

2-Year Retention Rates by Year: UNO vs. CUMU Peers











Participation of UNO Seniors in High-Impact Practices (NSSE)



Distribution of UNO Students' CLA+ Mastery Levels









### Post-Graduation Plans of 2017 and 2018 Graduates


Which best describes your plans or situation after graduation? (select all that apply)




