Executive Summary

This Enrollment Statistical Summary provides delivery-site information. Administrative-site headcounts, since they are more closely related to the budgetary authority exercised by the campus, are officially reported to the Board of Regents. Delivery-site reporting counts all students, including those in UNL programs delivered at UNO, but excludes UNO programs delivered in Lincoln (CPACS programs). Administrative-site reporting counts students enrolled in UNO programs only (including the CPACS programs delivered in Lincoln).

The Office of Institutional Research has found delivery-site counts to be the most frequently requested figures by campus units for academic and administrative planning purposes. The purpose of this summary is to provide the undergraduate and graduate enrollments and student credit hour information by college or equivalent academic unit, class, gender and ethnicity.

A glossary at the end of the report provides a list of definitions for headings and categories found in the report.

Spring 2007 Delivery-Site Campus Summary

A campus summary of changes in delivery-site head count enrollment and student credit hours compared to spring 2005 is below.

- Spring 2007 head count enrollment is 13,709, and is basically no change compared to the spring 2006 enrollment of 13,713 (see Figure 1).
- Spring 2007 undergraduate head count enrollment is 10,983, a -.7% decline compared to the spring 2006 enrollment of 11,058 (see Figure 2A).
- Spring 2007 graduate head count enrollment is 2,726, a 2.7% increase compared to the spring 2006 enrollment of 2,655 (see Figure 2A).
- Spring 2007 delivery-site student credit hours are 147,781, a 1.3% increase compared to the spring 2006 credit hours of 145,883 (see Figure 3A).
- Spring 2007 undergraduate credit hours are 132,626, a .9% increase compared to the spring 2006 undergraduate credit hours of 131,402 (see Figure 3).
- Spring 2007 graduate credit hours are 15,155, a 4.7% increase compared to the spring 2006 graduate credit hours of 14,481 (see Figure 3).

Spring 2007 Administrative-site Summary

- Spring 2007 administrative-site head count enrollment is 12,996, and is basically no change from the previous spring. (see Figure 1).
- Spring 2007 administrative-site student credit hours are 141,709 up .9% from the previous spring.

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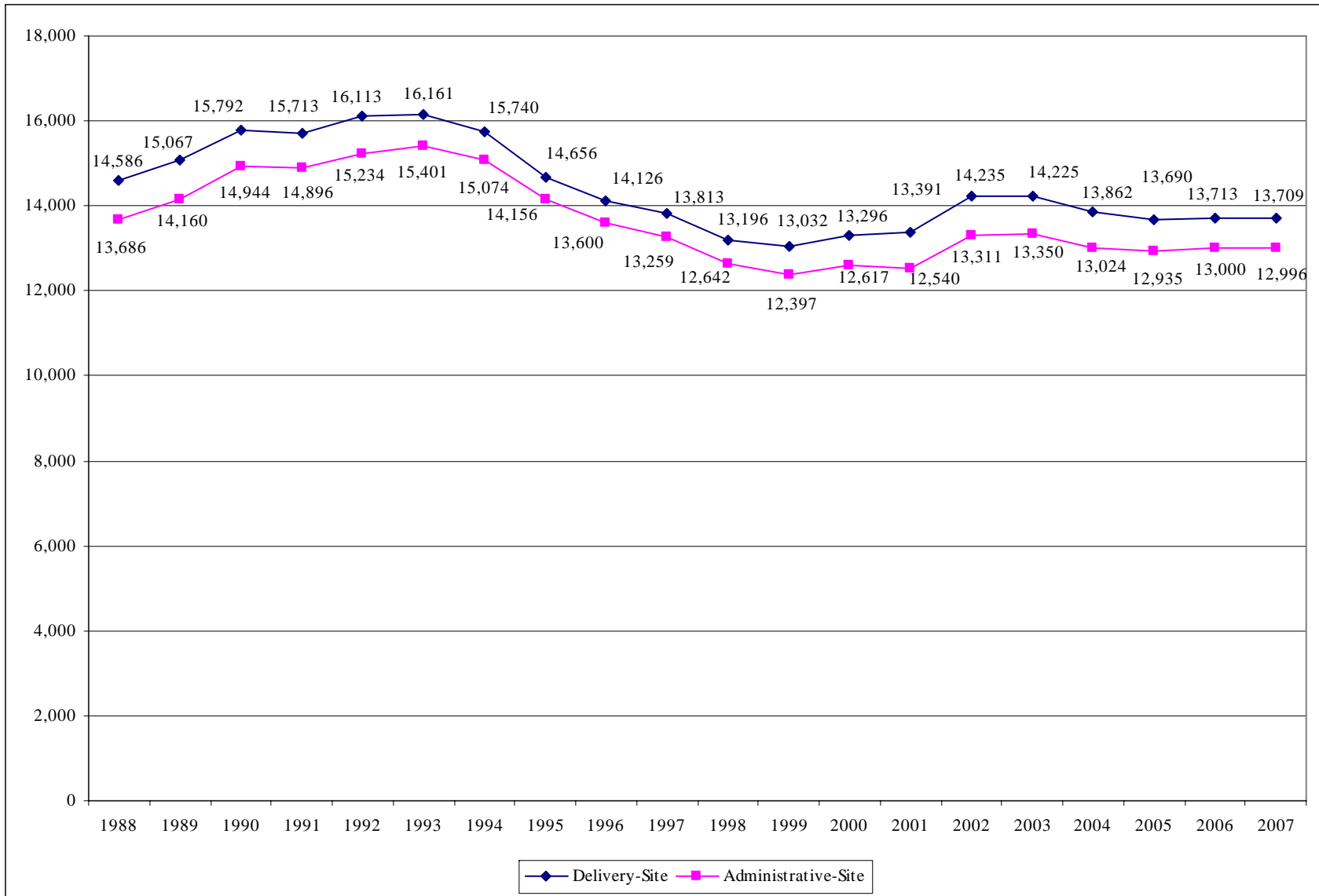

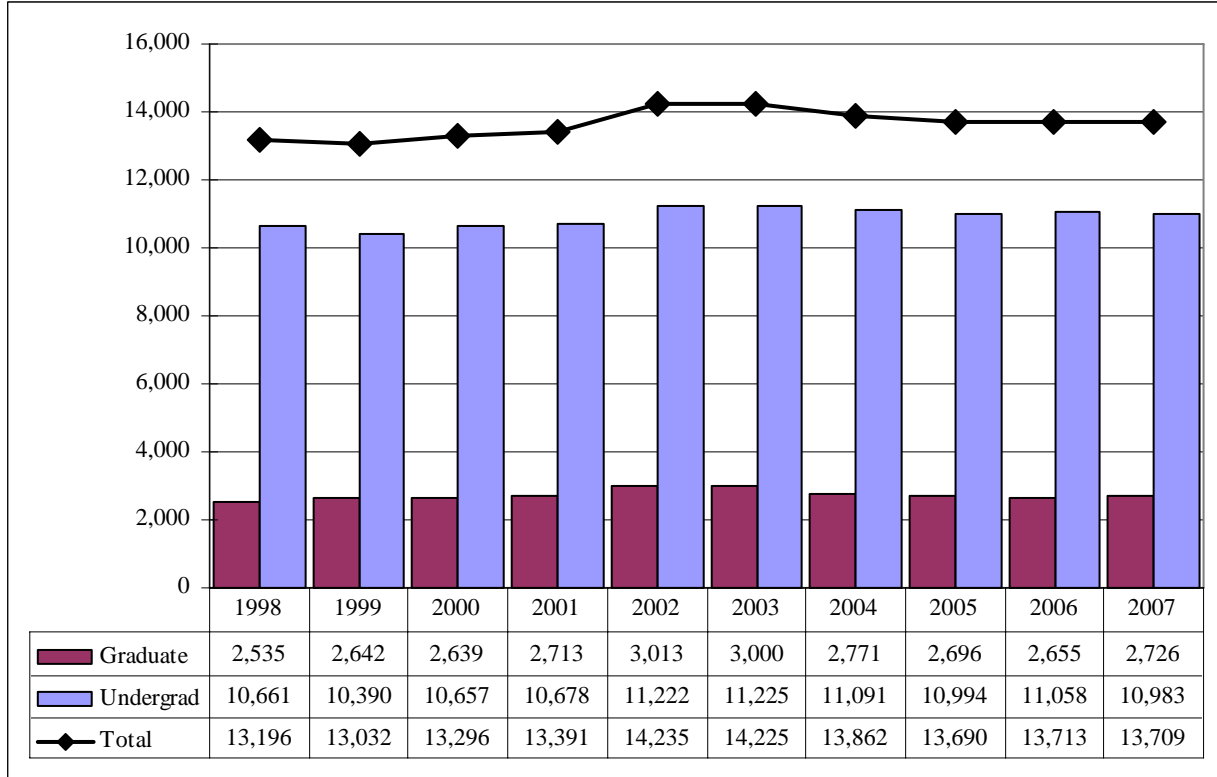

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

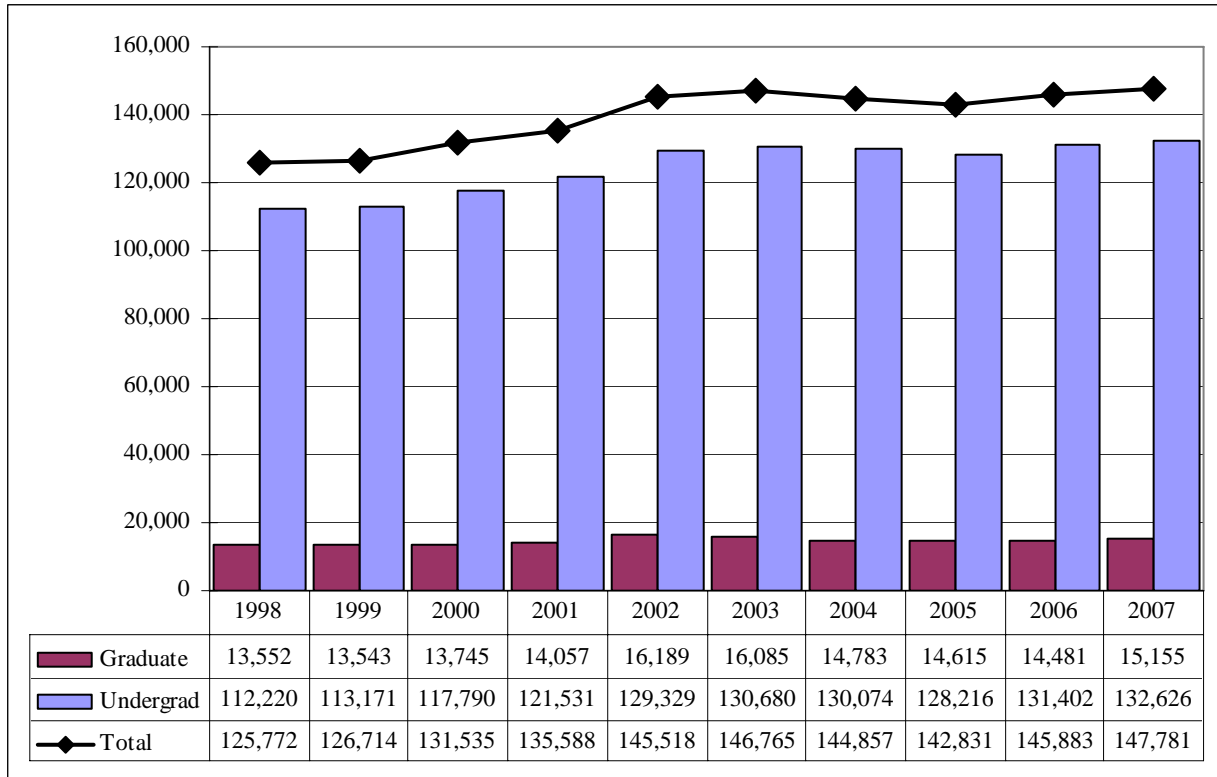

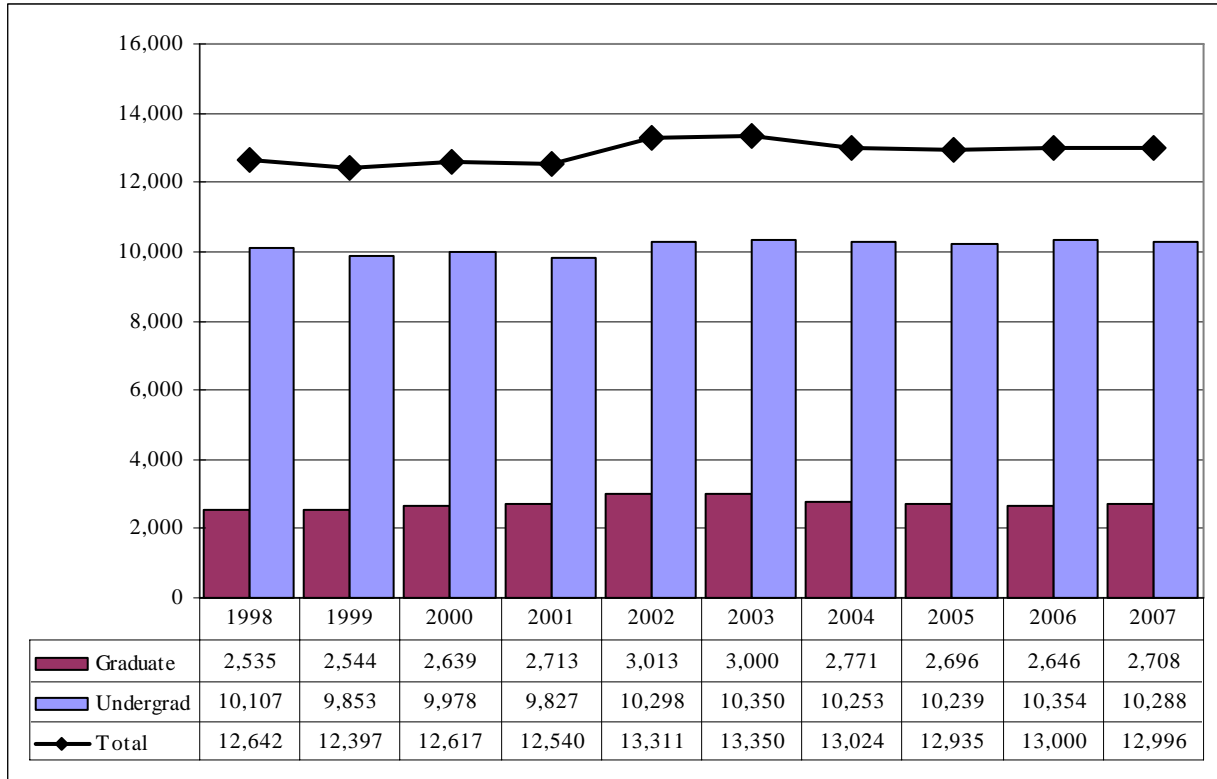

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

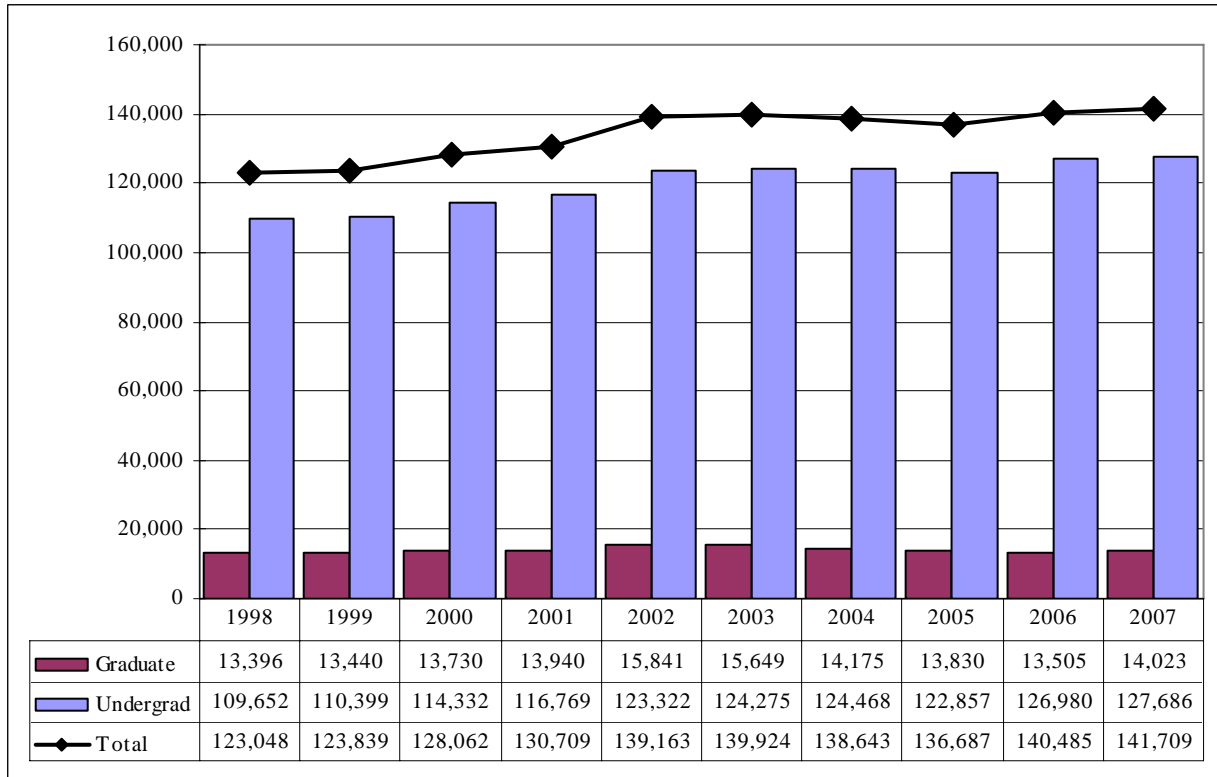

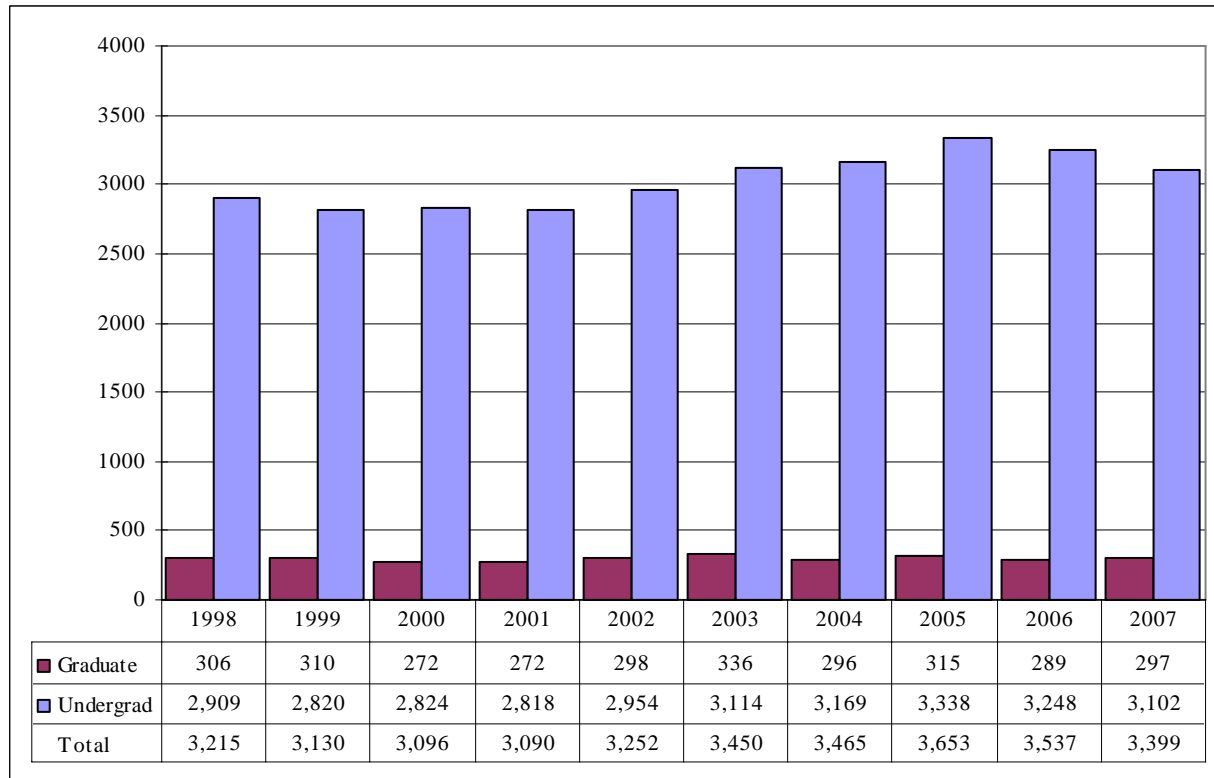

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

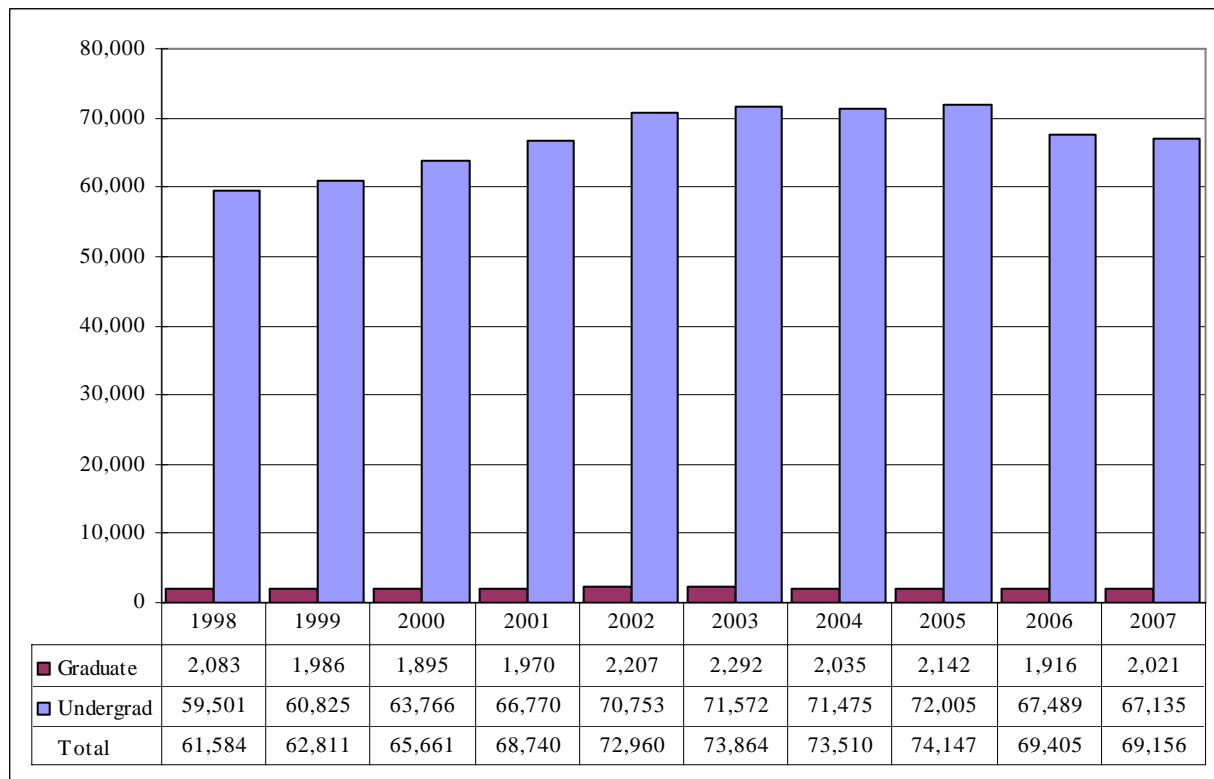

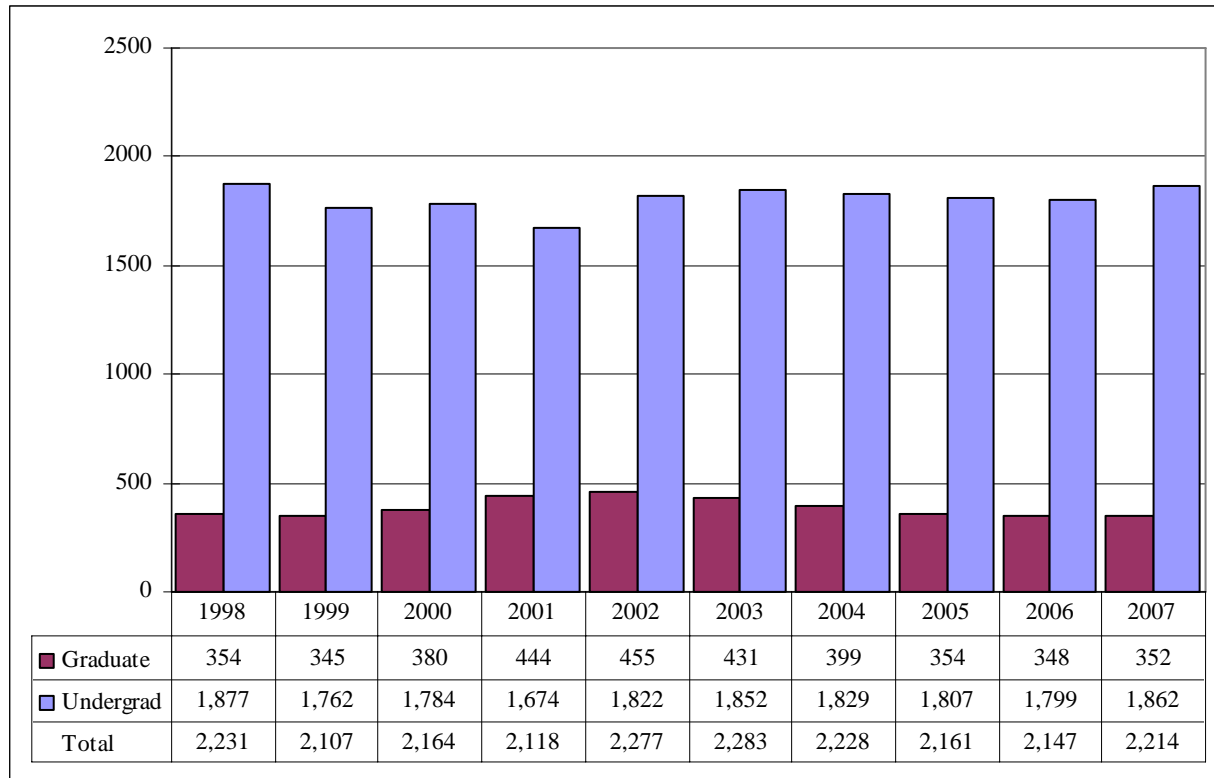

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

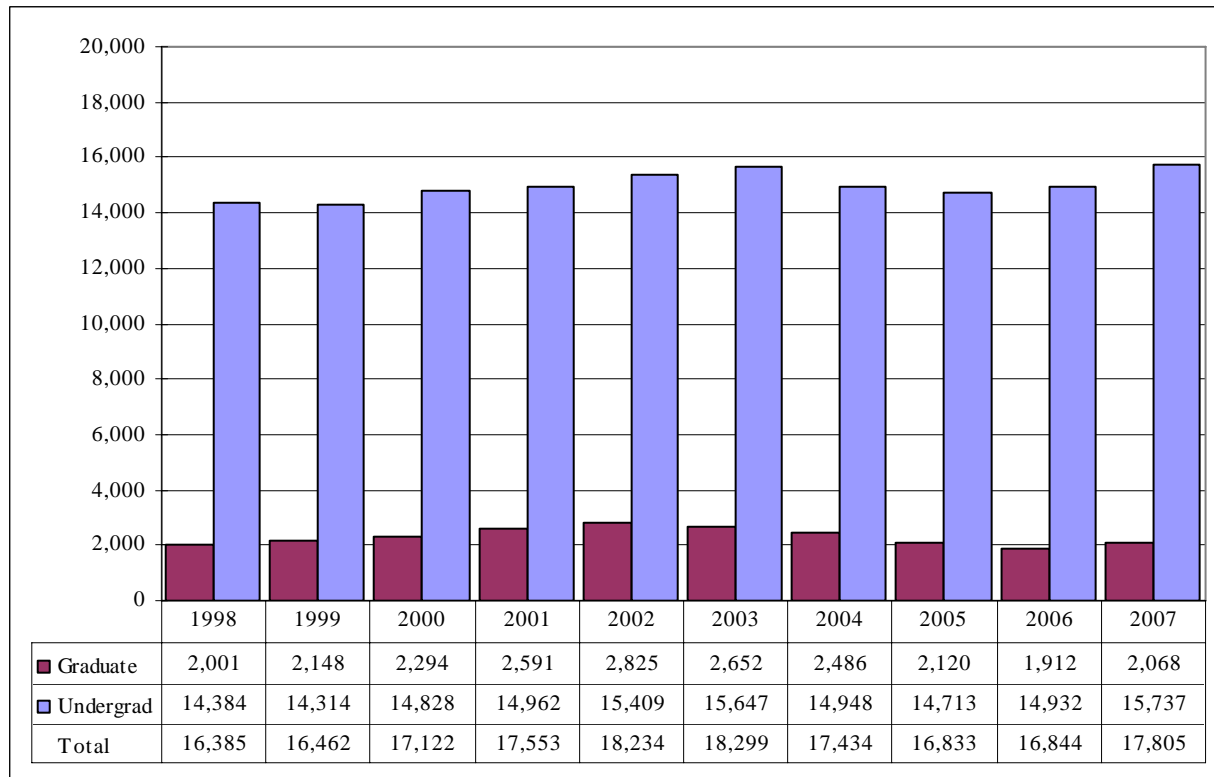

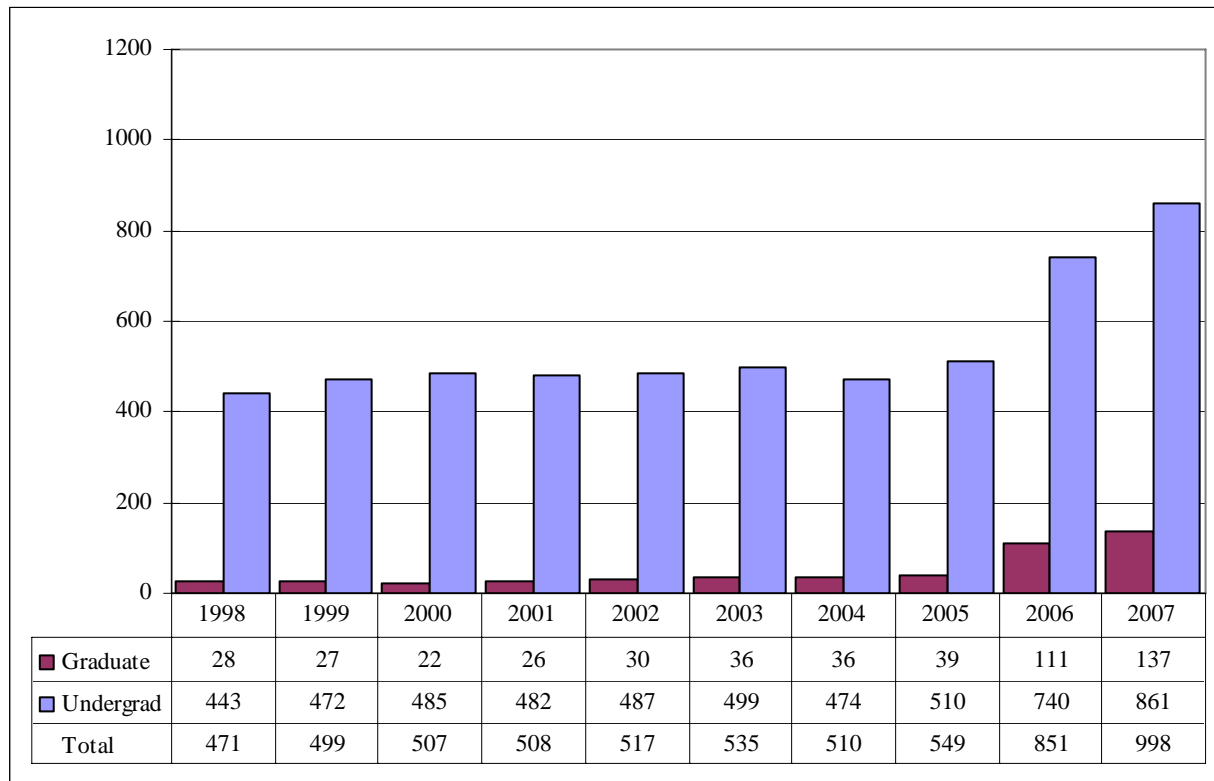

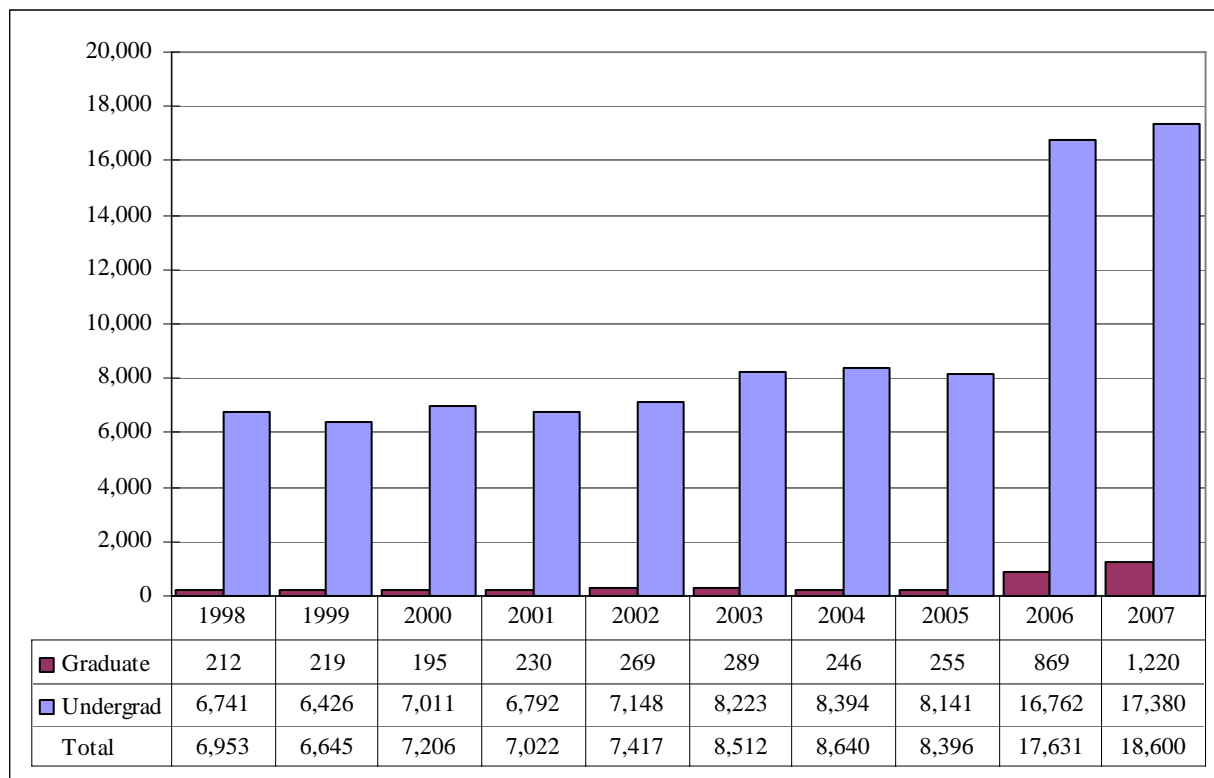

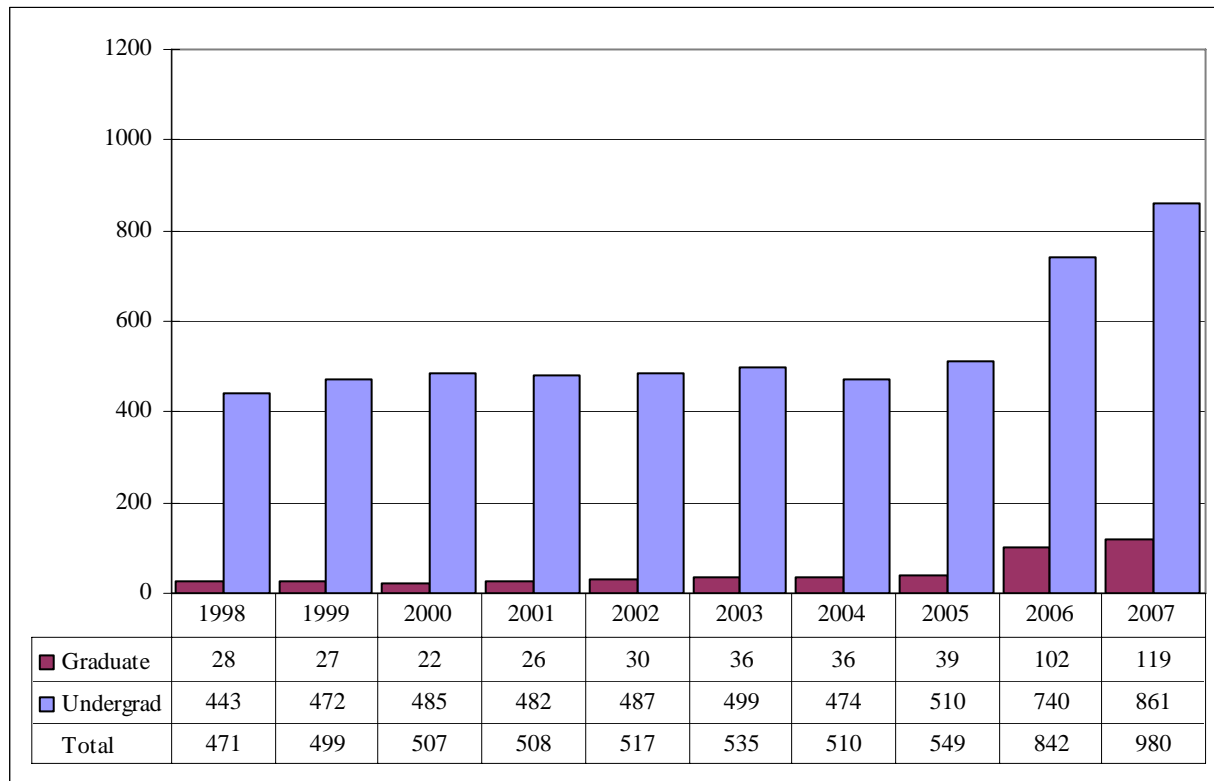

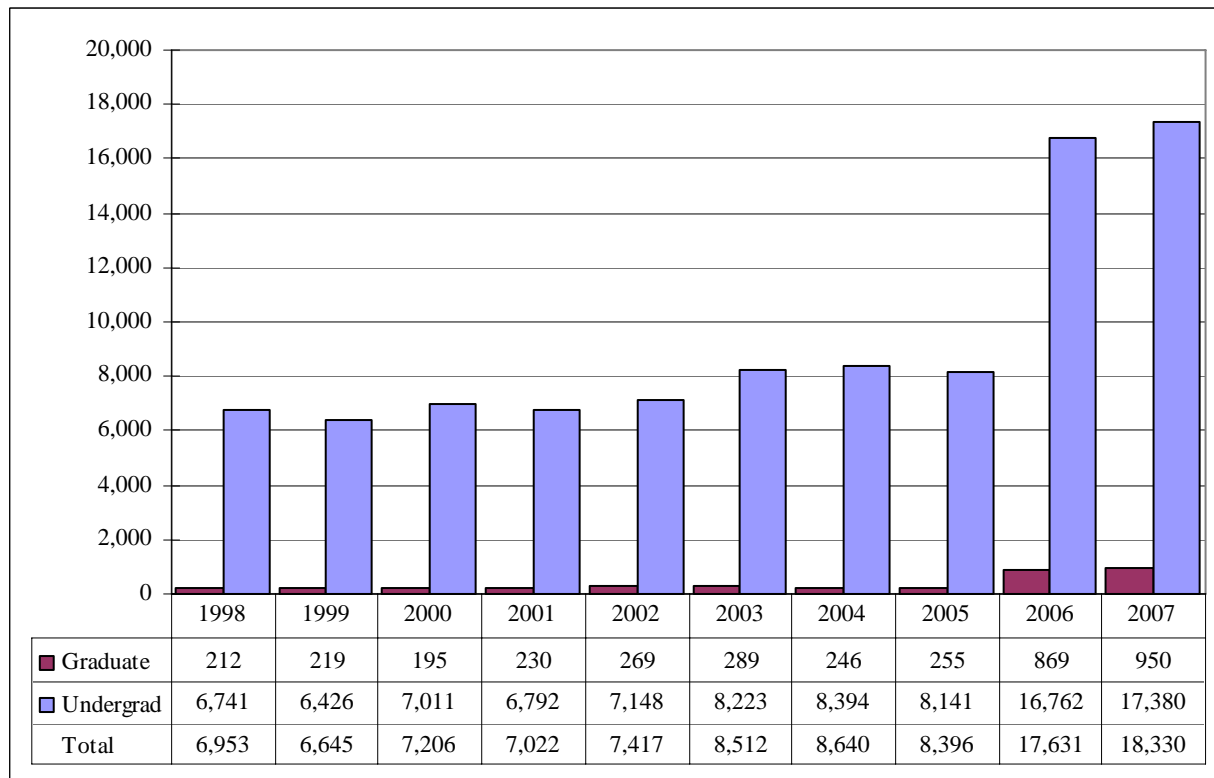

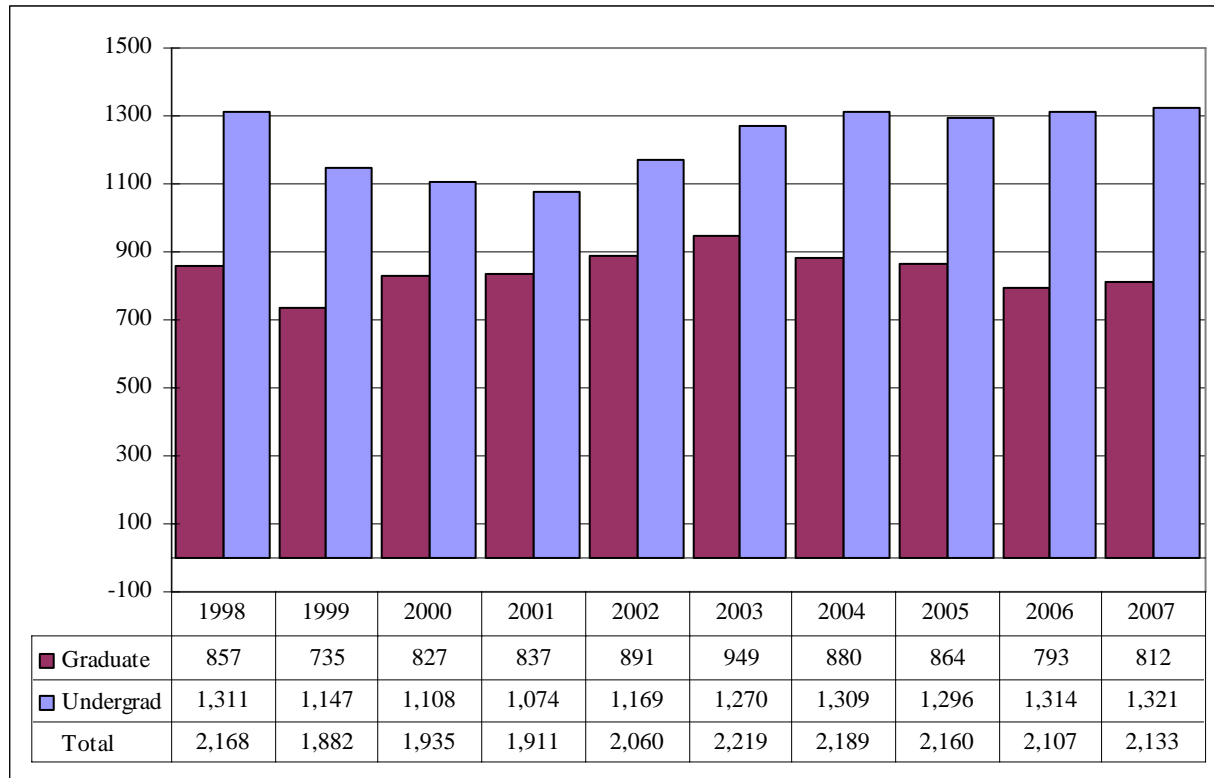

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

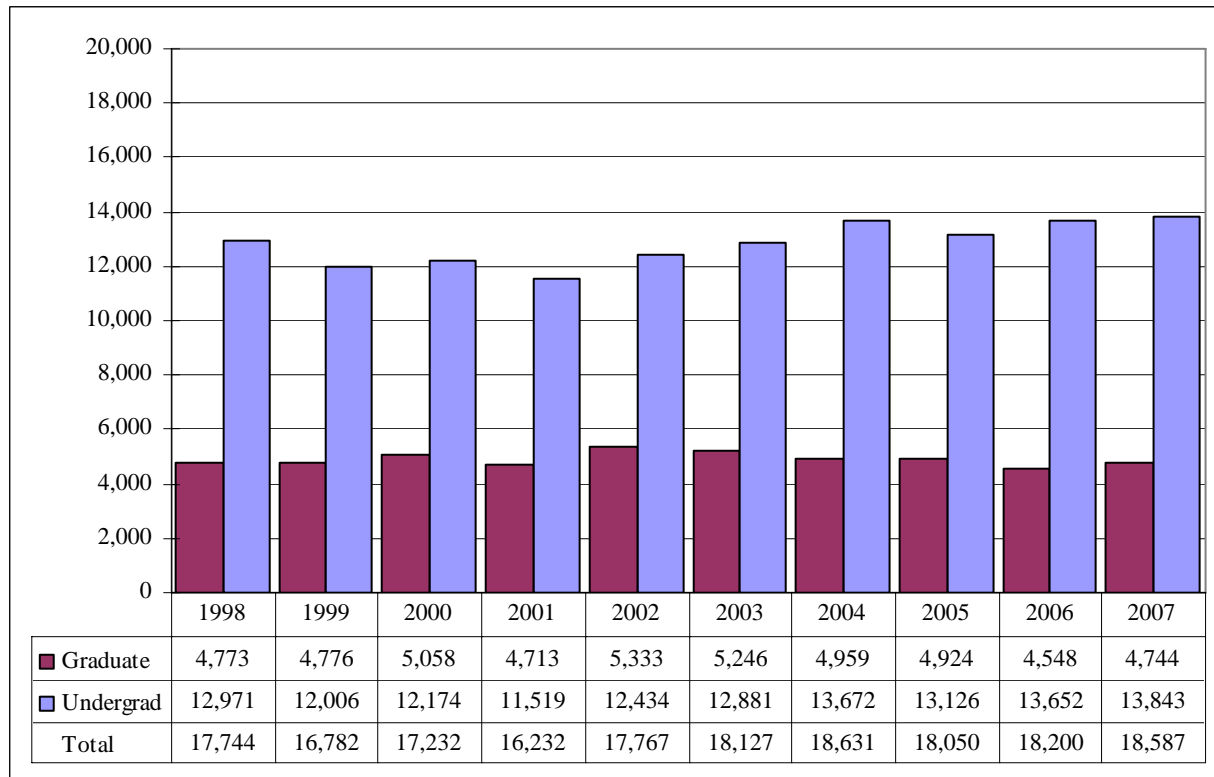

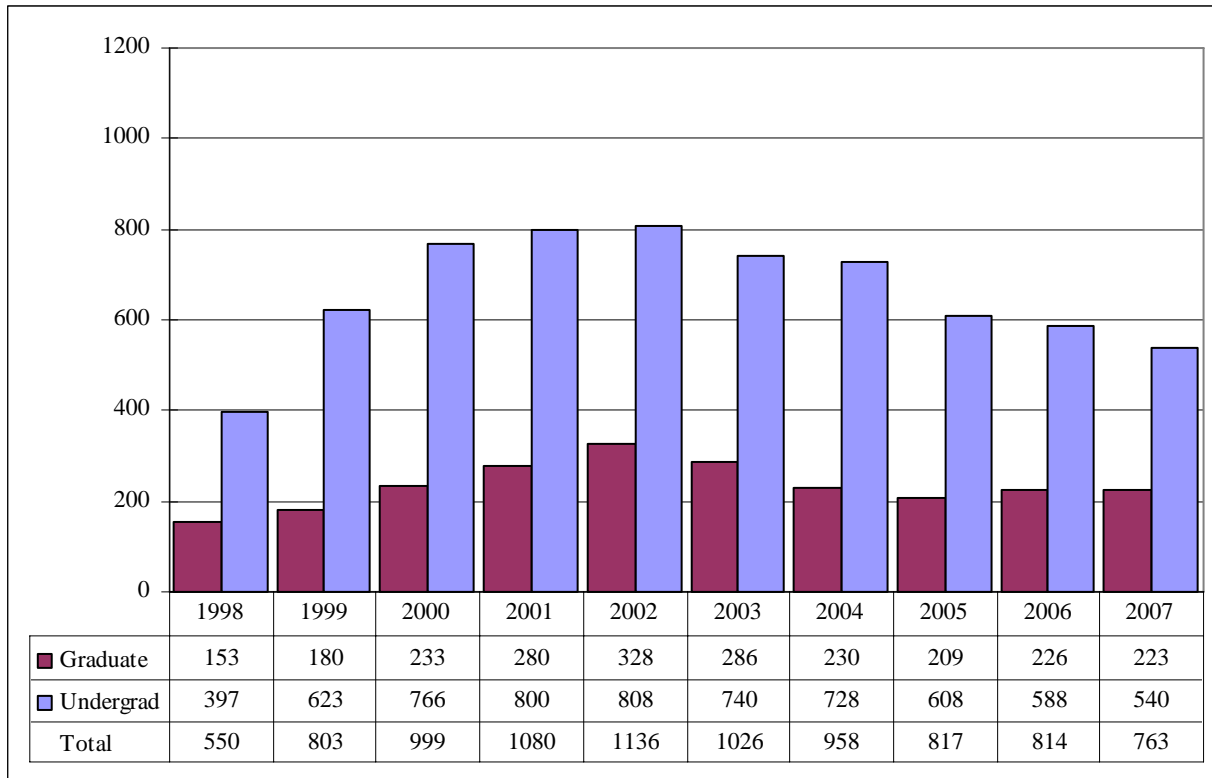

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

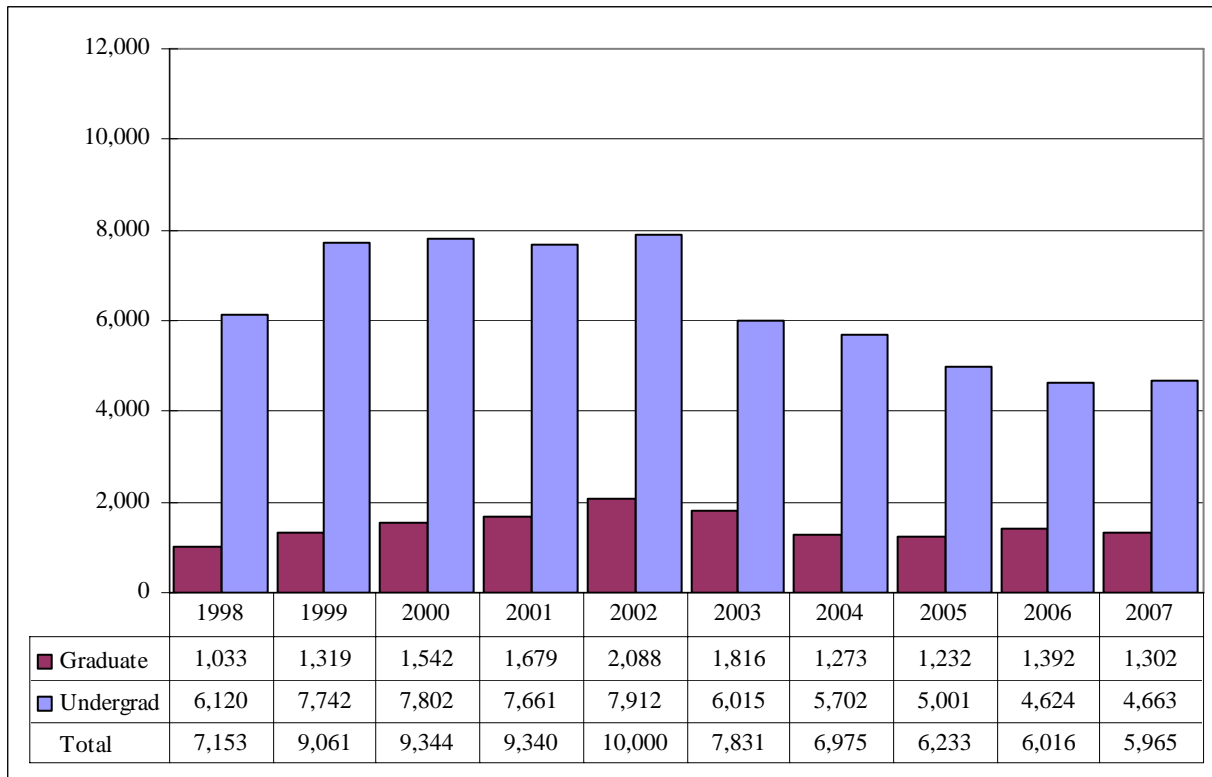

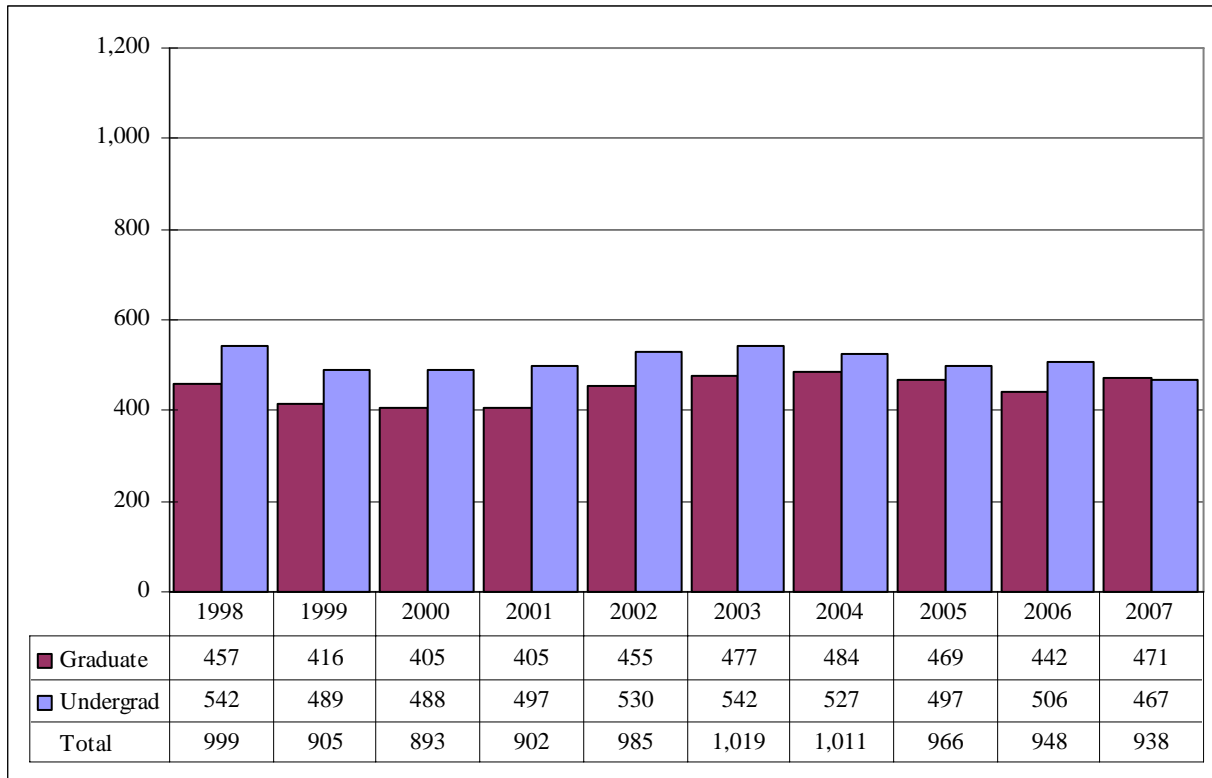

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

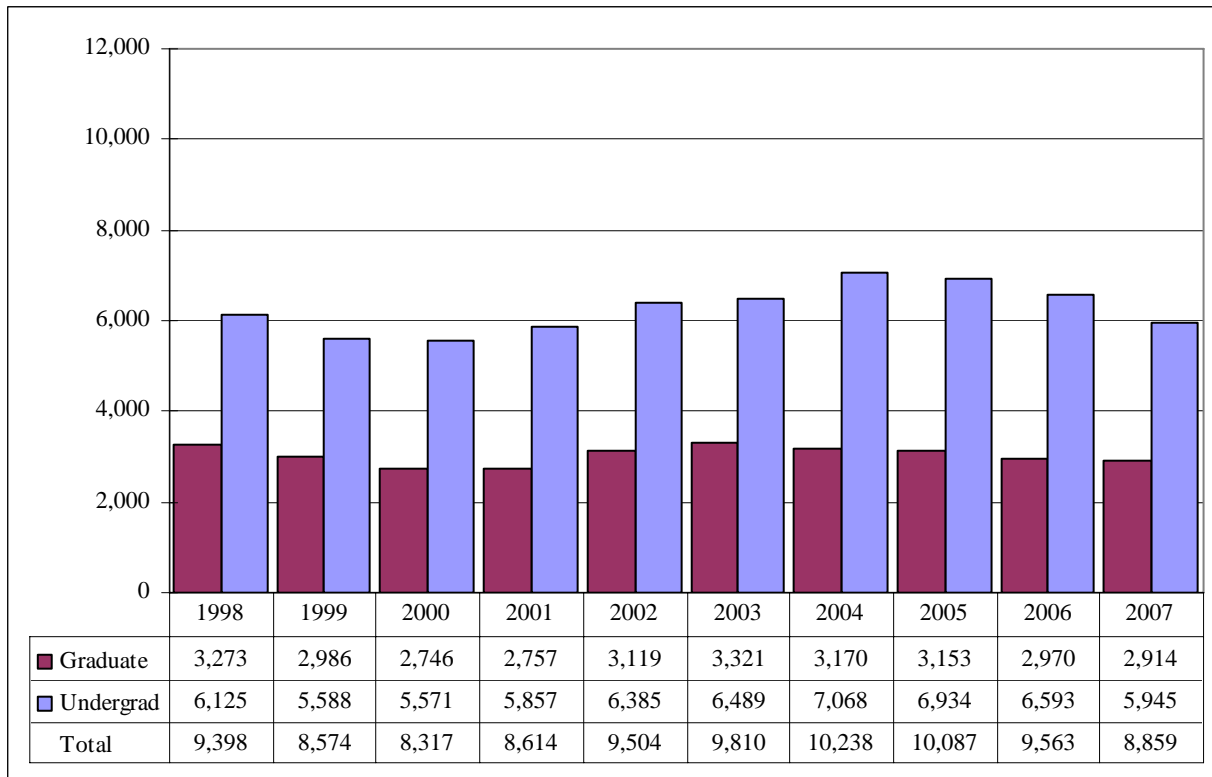

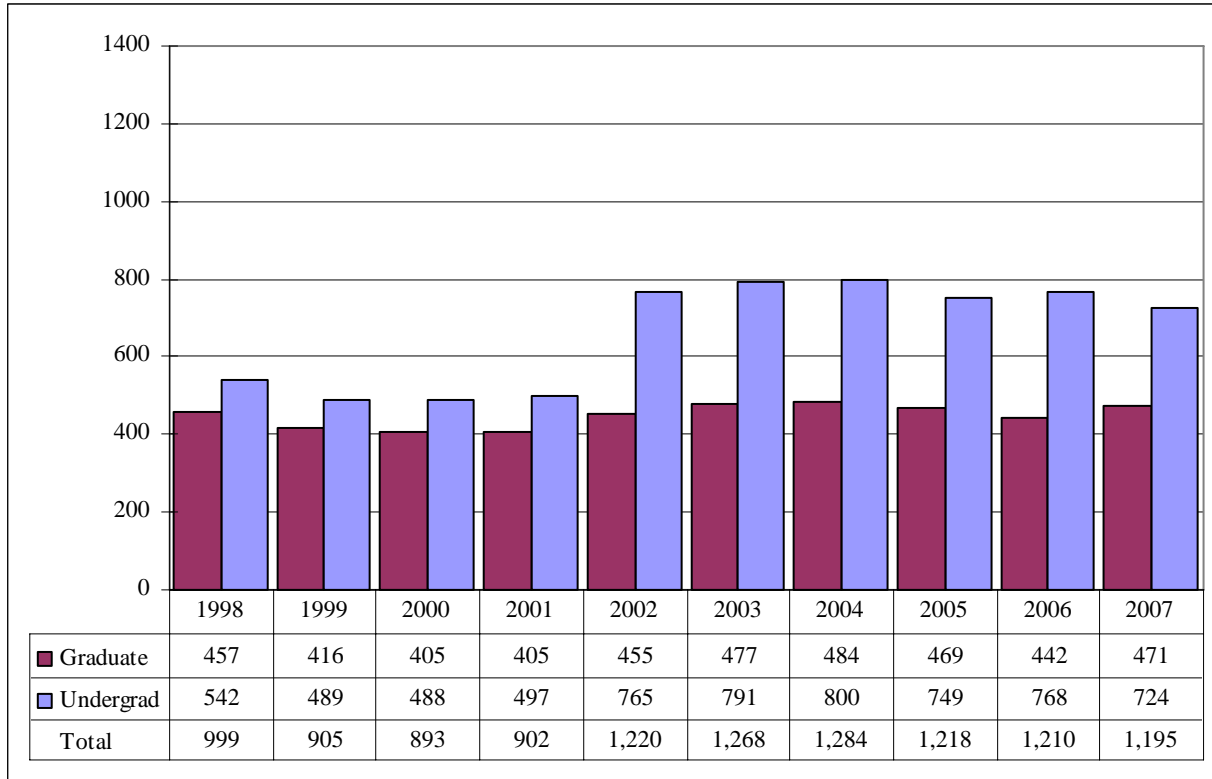

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

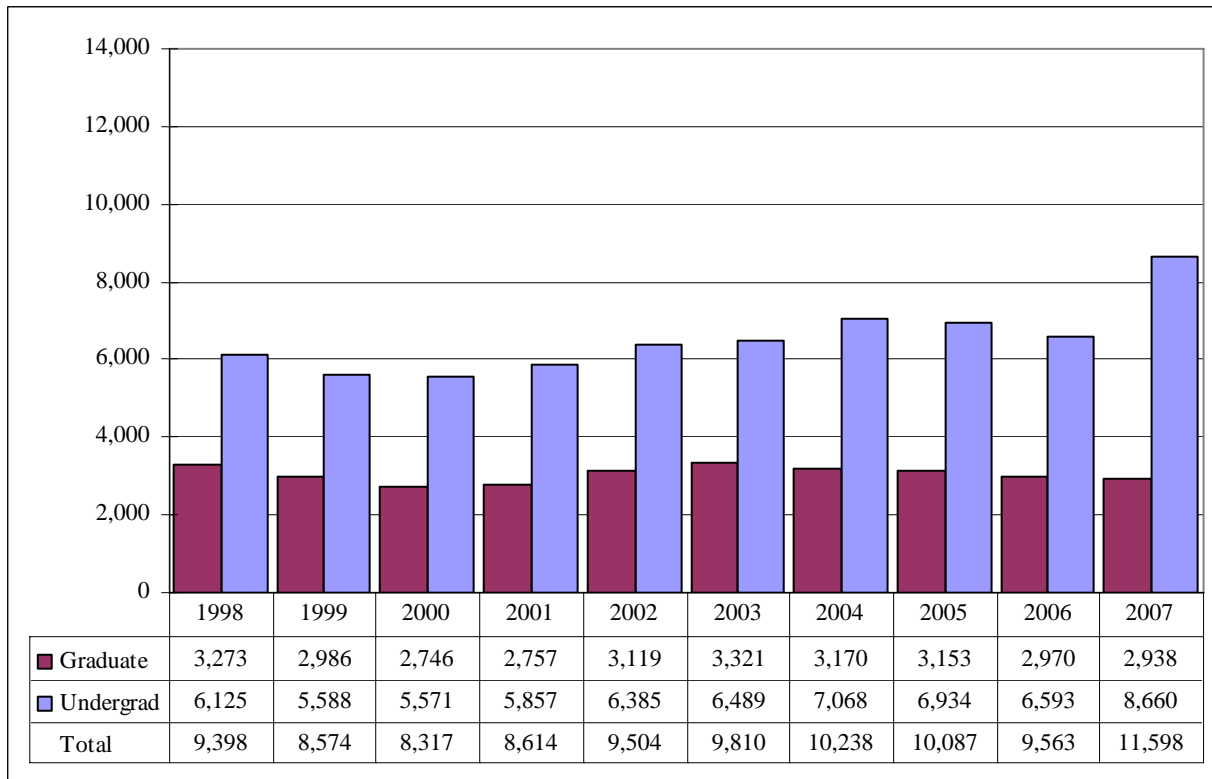

Head Count by Student Level

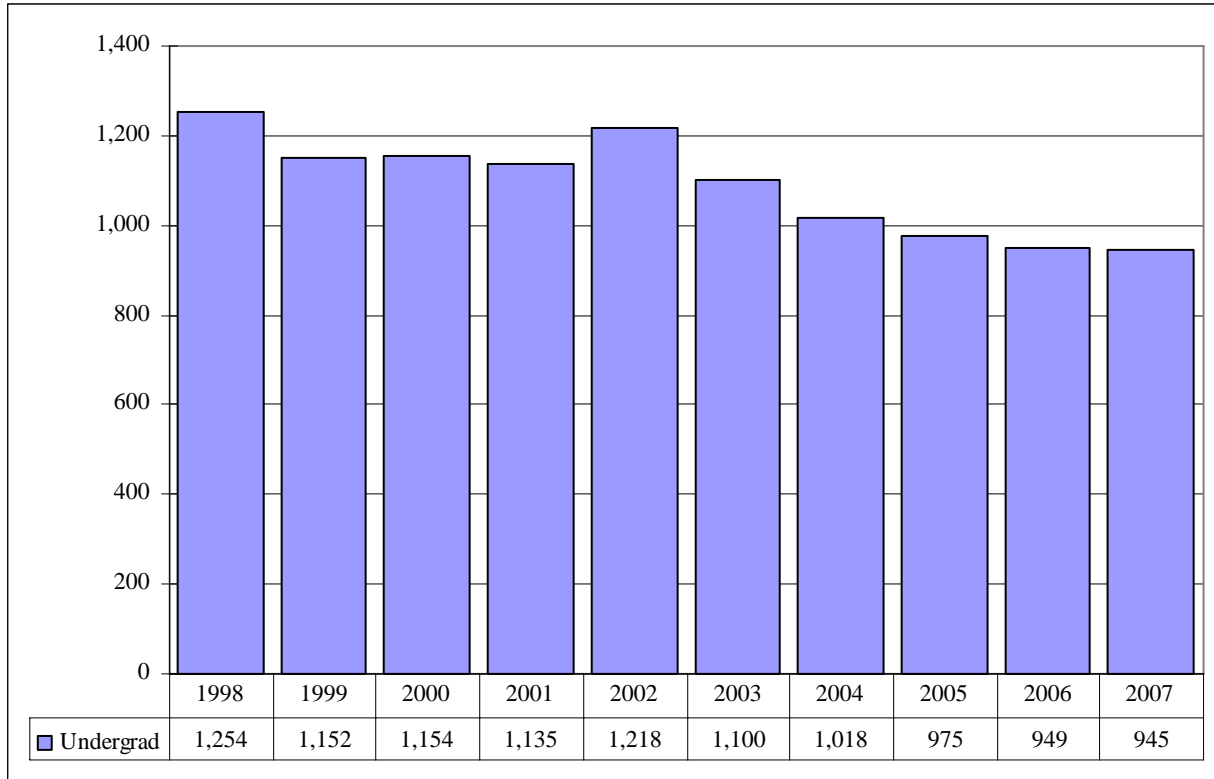
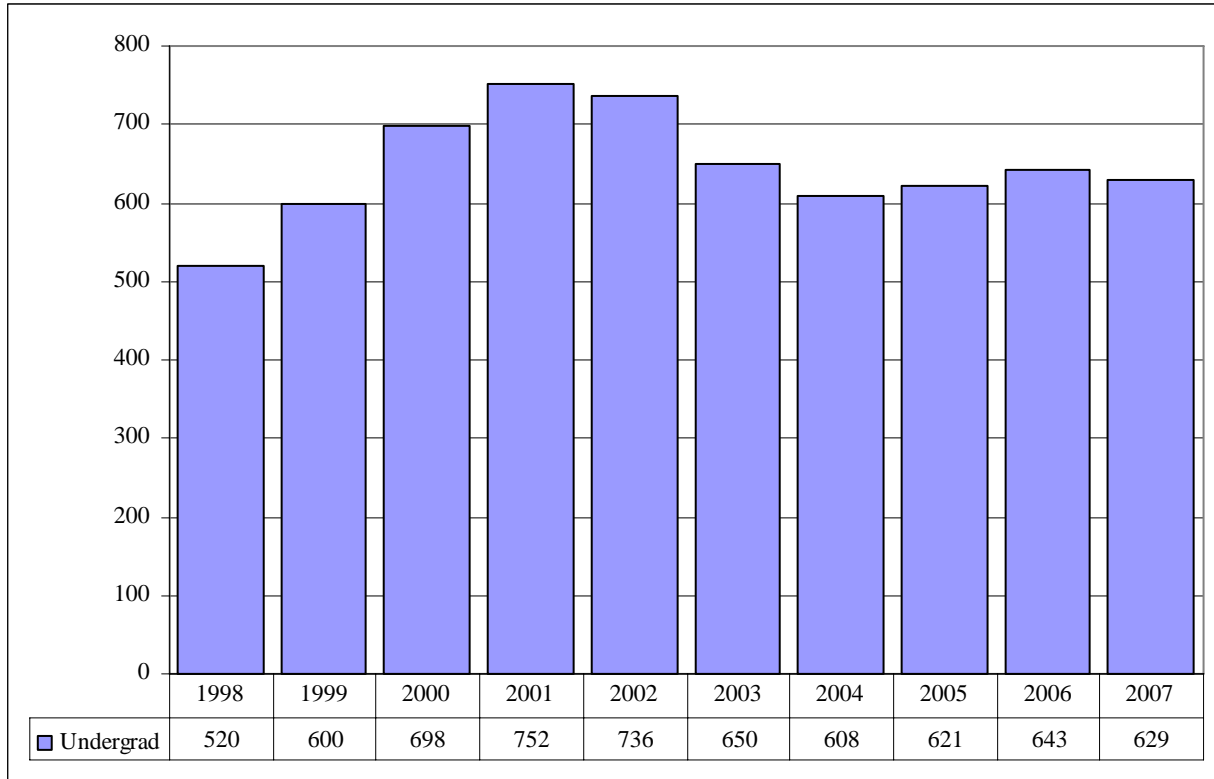

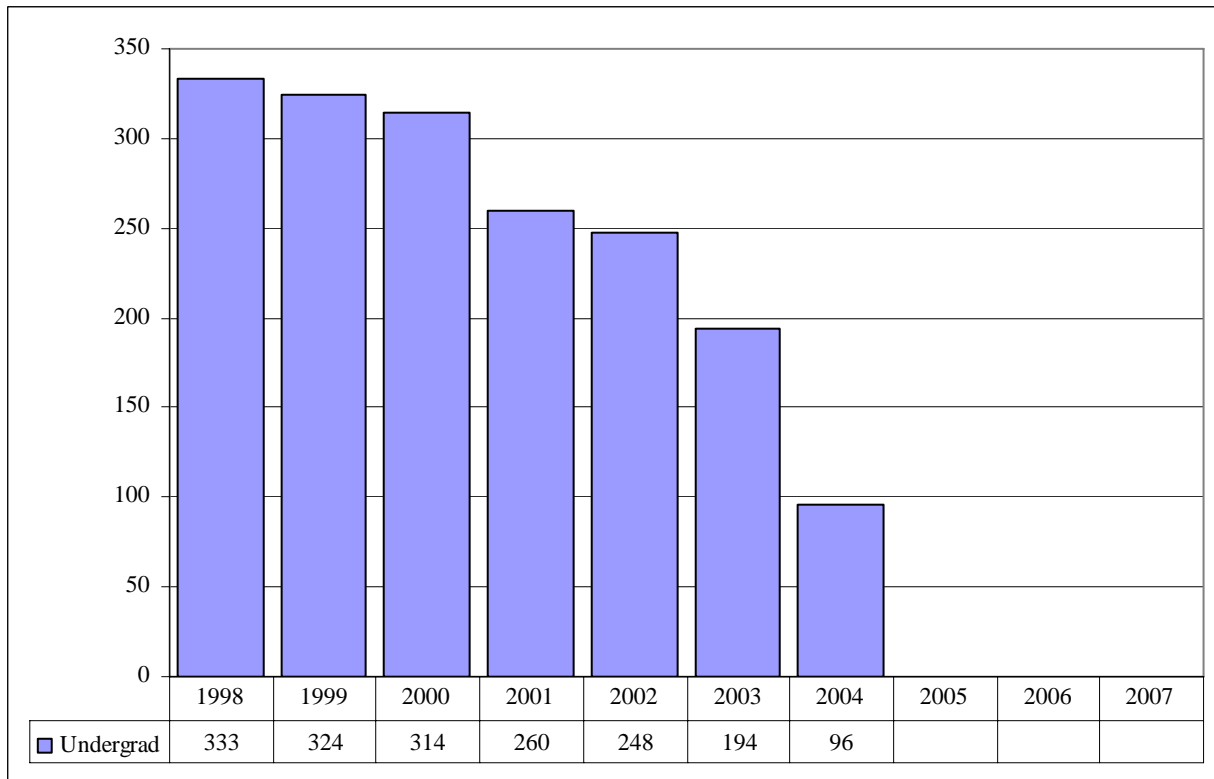

Head Count by Student Level

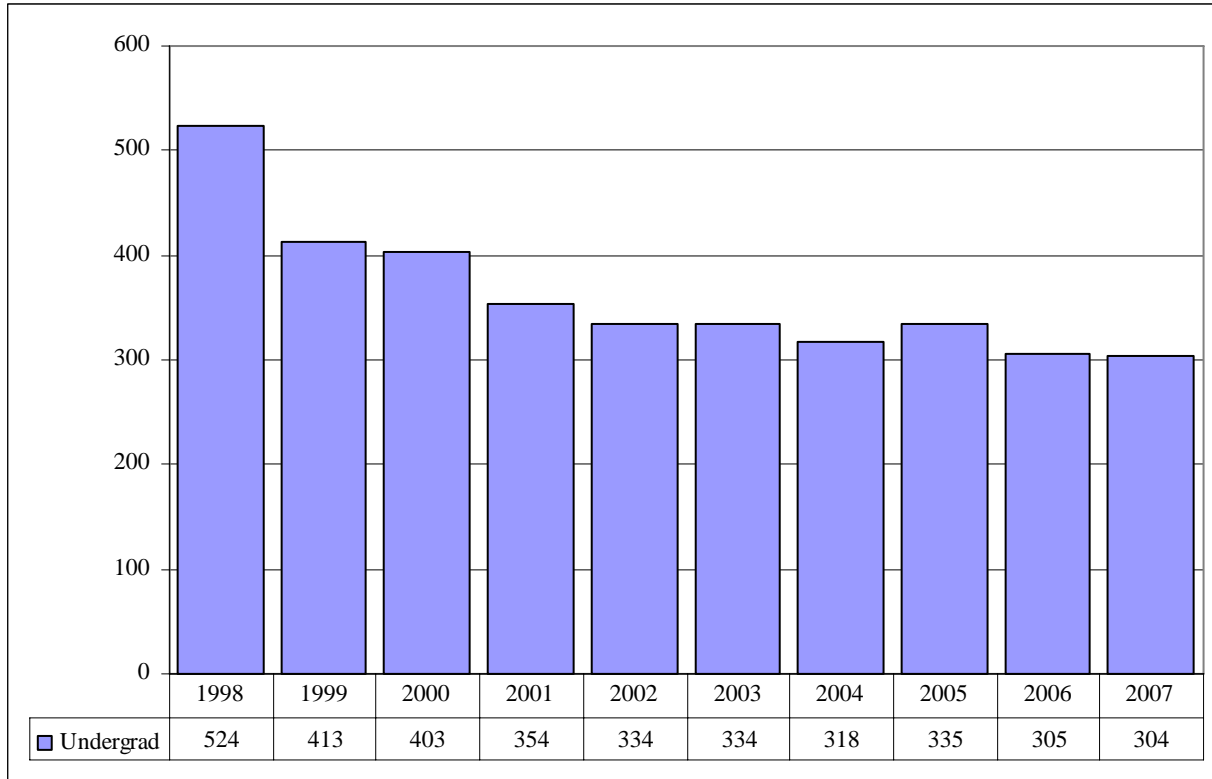

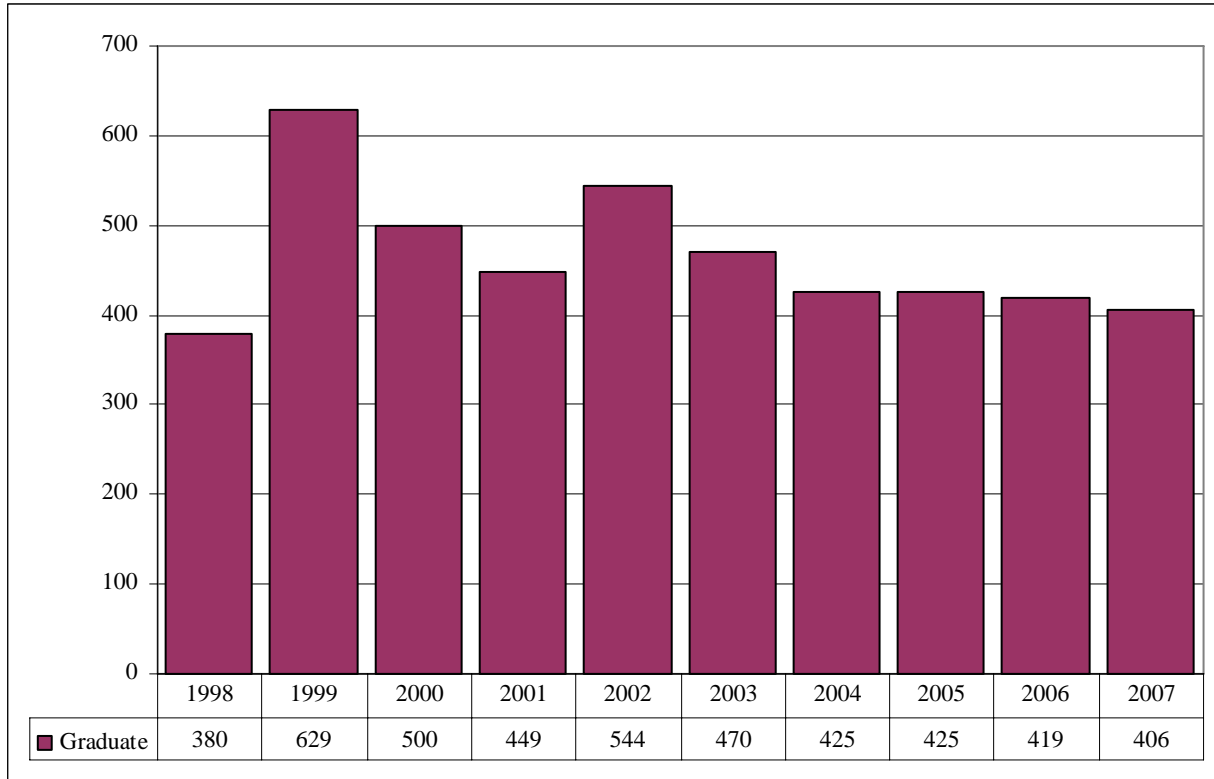
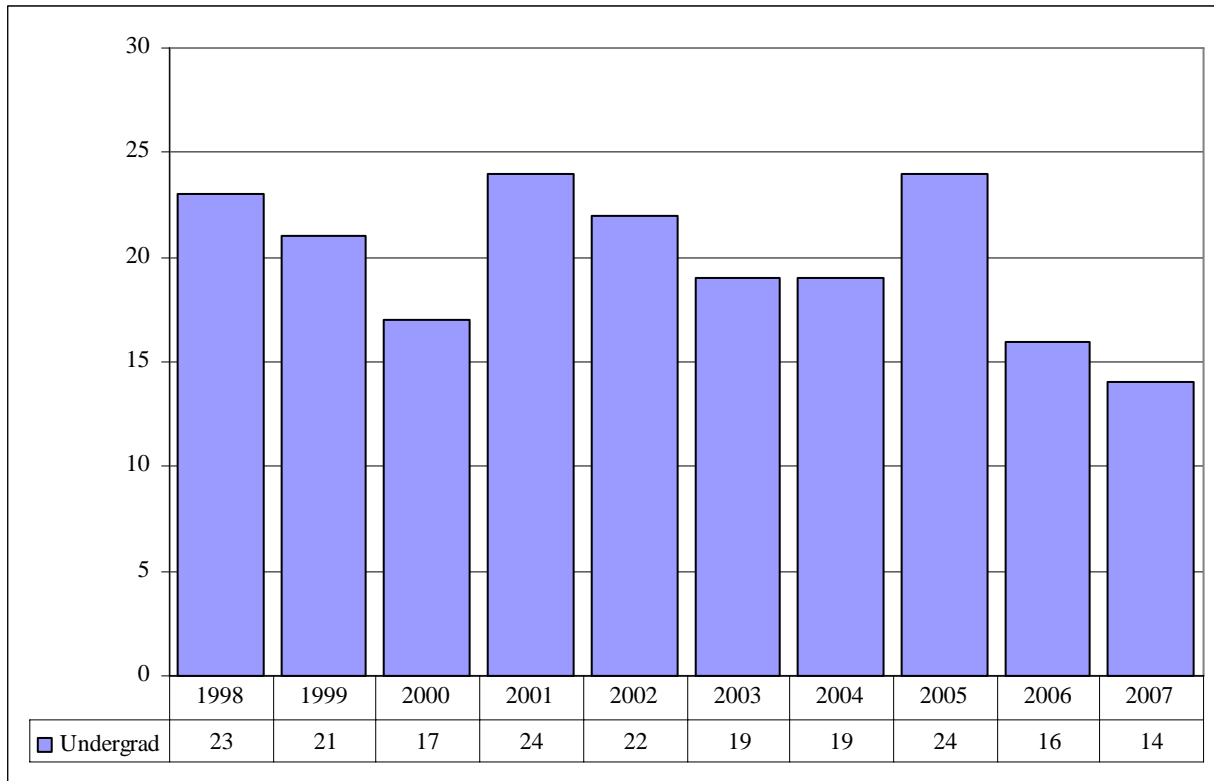

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

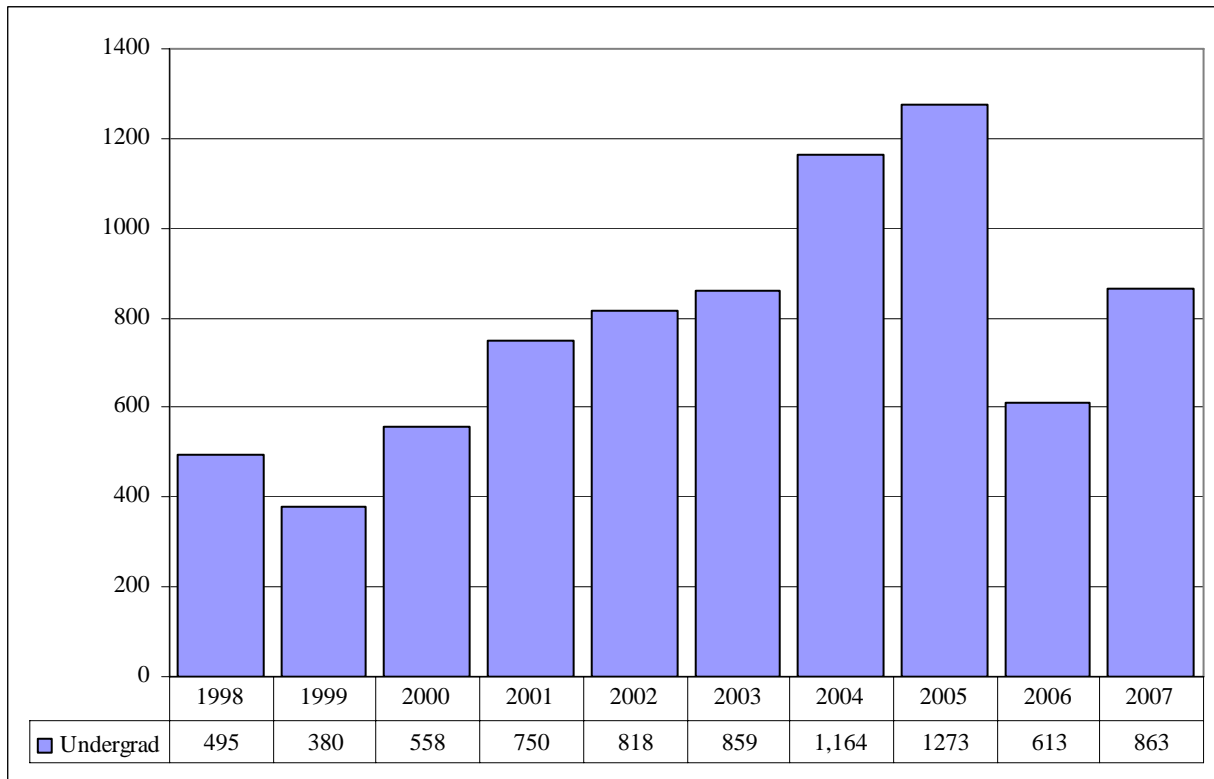
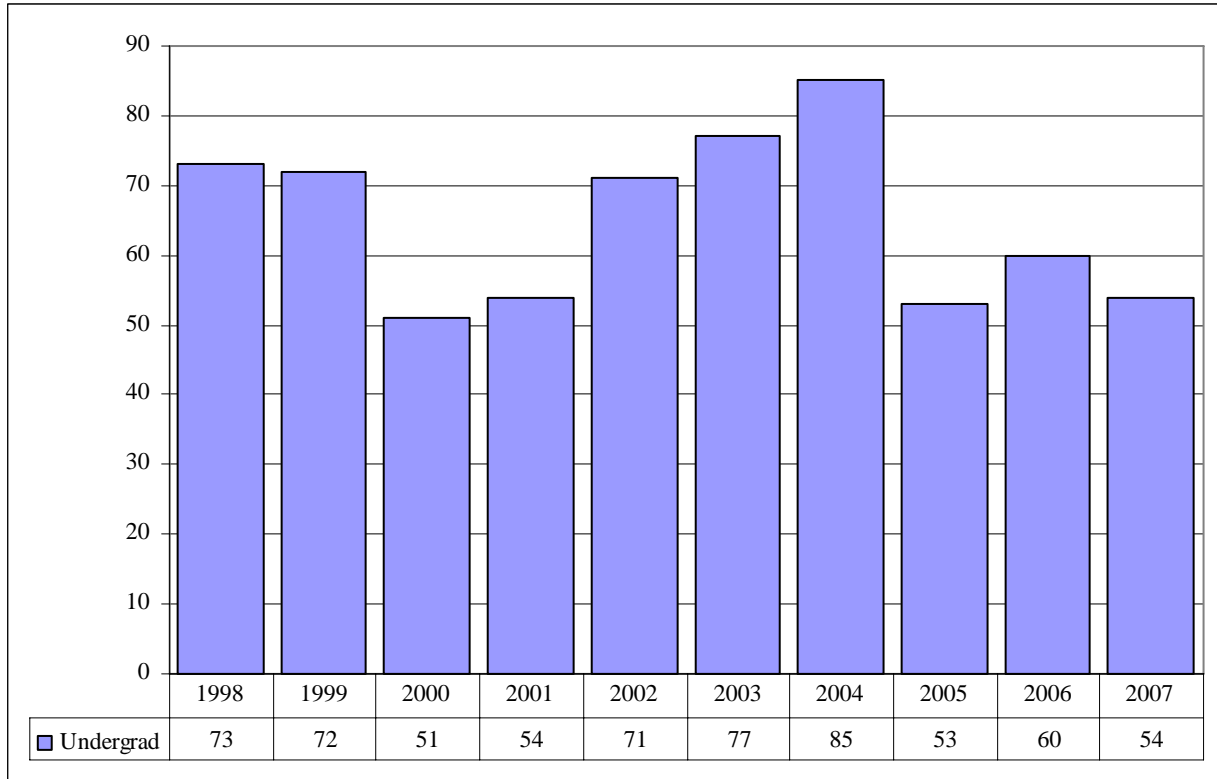

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

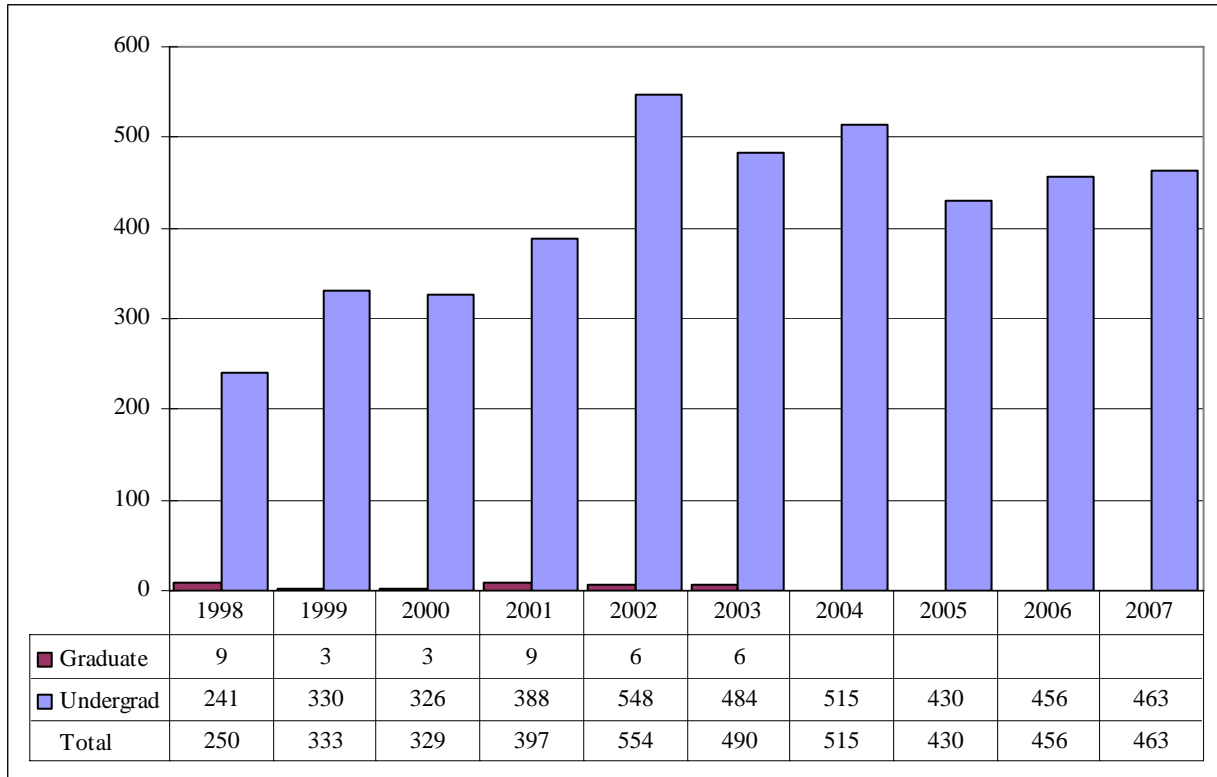
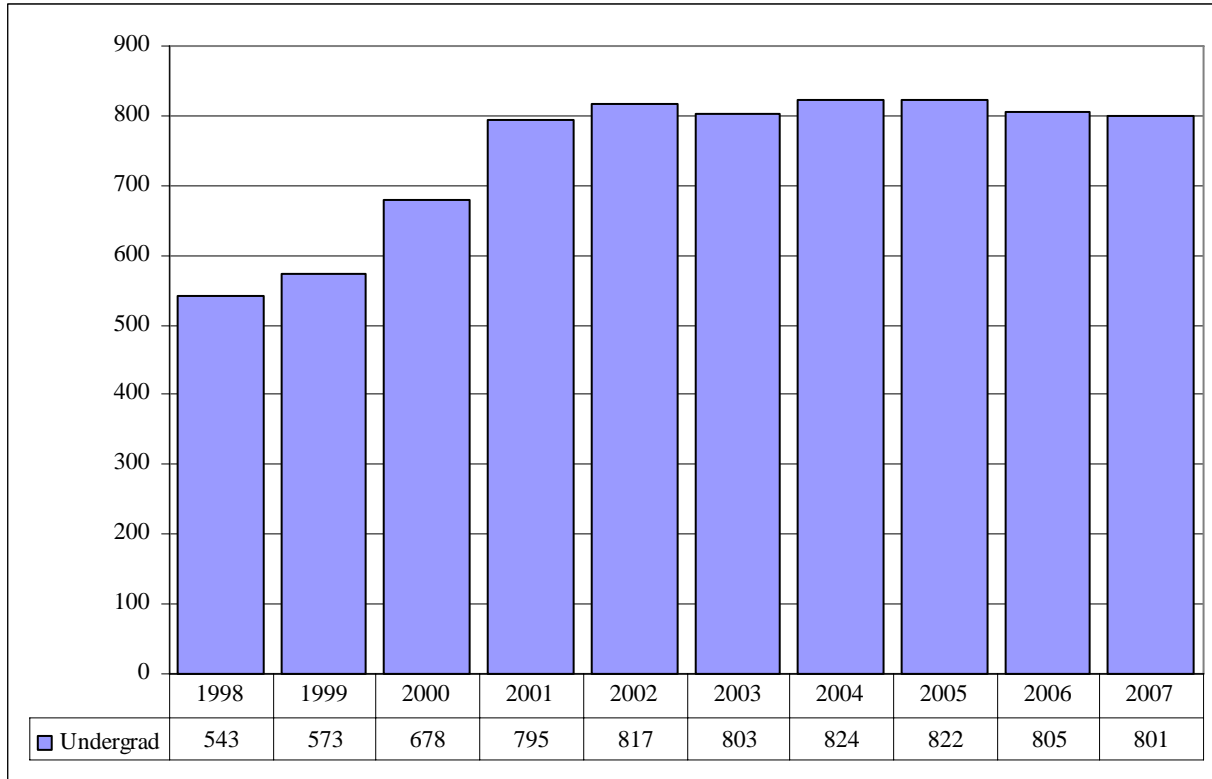

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

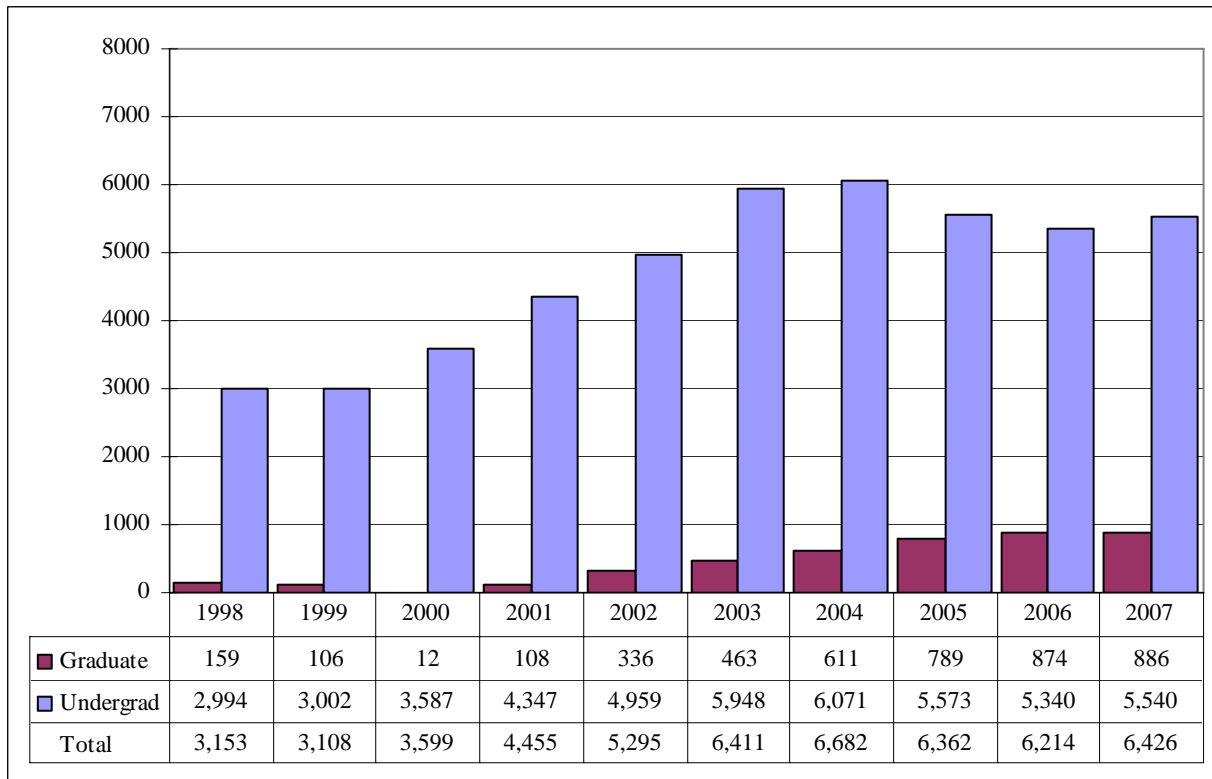
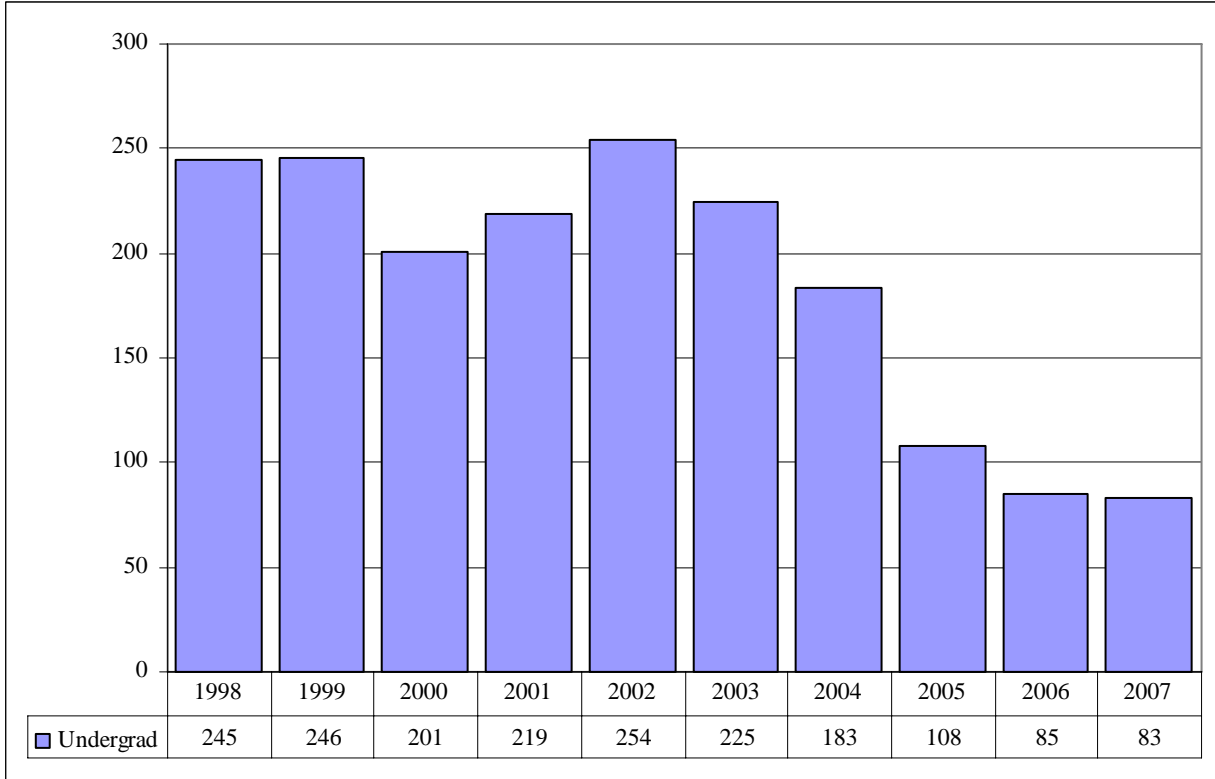

Student Credit Hours by Course Level

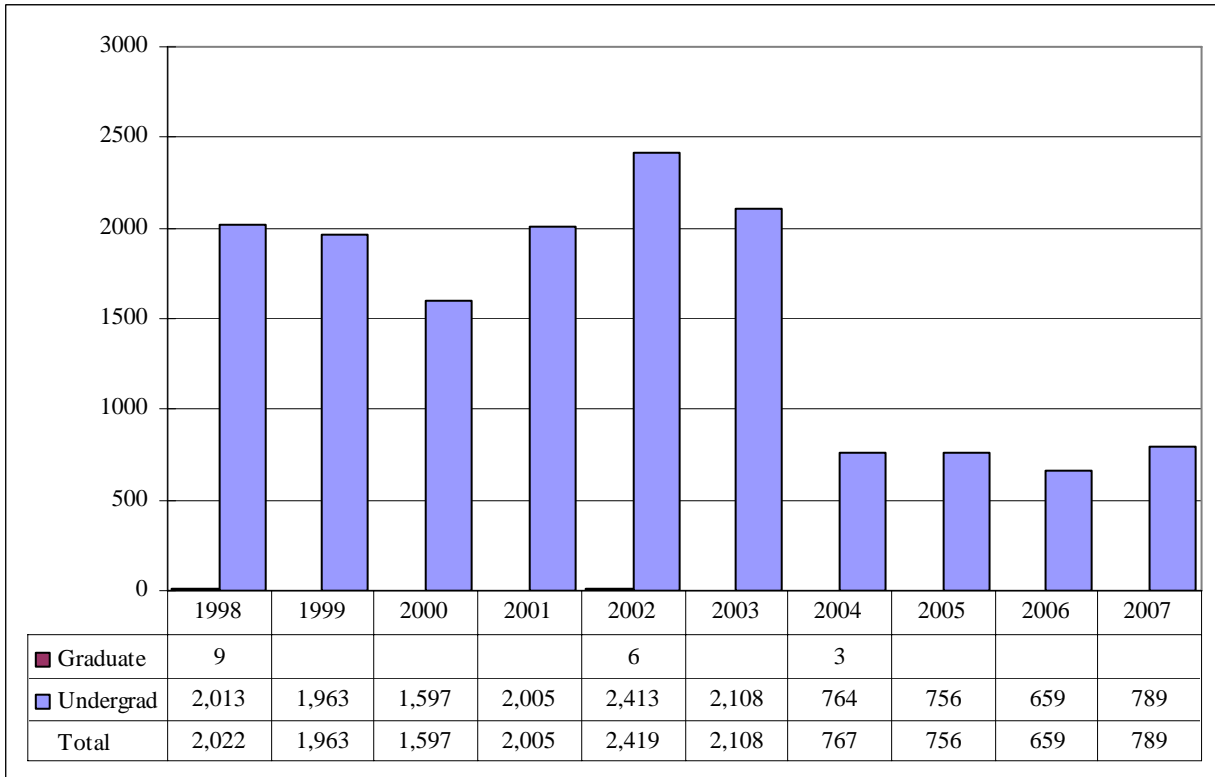
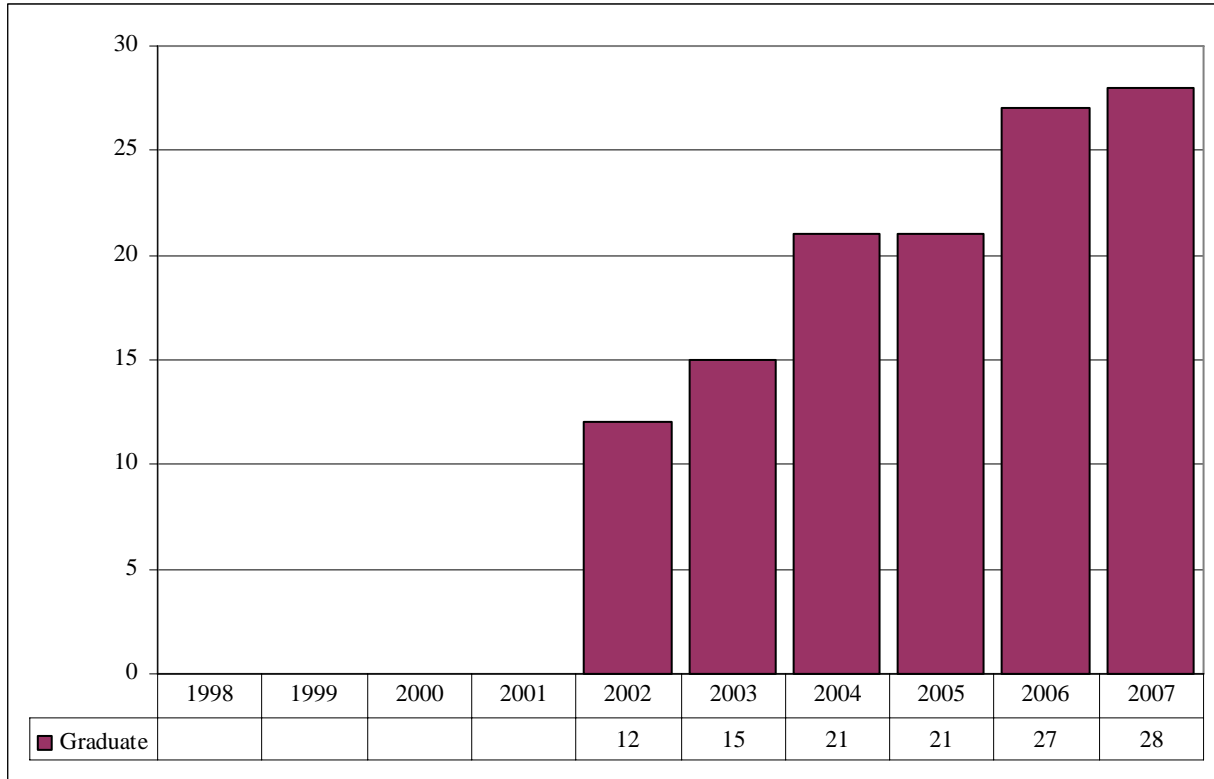

Head Count by Student Level



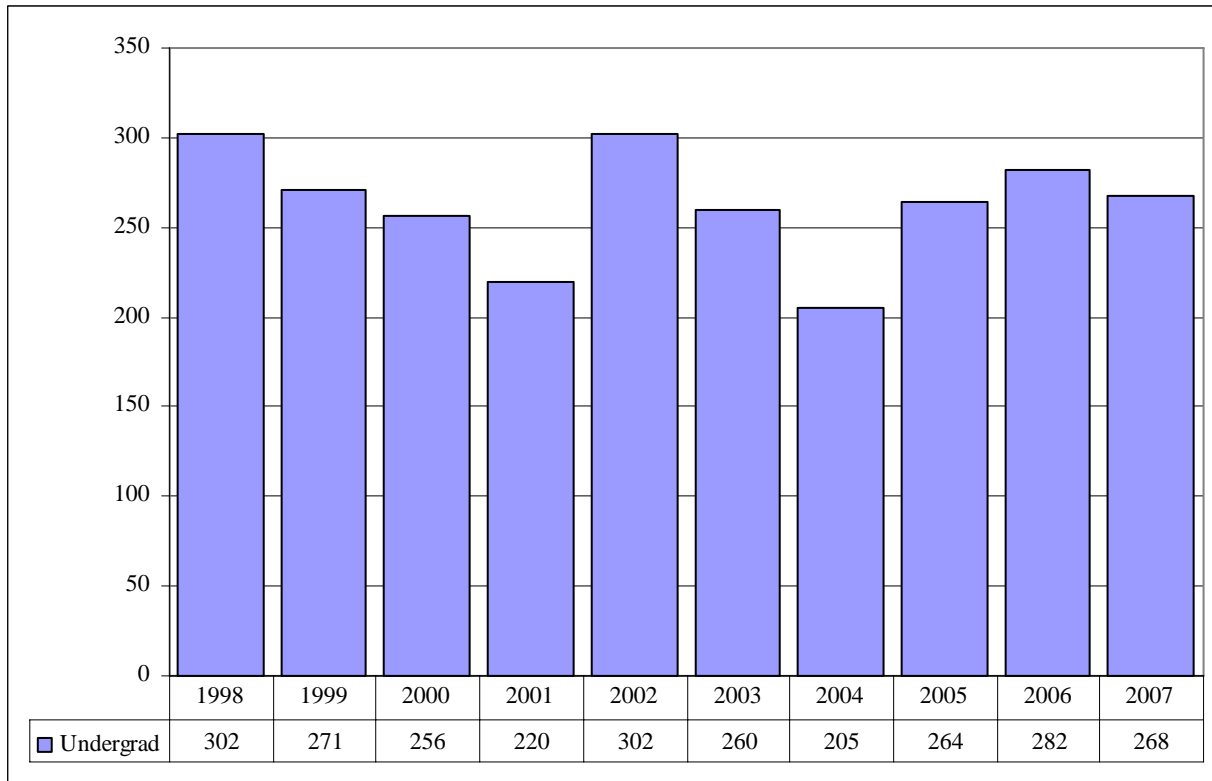

Glossary

Except where noted, the total head count and student credit hours in this enrollment report are provided on a delivery-site basis. Delivery-site includes enrollment in all courses taught at UNO regardless of "home" campus. This means that student credit hours are reported for courses in the colleges. Student enrollment is counted in the college declared by the student. Specifically, the delivery-site enrollment numbers include students in degree programs in the UNL Colleges of Agriculture, Architecture, Engineering and Technology, and Education and Human Science.

FIRST-TIME, Entering (freshmen) Student: Students attending any institution for the first time at the undergraduate level. For students entering the fall term, this includes students enrolled in the fall term who attended college for the first time in the prior summer term. Also included are students who entered with advanced standing, i.e. college credits earned before graduation from high school.

OTHER FRESHMEN: At the beginning of the current semester, undergraduate students who (1) are not First-Time Freshmen and (2) have less than 27 semester hours earned from all institutions of higher education attended.

SOPHOMORES: At the beginning of the current semester, undergraduate students who have at least 27, but not more than 57, semester hours earned from all institutions of higher education attended.

JUNIORS: At the beginning of the current semester, undergraduate students who have at least 58, but not more than 90, semester hours earned from all institutions of higher education attended.

SENIORS: At the beginning of the current semester, undergraduate students who have at least 91 semester hours earned from all institutions of higher education attended.

NON-DEGREE/INTER-CAMPUS/SPECIAL UNDERGRADUATES: Special undergraduates not pursuing a degree at UNO in various programs: Inter-Campus UNMC, UNK, UNL, and Non-Degree.

NON-DEGREE/INTER-CAMPUS/SPECIAL GRADUATE STUDENTS: Special graduate students not pursuing a degree at UNO in various programs: Engineering Transfer Program, Inter-Campus UNMC, UNK, UNL, Inter-Campus UNL Graduate Psychology and Non-Degree.

MASTERS/SPECIALIST: Graduate students pursuing a degree less than doctoral.

DOCTORAL: Graduate students who have been accepted into a doctoral program.

FULL-TIME: In the current semester, undergraduate students enrolled for 12 or more semester hours, or graduate students enrolled for 9 or more semester hours.

PART-TIME: In the current semester, undergraduate students enrolled for less than 12 semester hours, or graduate students enrolled for less than 9 semester hours.

COOPERATIVE GRADUATE PROGRAM: Graduate students enrolled in Public Health or Human Resources and Training Programs offered cooperatively by two or more colleges.
