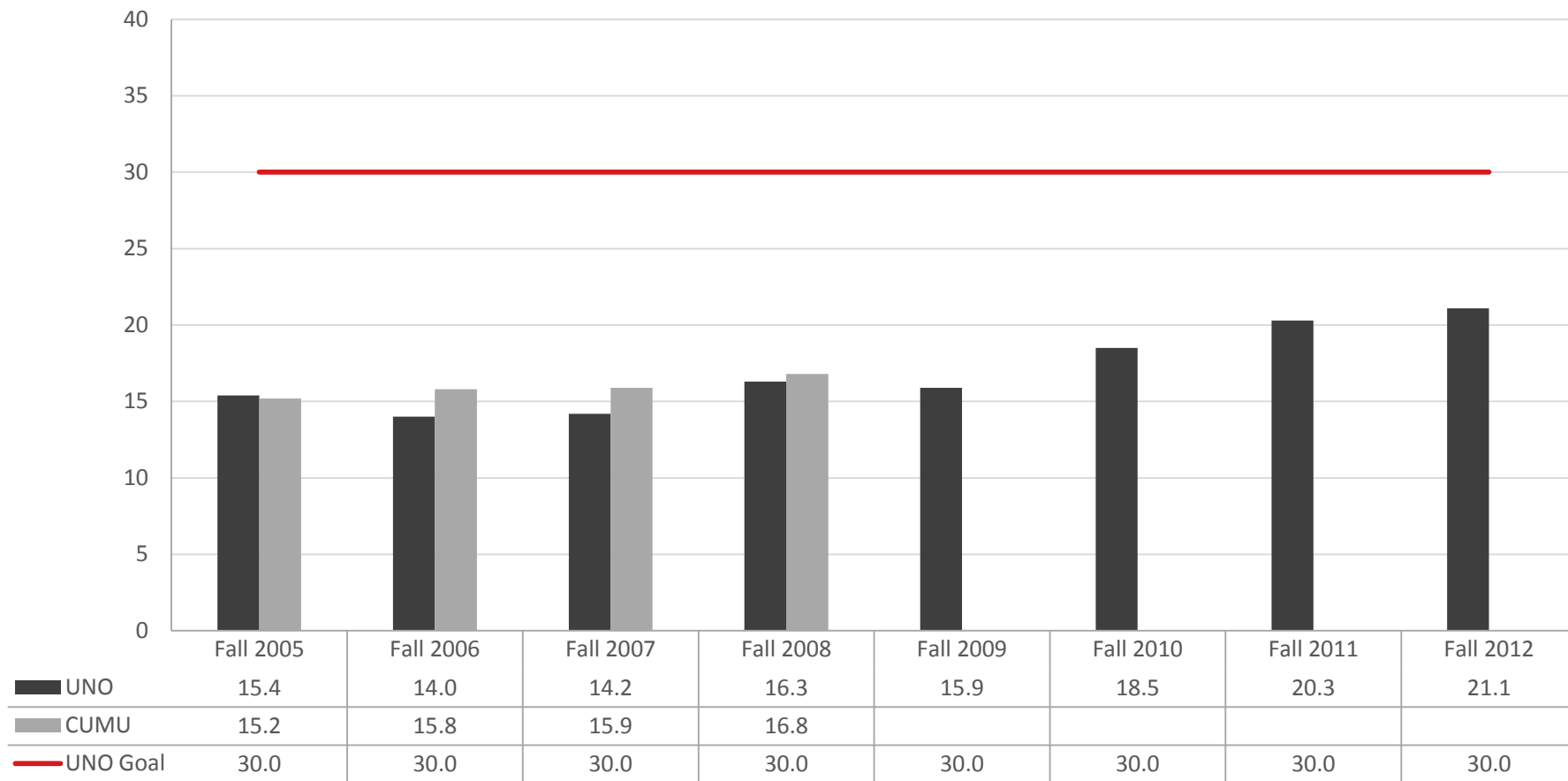

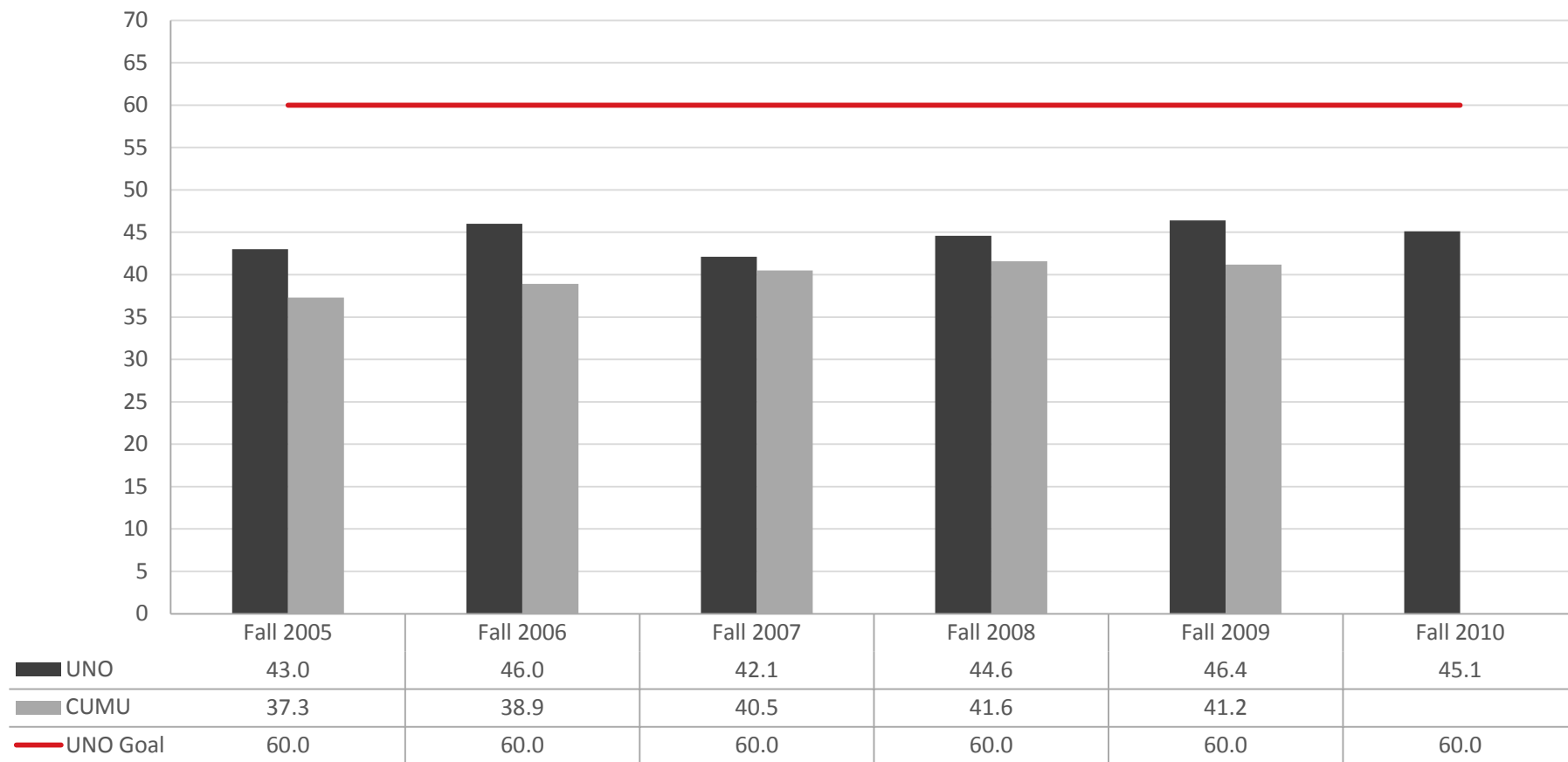

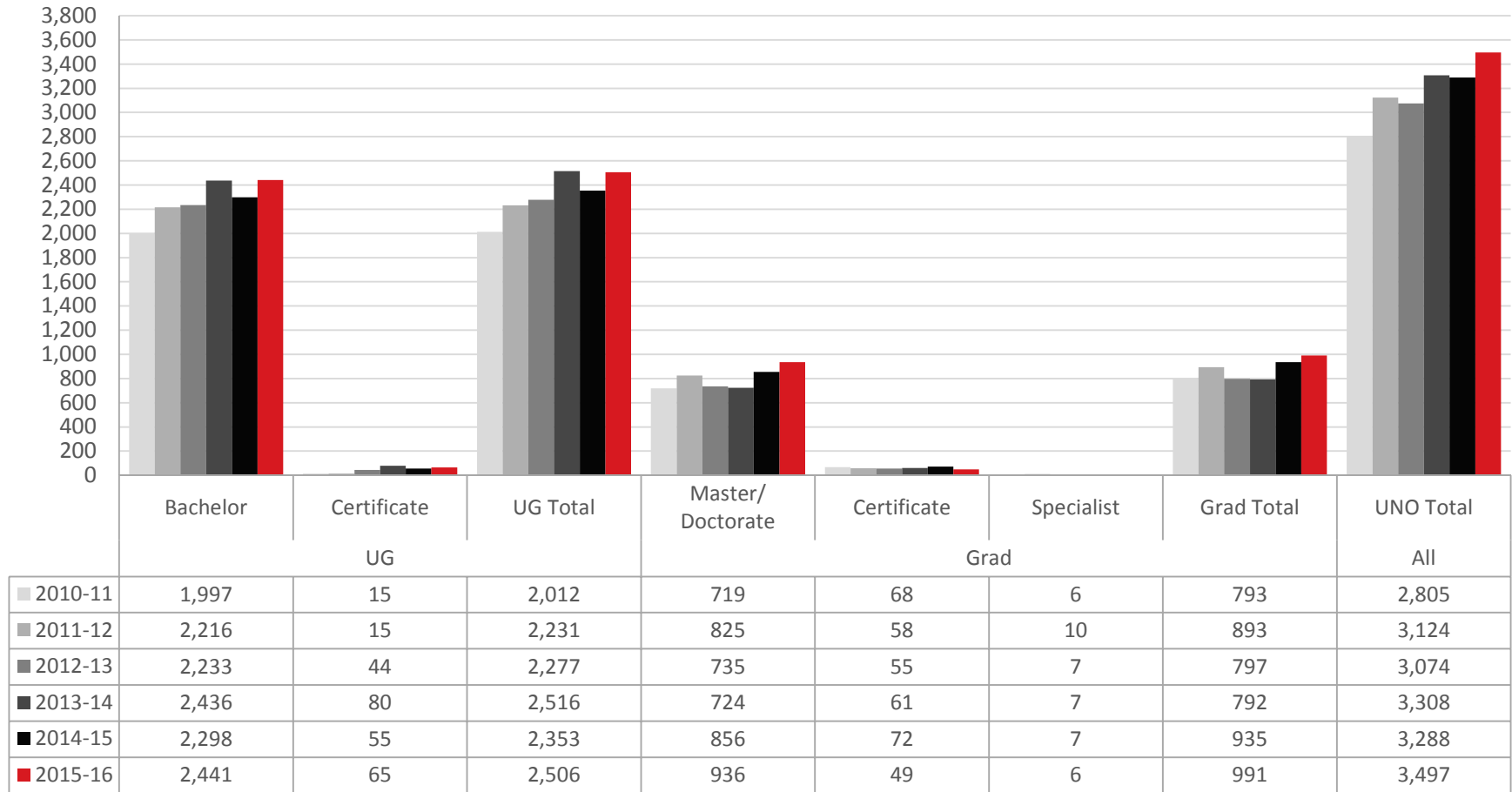

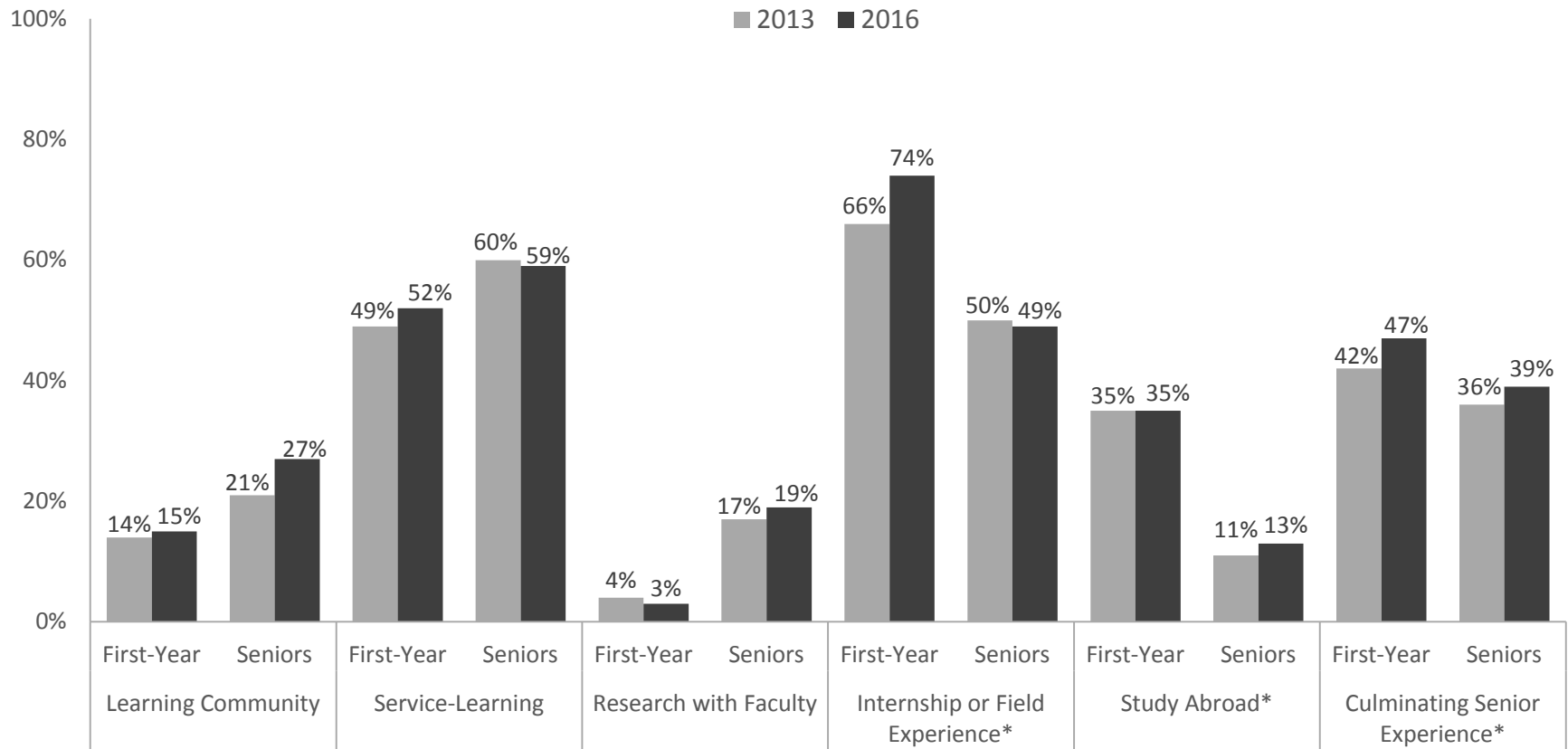

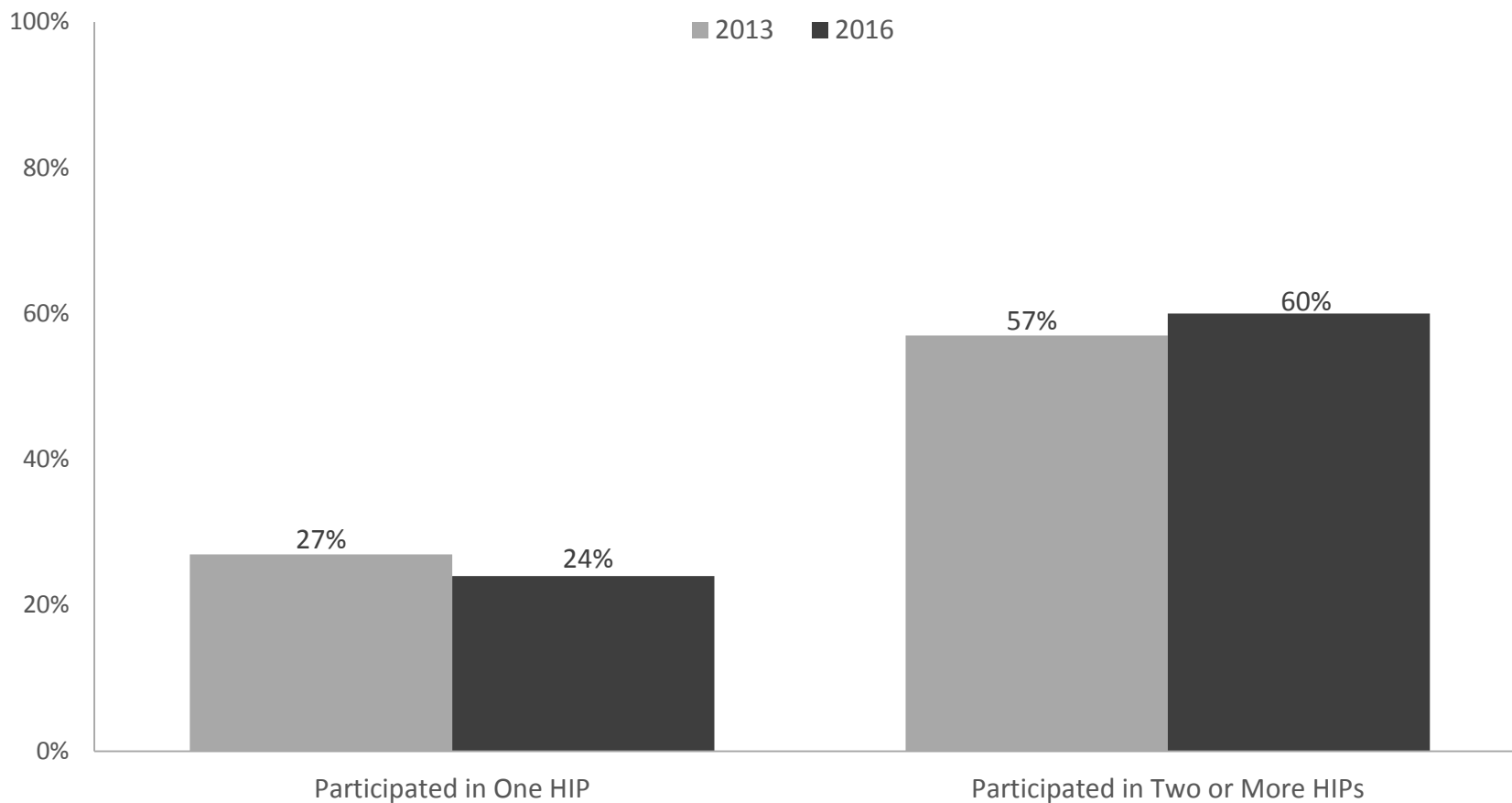

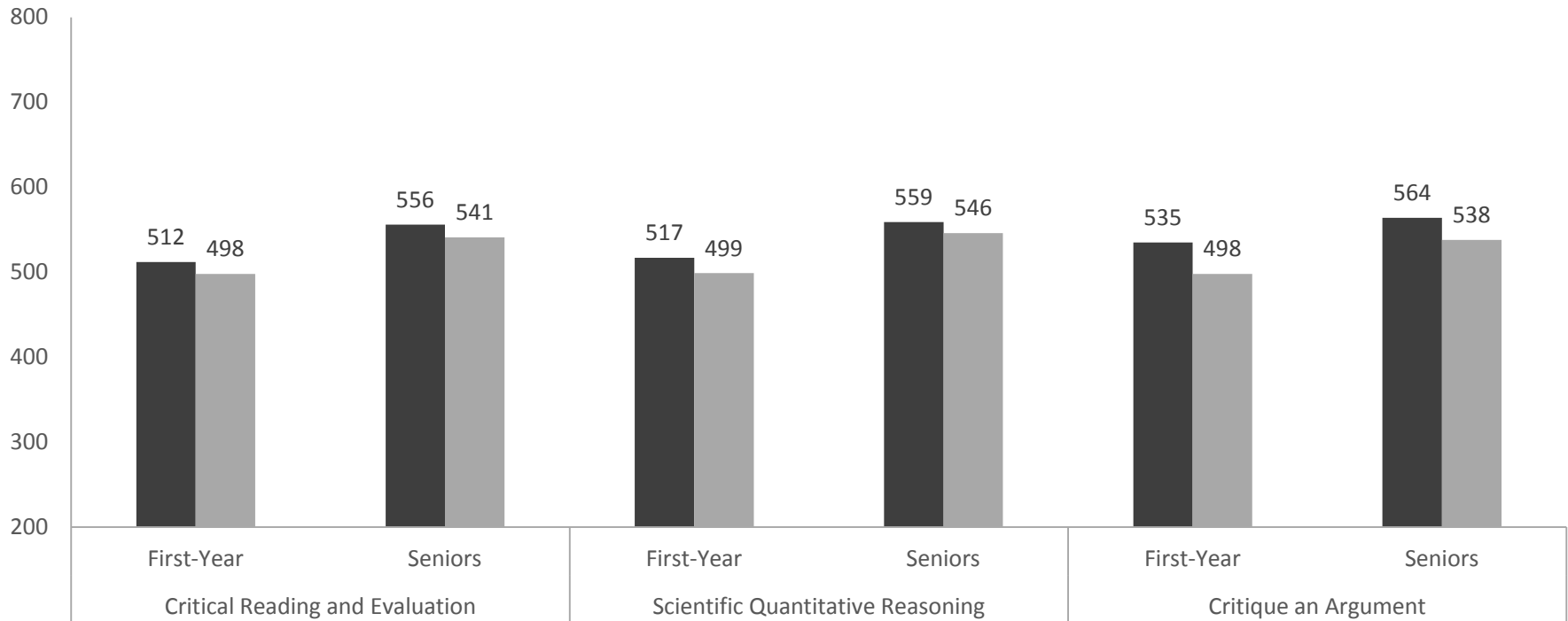

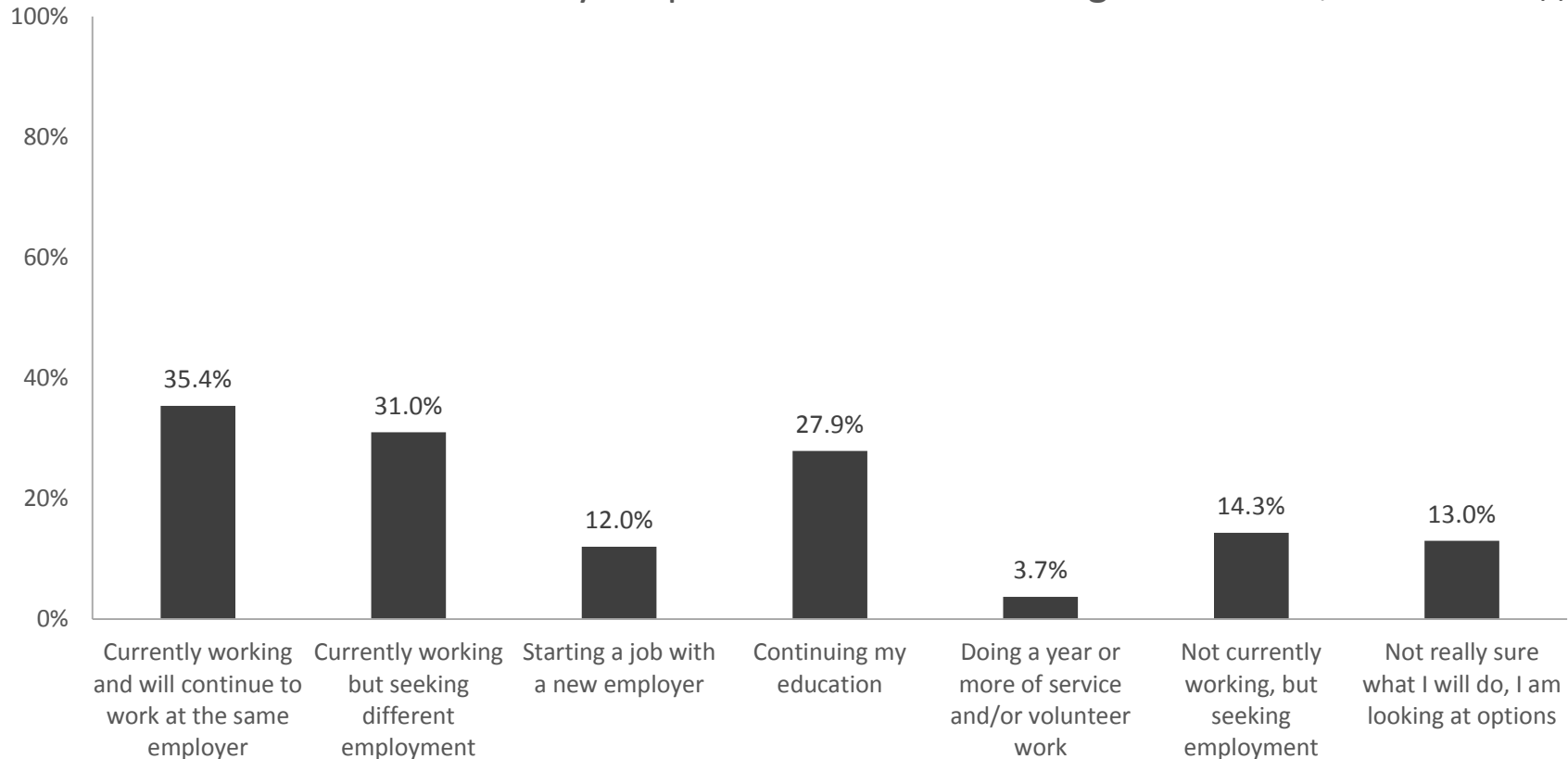

Which best describes your plans or situation after graduation? (select all that apply)



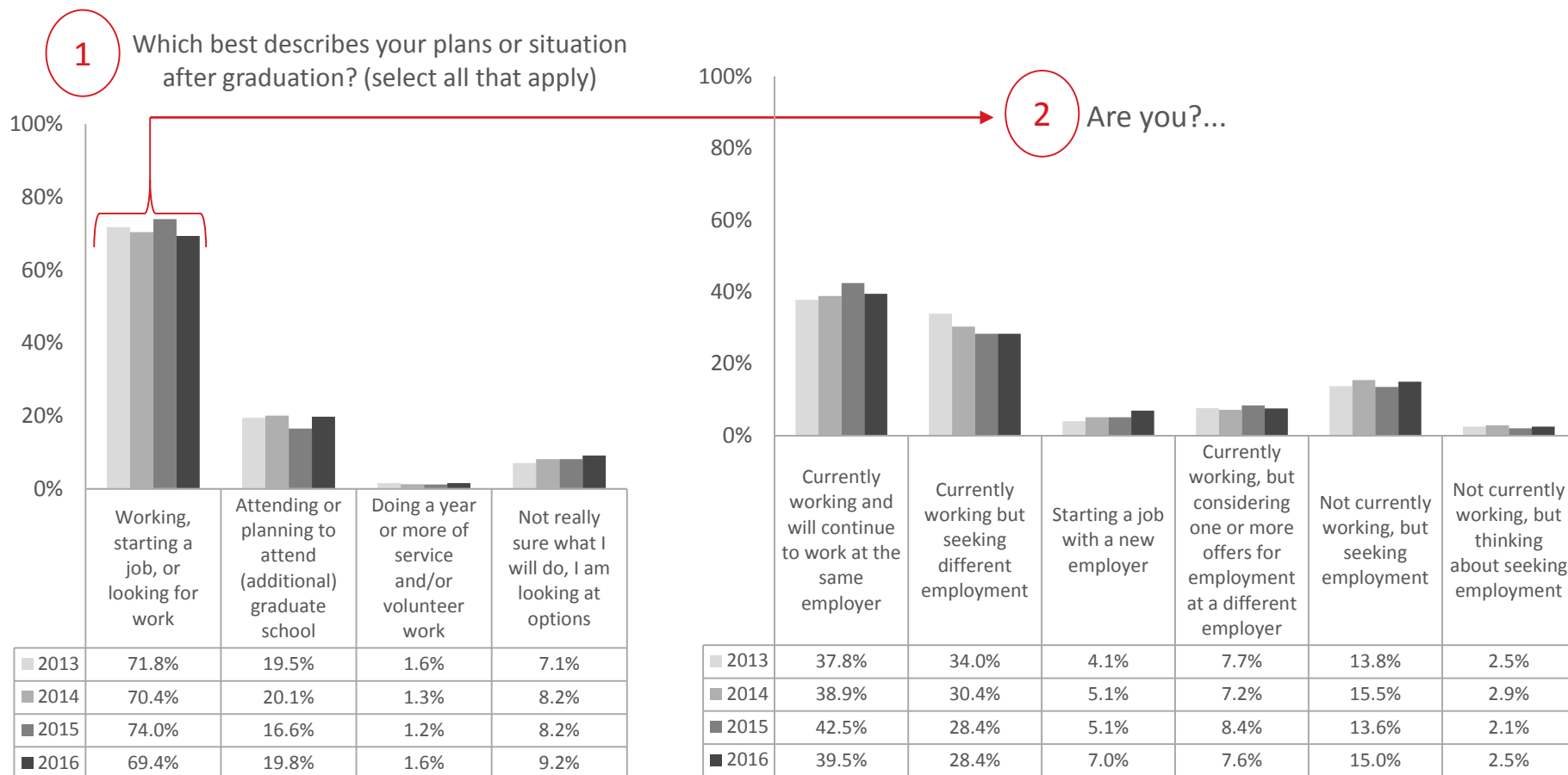

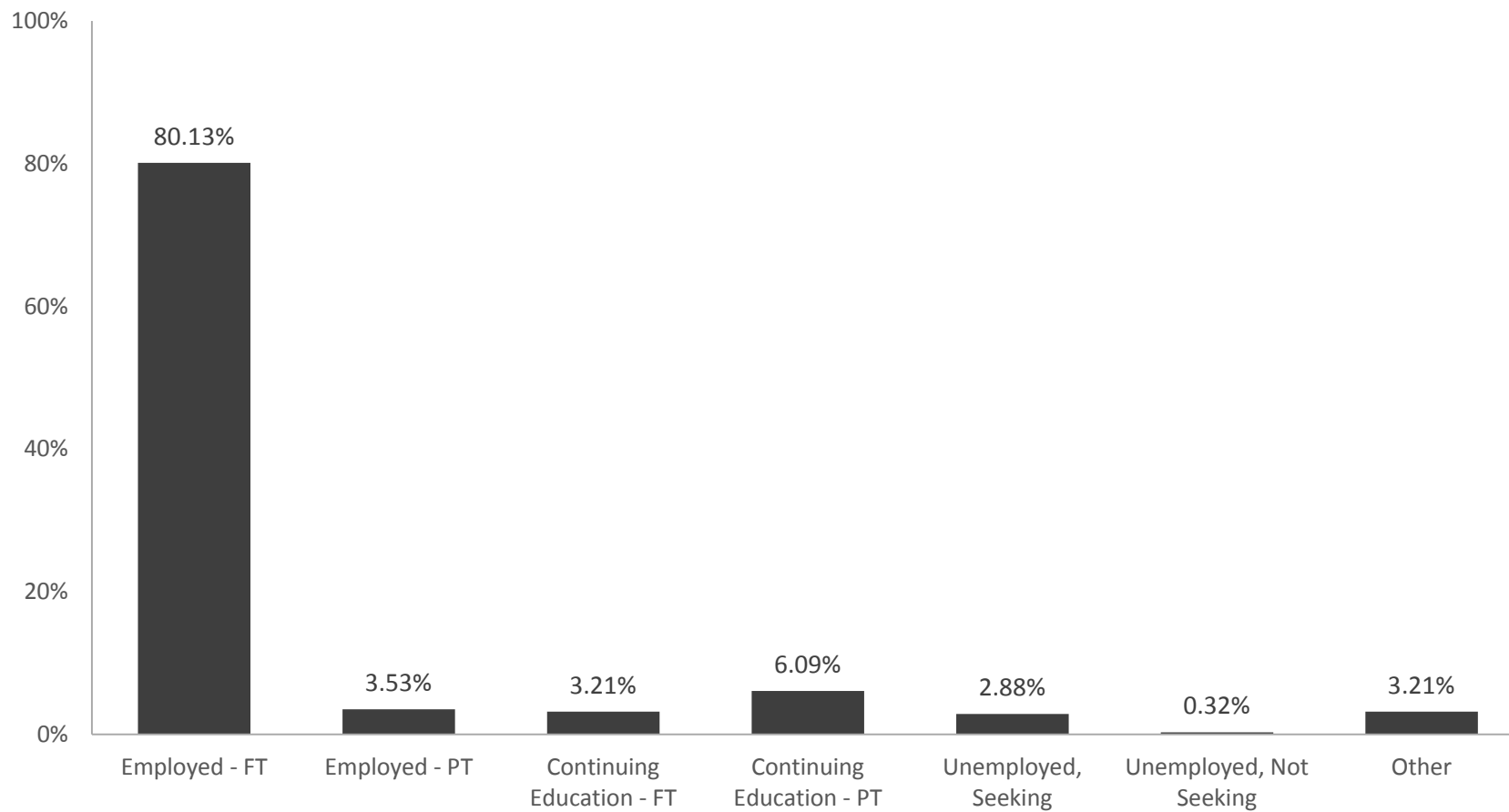

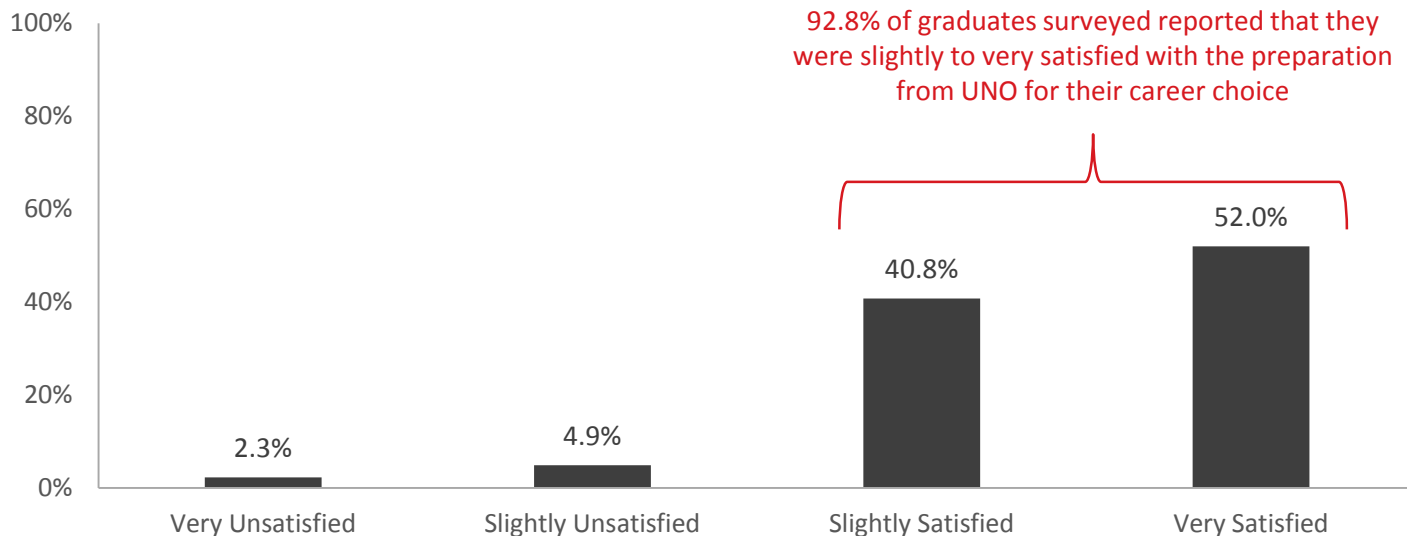

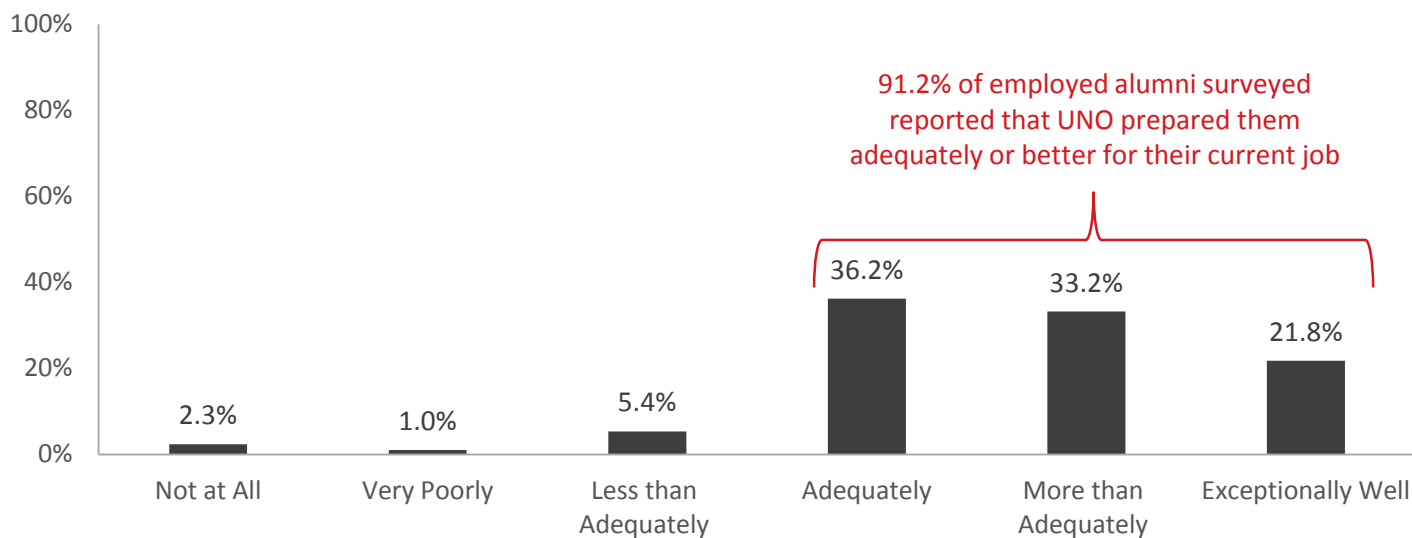

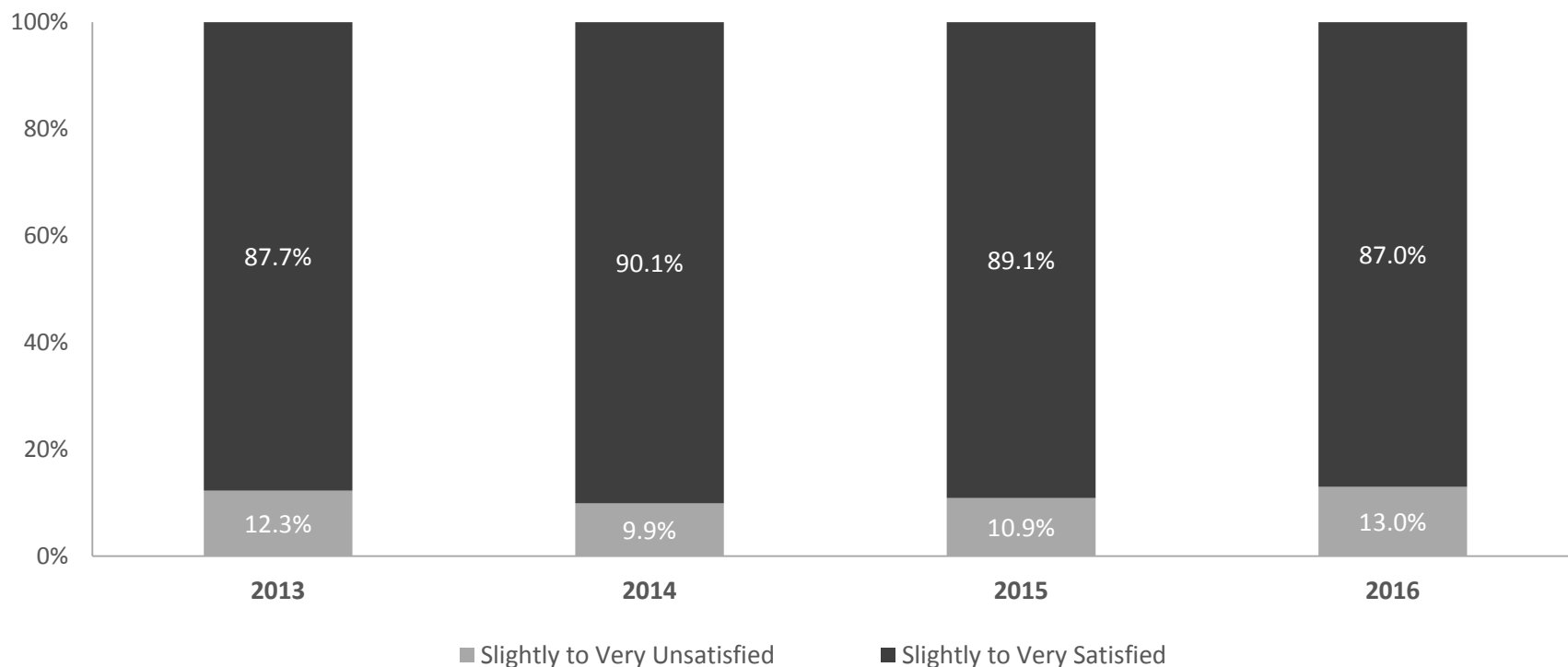

Based on your UNO experiences, how satisfied are you with your preparation for your work/career choice?



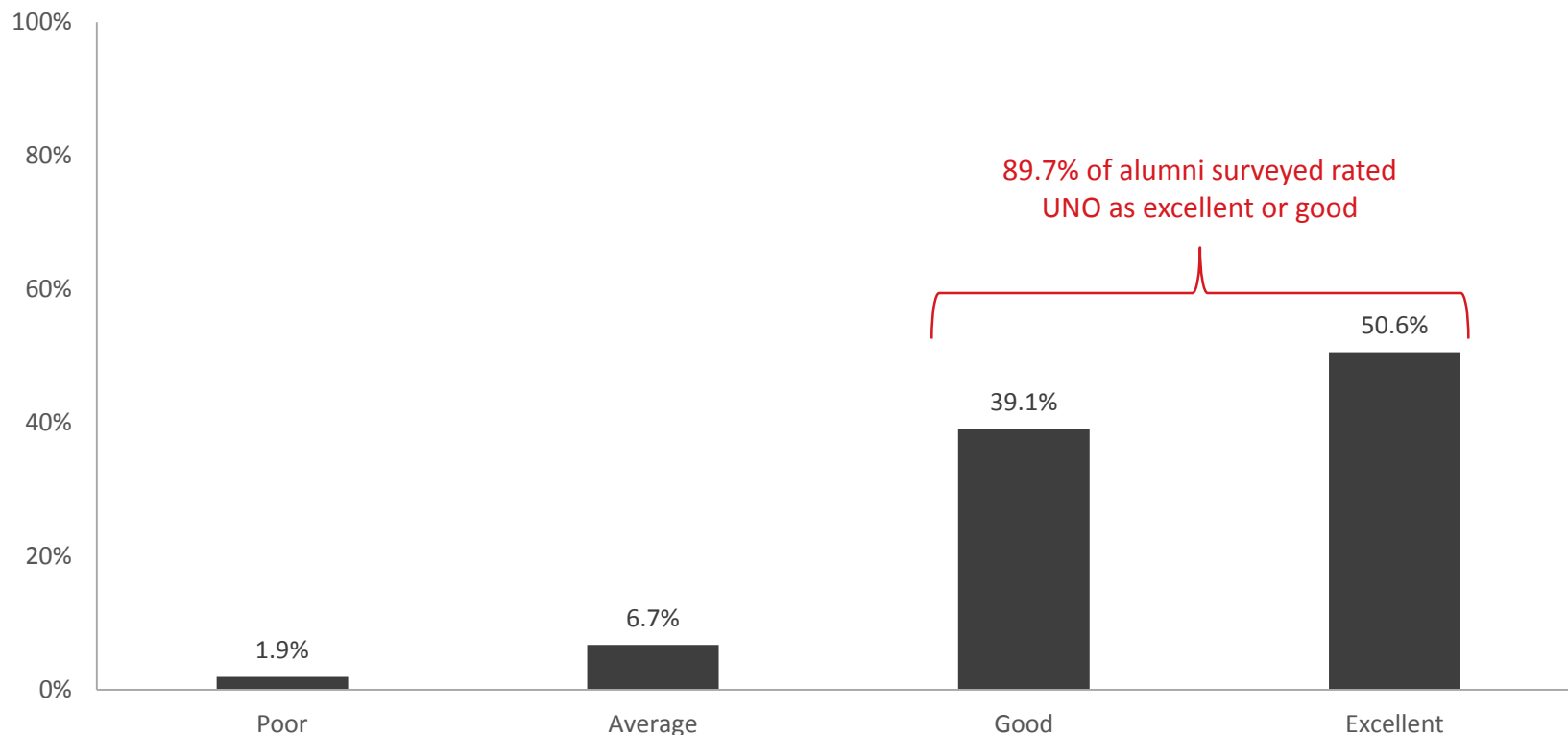
