





### 6-Year Completion Rates by Year: UNO vs. CUMU Peers







## UNO Students' Participation in High-Impact Practices (NSSE)



## Participation of UNO Seniors in High-Impact Practices (NSSE)













Which one of the following best describes your primary work status at this time?






## Post-Graduation Plans of Graduates (2013 - 2016)
