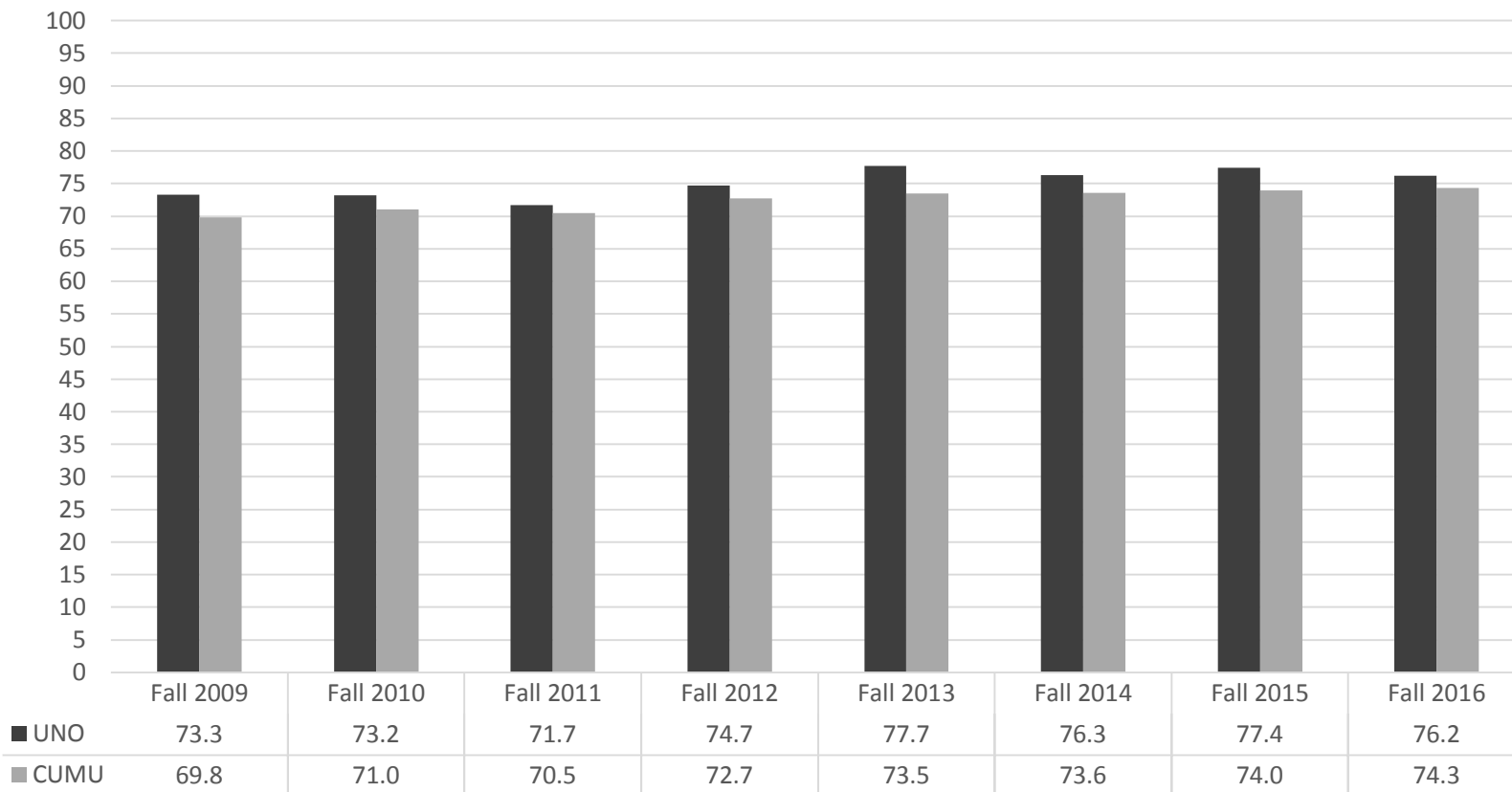

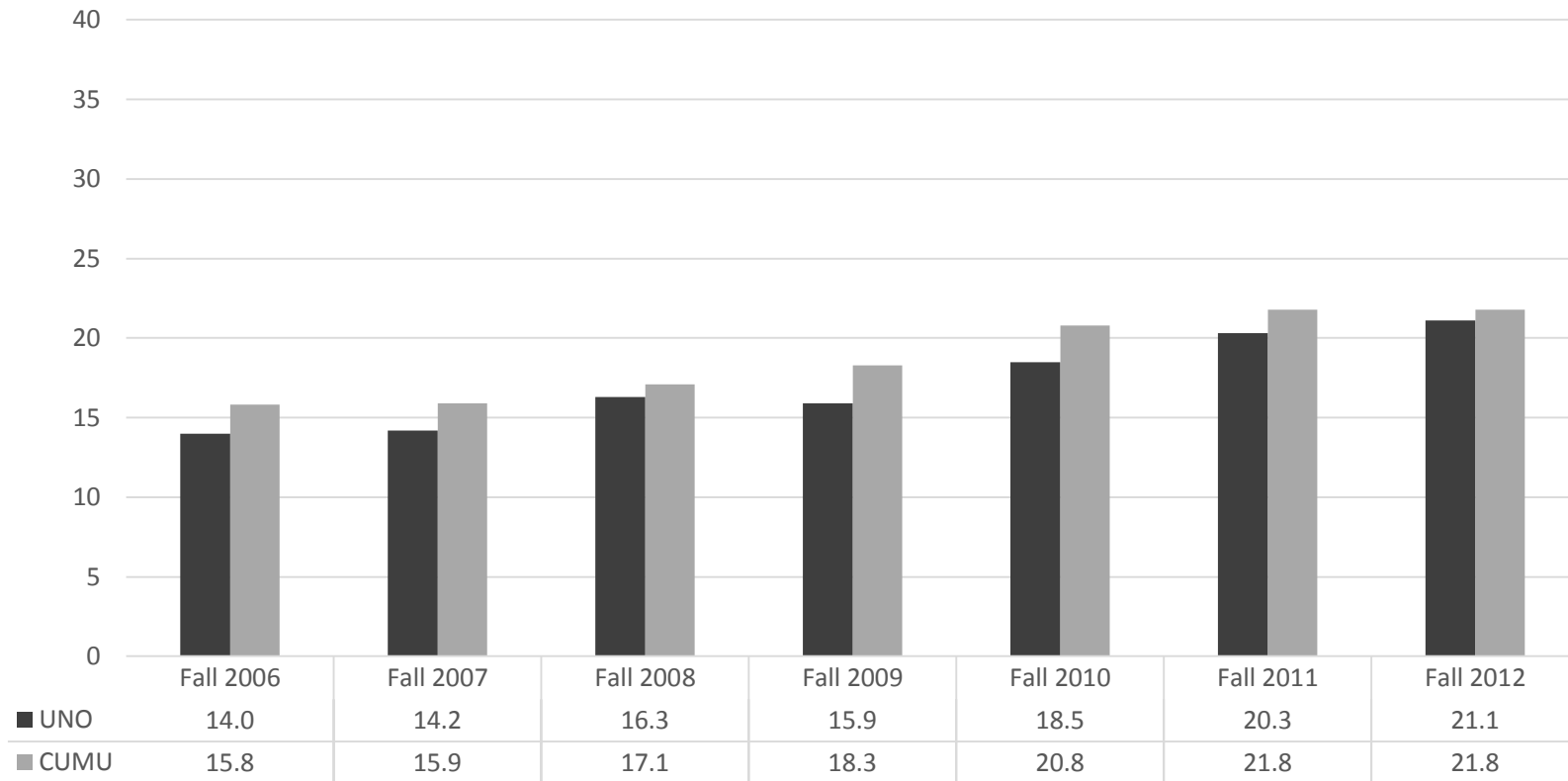

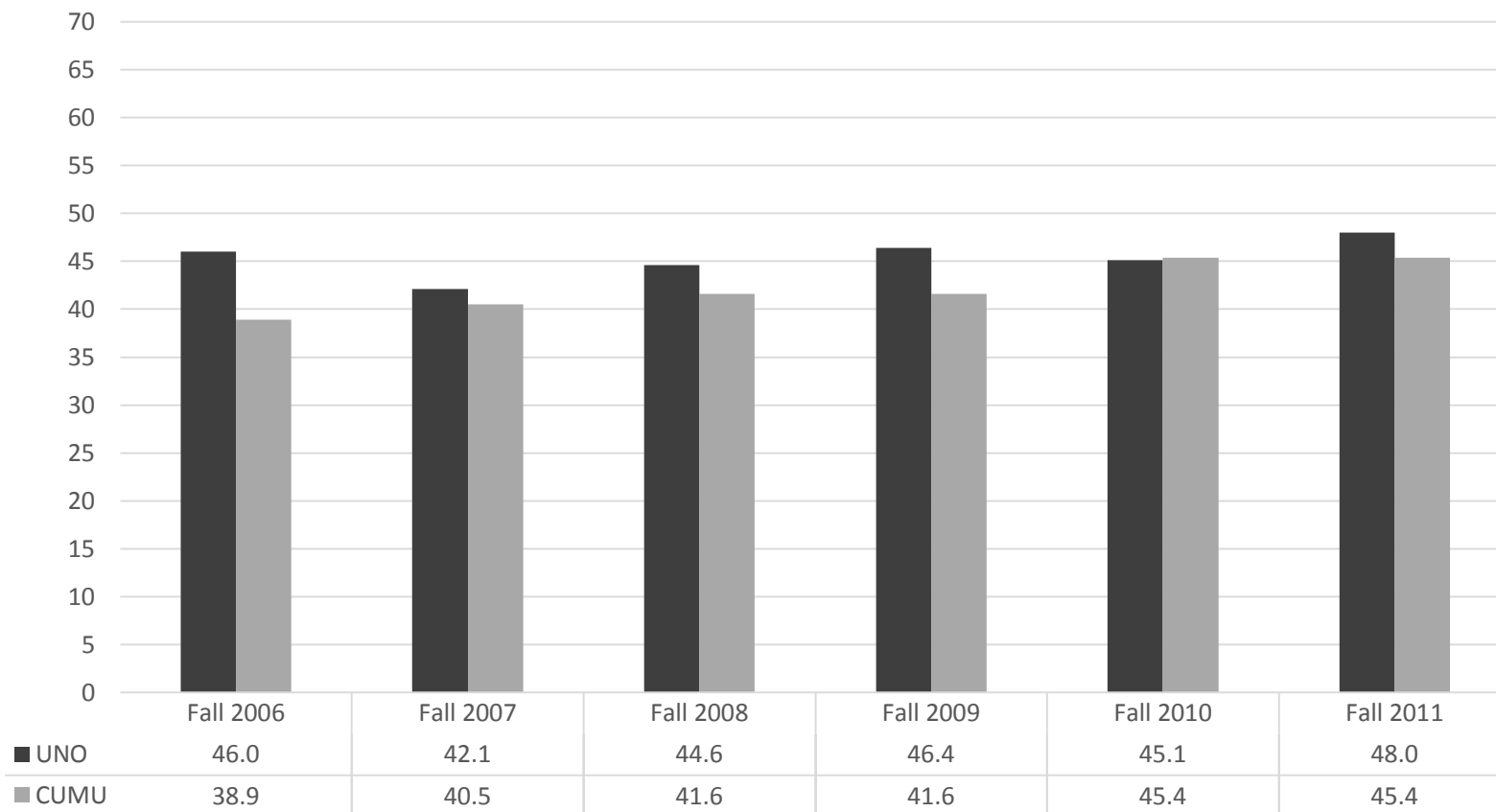

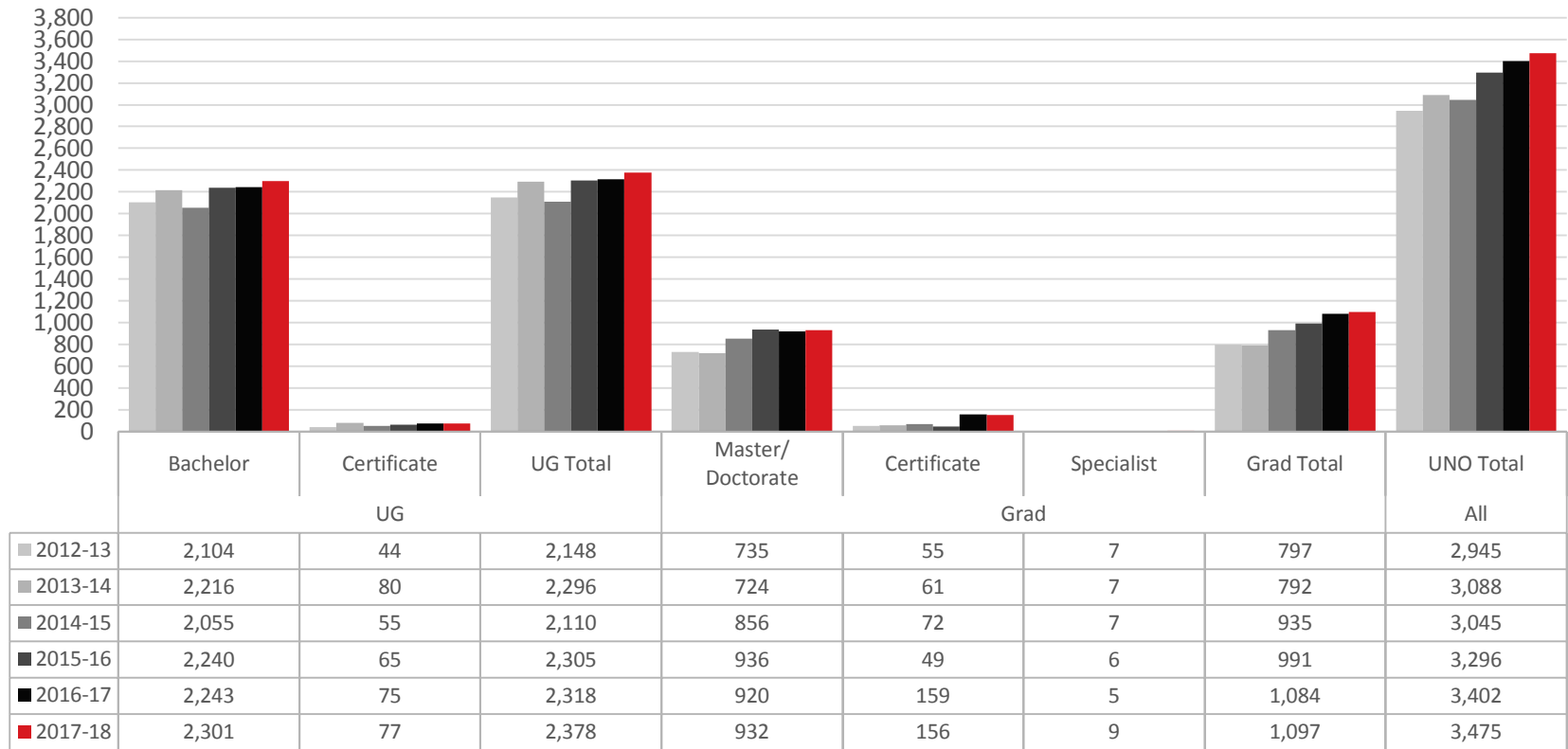

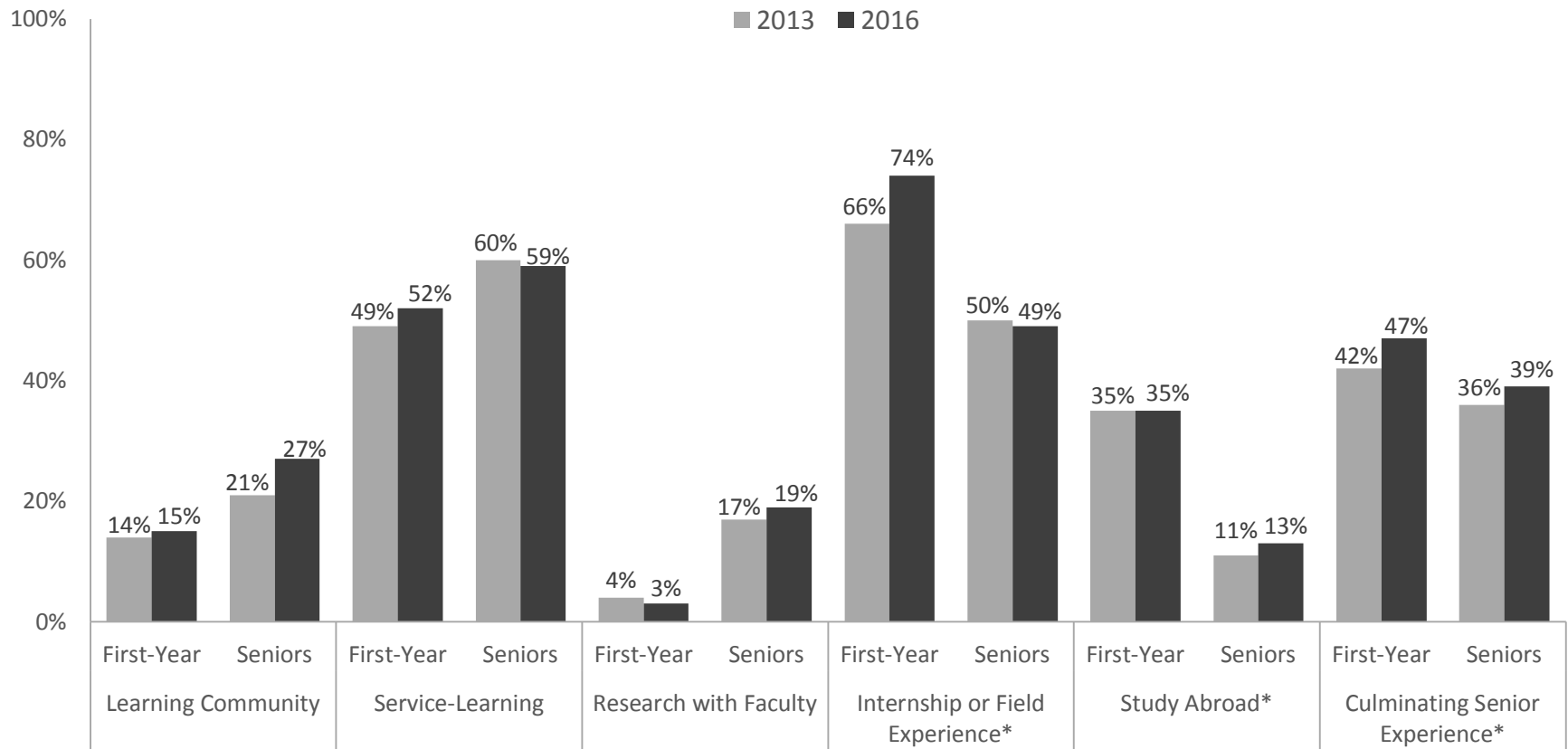

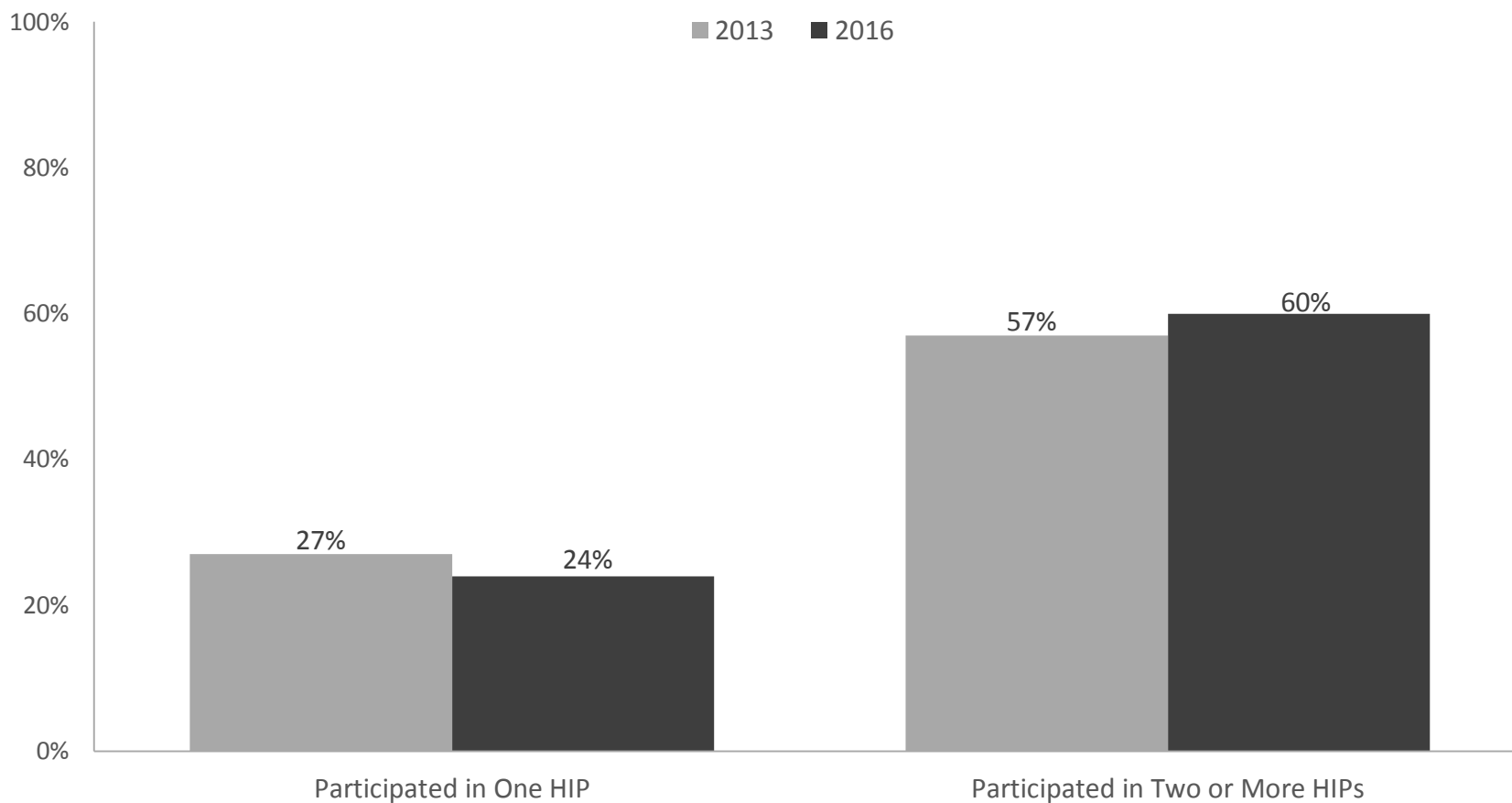

Participation of UNO Seniors in High-Impact Practices (NSSE)



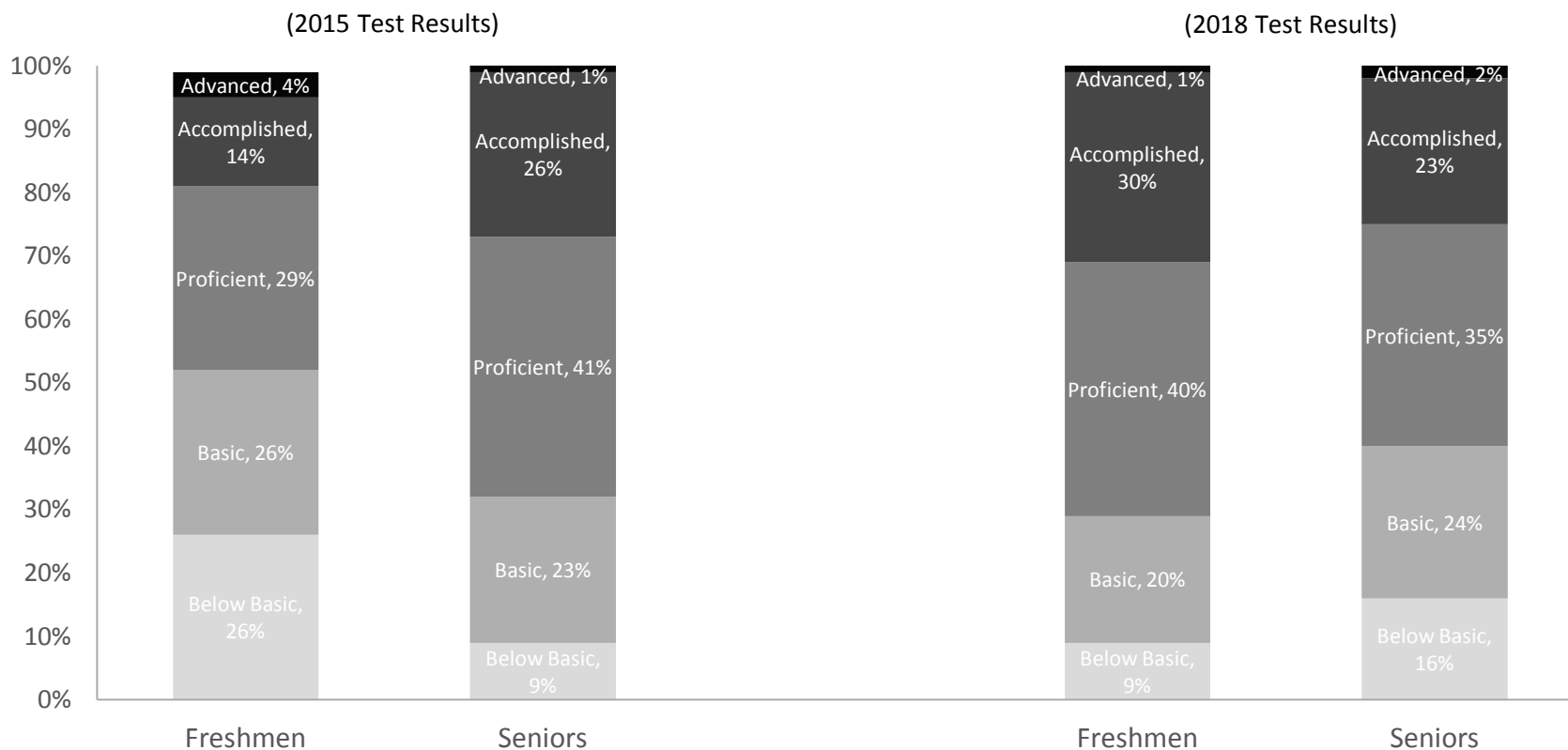

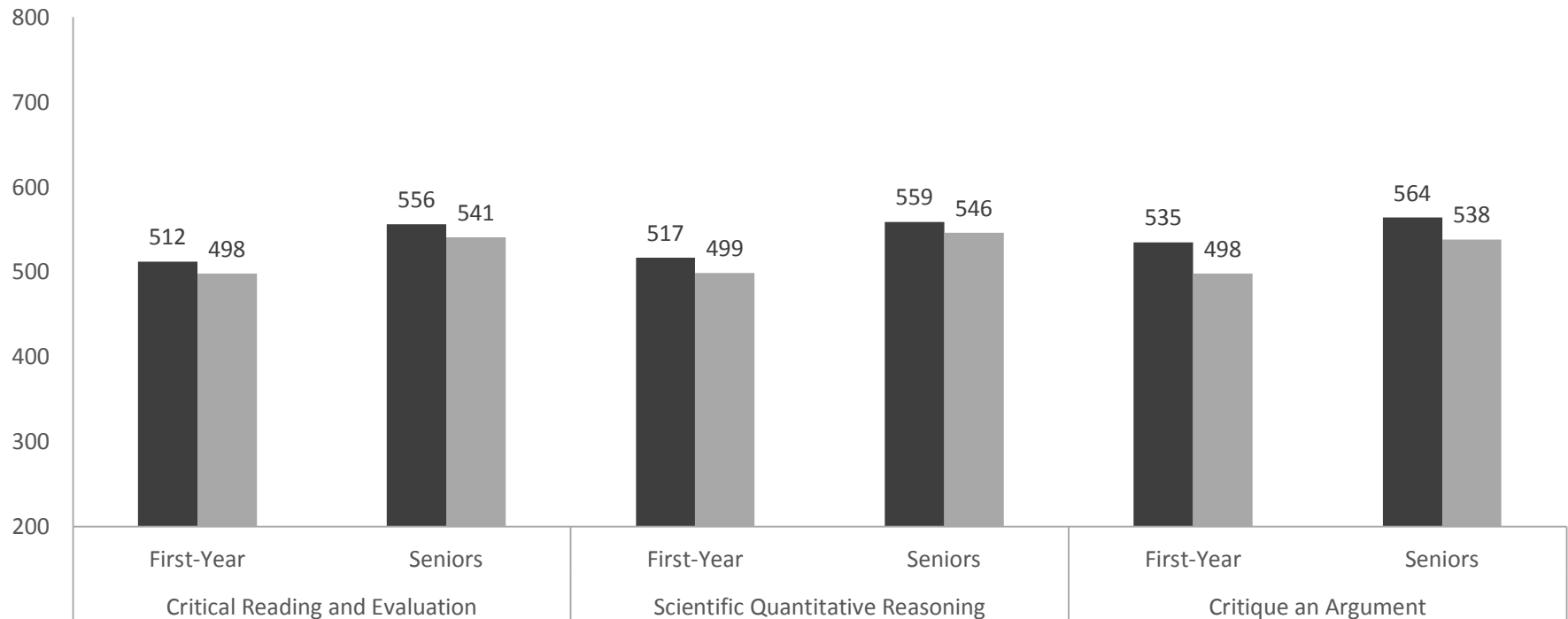

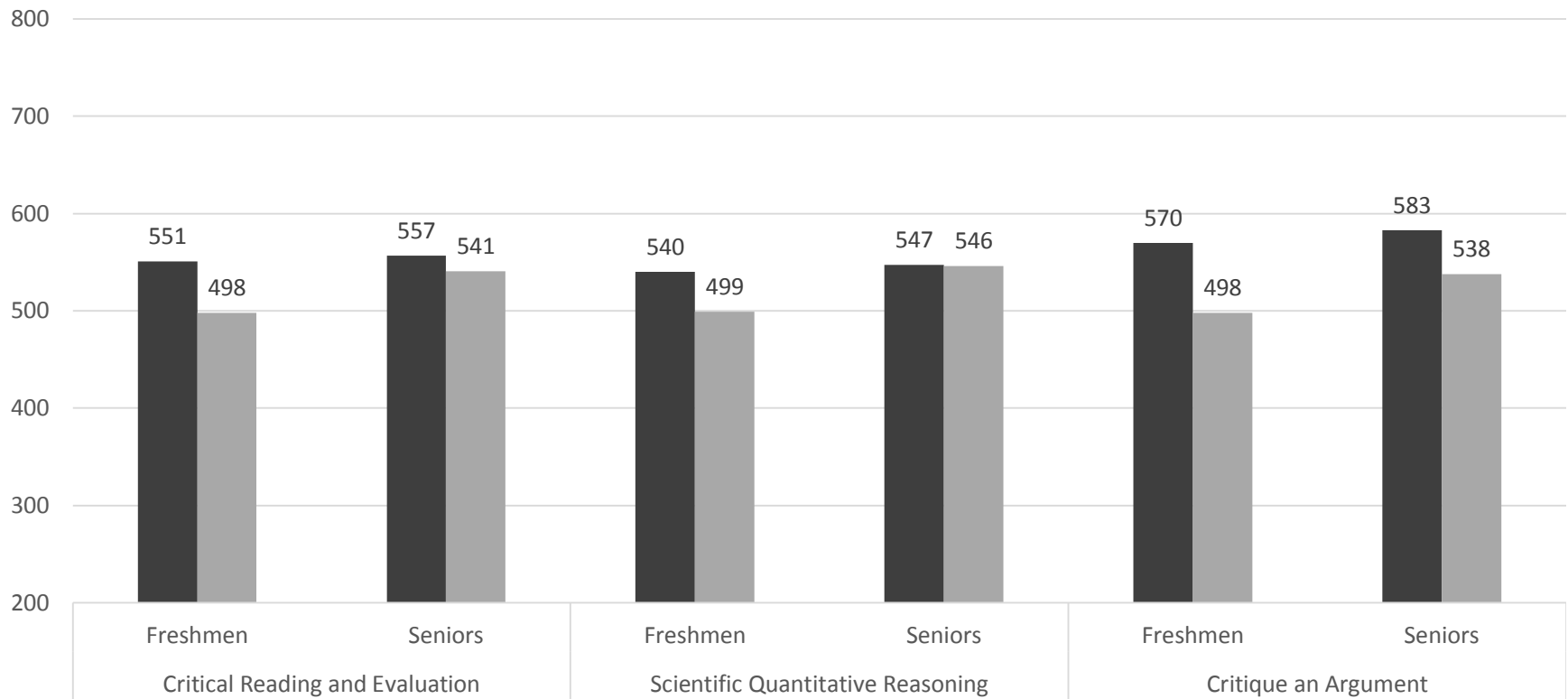

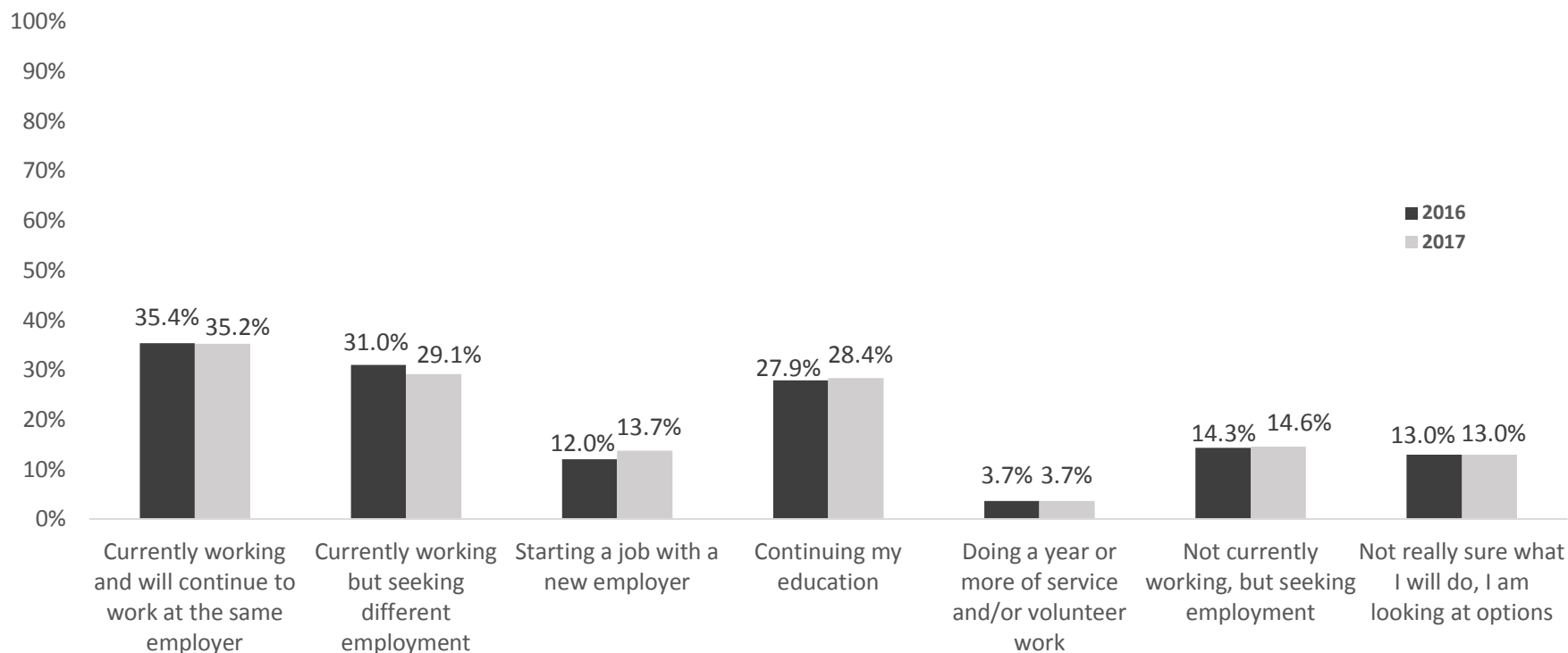

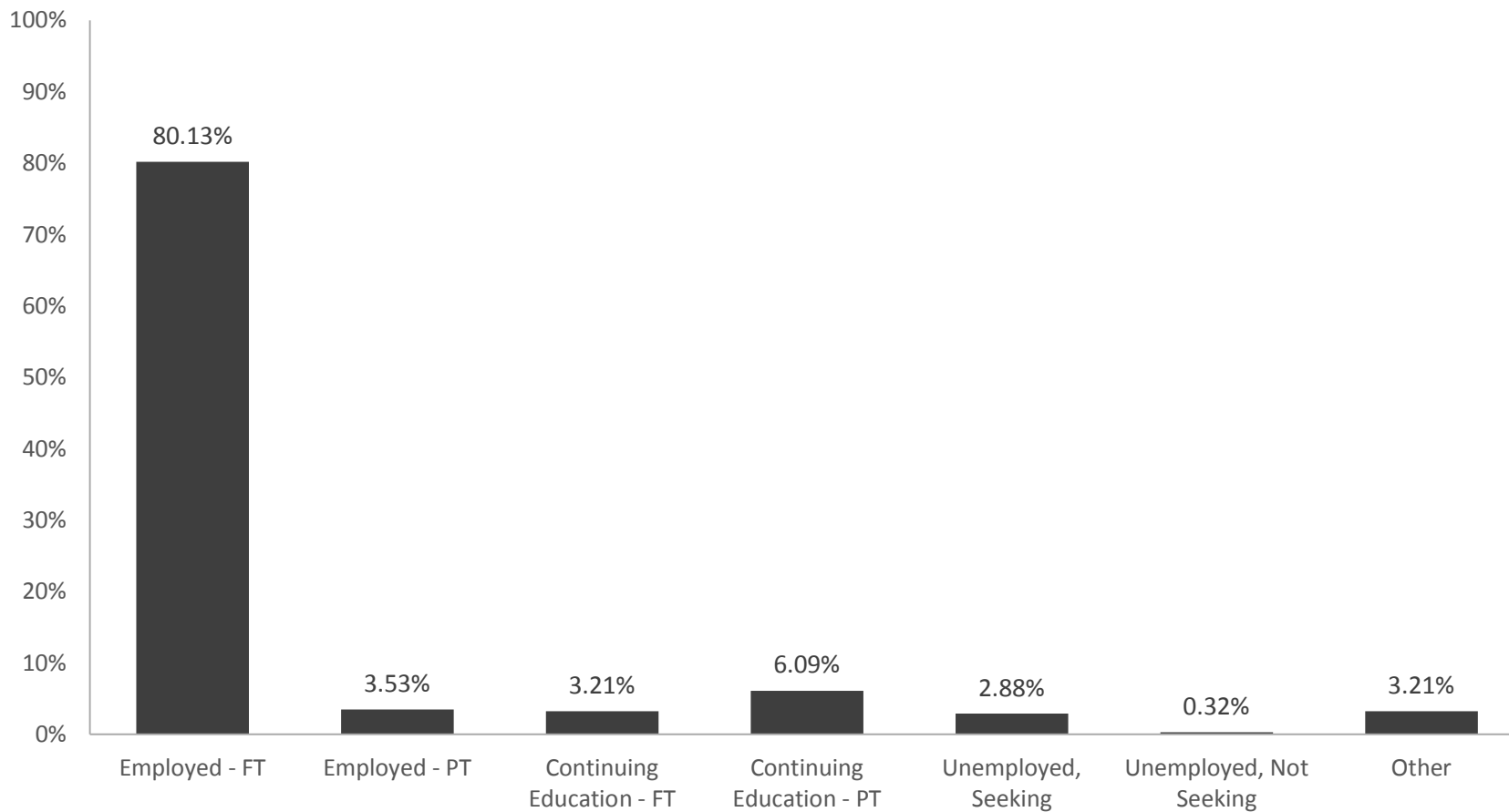

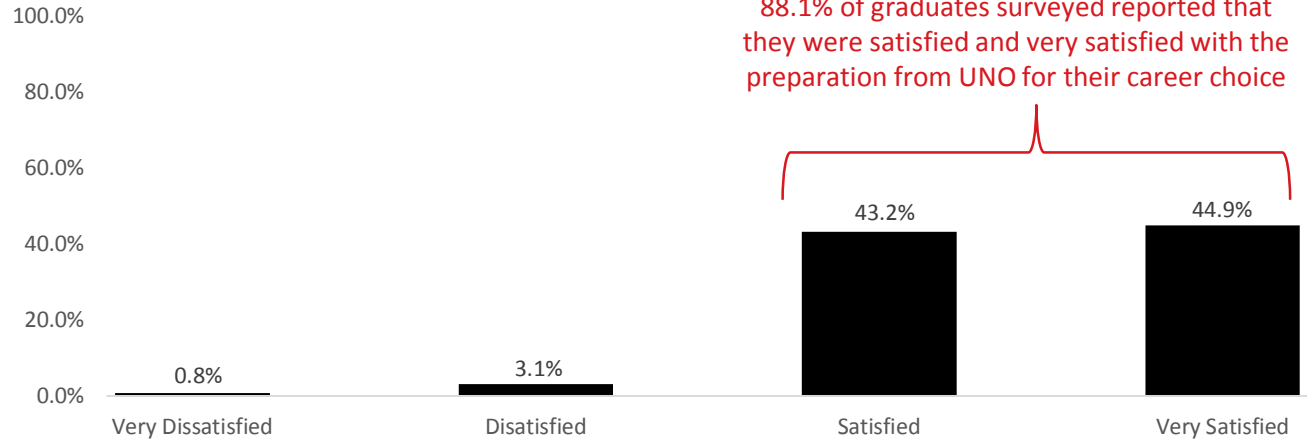

Based on your UNO experiences, how satisfied are you with your preparation for your work/career choices?

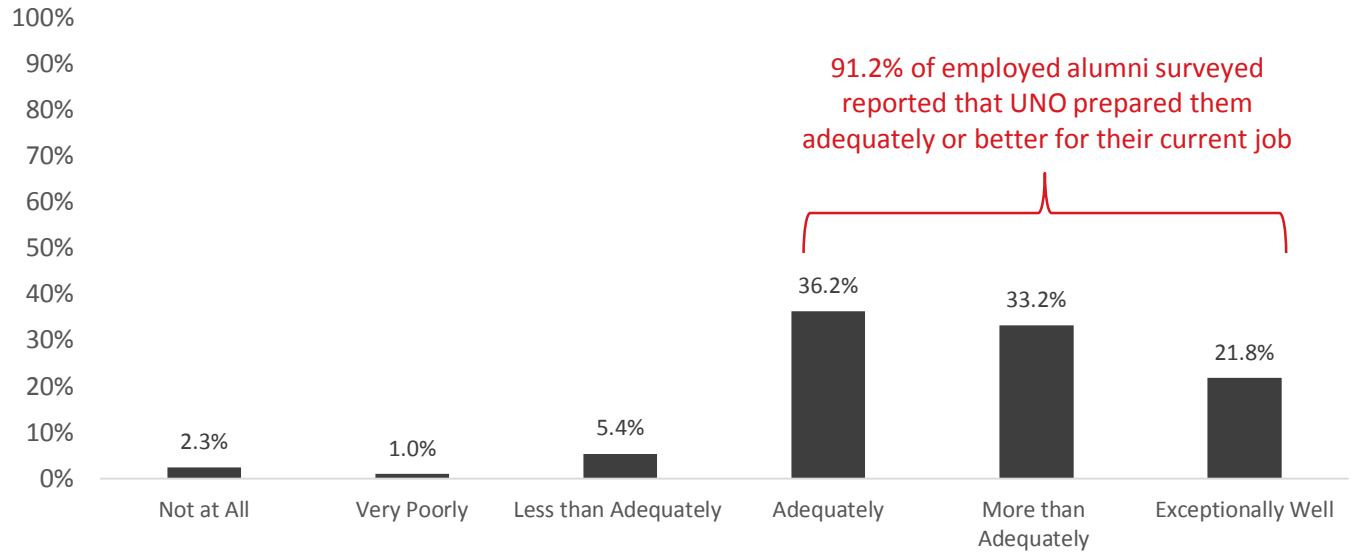

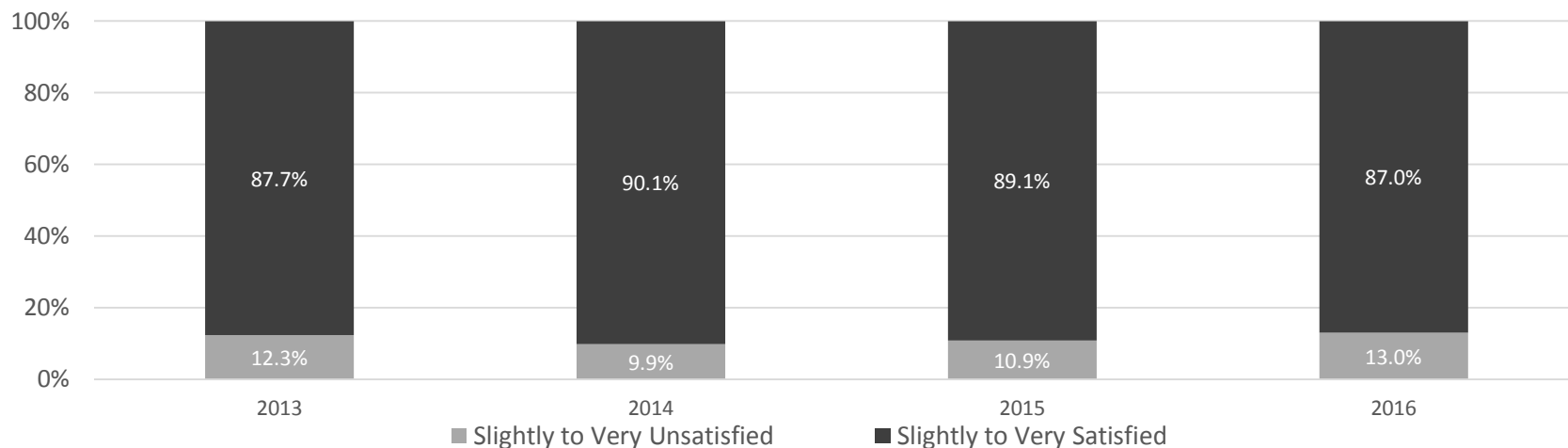

Based on your UNO experience, how satisfied are you with your preparation for your work/career choice?



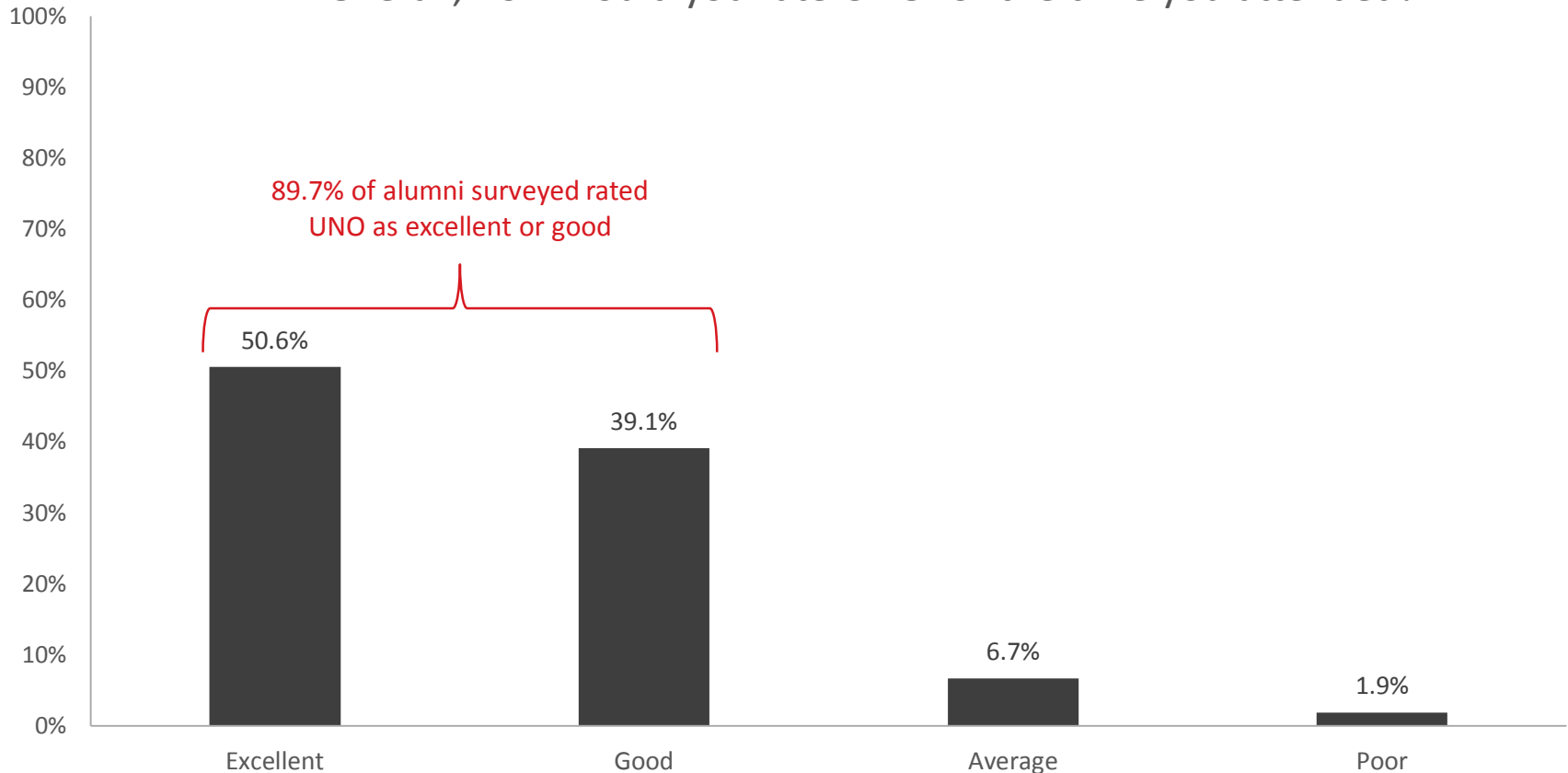
