## ACADEMIC REGALIA

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's and master's degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program.

## COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

### L. DENNIS SMITH

Dr. L. Dennis Smith became president of the University of Nebraska on March 1, 1994. Previously, he had served as executive vice chancellor of the University of California, Irvine (1990-1994). He was acting chancellor of the Irvine campus from October 1992 to July 1993. Earlier, he had been dean of the School of Biological Sciences at Irvine (1987-1990), where he also served as a faculty member in developmental and cell biology.

Dr. Smith was on the faculty of Purdue University from 1969 to 1987. At Purdue, he headed the department of biological sciences (1980-1987). He was employed at the Argonne National Laboratory (1964-1969) and at Indiana University (1963-1964). He was an instructor in embryology at the Woods Hole Marine Biology Laboratory during five summer sessions in the 1970s and 1980s.

Dr. Smith earned his Ph.D. (1963) in experimental embryology, and his bachelor's degree (1959) in zoology and chemistry from Indiana University.

He has been a member of the Board of Scientific Counselors for the National Institute for Child Health and Human Development since 1990, and has been the board's chair since 1992. He was a member of the Space Science Board of the National Research Council from 1984-1991 and served as chair of the Committee on Space Biology and Medicine from 1986-1991. He is a member of several professional societies, including the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the International Society of Developmental Biology, the American Society of Cell Biology and the American Society for Microbiology.

Dr. Smith and his wife, Suzanne, have two adult children.

## **ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECIPIENTS**

The University of Nebraska at Omaha Alumni Association awards the Citation for Alumnus Achievement Award to distinguished alumni.

The awards are presented each year at spring commencement to graduates who have achieved distinction in their chosen fields.

This year's honorees are Robert Hemenway, Margaret A. Lehning and Stephen K. Wild.

### **ROBERT HEMENWAY**

Hemenway graduated from UNO in 1963 with a bachelor's degree in English. Three years later, he acquired his Ph.D. from Kent State University.

He first taught at the University of Kentucky as an assistant professor of English from 1966-68, also serving as an associate professor and professor from 1973-81. He became chair of UK's English department in 1981, leaving Lexington five years later to become dean of Arts and Sciences at the University of Oklahoma.

Hemenway returned to Kentucky in 1989 to assume his present post. As chancellor, he oversees the operations of 12 colleges, 1,000 faculty members, 3,500 staff and approximately 21,000 students. He also is the author or editor of seven books, including his biography of Zora Neale Hurston, a black woman novelist, anthropologist and folklorist. The book was listed by the New York Times among its "Best Books of 1978."

### **MARGARET A. LEHNING**

Lehning earned her bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies from UNO in 1976, also acquiring an MBA from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. She joined First Data in 1990 as vice president of strategic planning. Recently, she was named to head First Data's Debit Card Services, which processes debit card transactions for numerous financial institutions across the United States.

Prior to joining First Data, Lehning was president of Tracking Trend, Inc., a private consulting firm specializing in strategic planning and innovation. From 1978 to 1986, she filled several positions in corporate planning at Internorth/Enron Corp.

Lehning, who speaks Korean and Spanish, has lived and worked in a variety of international locations. She currently serves on the board of directors for Girl's Inc., Omaha 2000 Steering Committee and Nebraska 2000. She also has volunteered her time with the YMCA, Girl Scouts, Women's Fund of Omaha Community Foundation, and Opera Omaha.

### **STEPHEN K. WILD**

Wild attended UNO from 1968-73, becoming just the second student to serve as a two-term student body president. In 1971, he was awarded the Student Achievement Award, UNO's highest non-academic student honor.

He has overseen the tremendous success of Financial Dynamics, a national diversified financial services firm. Among its subsidiaries is Securities America, named last year as Omaha's fastest growing privately-held company. Last August, Securities America also was listed as the fastest growing independent securities broker/dealer in the United States, according to Stanger's "Investment Advisor."

Wild, a vigorous entrepreneur, has been involved in the start up of more than 20 businesses since 1979. Education has continued to be an important part of his career. In 1985, he initiated a program for Financial Dynamics employees to be fully reimbursed for educational costs.

Wild serves on the board of directors of the Child Saving Institute and is a member of Christ Community Church.
