ACADEMIC REGALIA

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's and master's degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program.

ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECIPIENTS

The University of Nebraska at Omaha Alumni Association awards the Citation for Alumnus Achievement Award to distinguished alumni. The awards are presented each year at spring commencement to graduates who have achieved distinction in their chosen fields. This year's honorees are Joe Edmonson, Nancy L. O'Brien, and Rod D. Rhoden.

Joe Edmonson

Edmonson graduated from UNO in 1972 with a bachelor's degree in law enforcement and corrections. Four years later, he acquired his master's degree in criminal justice from UNO.

In 1969, Edmonson co-founded Omaha's Edmonson Youth Development Association, a non-profit organization devoted to providing a series of structured social and athletic programs to Omaha's inner-city youth. In the more than 25 years since the program started, thousands of at-risk youth have benefited from Edmonson's programs, many through the wrestling teams he oversees. He also has tutored youth in developing skills for a career in the television industry.

In 1990, the Edmonson Youth Development Association merged with the Metropolitan YMCA to further enhance and expand outreach efforts. Edmonson, along with his wife, Jean, continue as association directors.

Edmonson has been the recipient of numerous honors and awards, including one of President George Bush's "Thousand Points of Light."

Nancy L. O'Brien

O'Brien earned her master's degree from UNO in 1976. She went on to earn a doctoral degree from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln with an emphasis in program planning and design. She earned a bachelor's in education from UNL in 1972.

O'Brien retains her close ties with the university system as a member of the NU Board of Regents. She was elected to a six-year term in 1990, and in 1994 was chosen chairwoman of the eight-member board.

Five years ago, O'Brien was one of the founding partners of SmartPay, a Bellevue firm providing electronic processing of home banking and bill payment to financial institutions. She is senior vice president for business development responsible for the sales, marketing and training departments. She has been instrumental in shaping the strategic direction of the company.

Prior to a notable career in the banking field, O'Brien spent numerous years in the classroom, including seven with Omaha Public Schools. She also has been an administrator with Metropolitan Community College and an adjunct faculty member of the College of St. Mary.

Rod D. Rhoden

A native of Glenwood, Iowa, Rod D. Rhoden received his bachelor's degree from UNO in 1967. At UNO he was a member of both Sigma Phi Epsilon and Omicron Delta Kappa. He later attended law school in California before serving active duty in the U.S. Air Force Reserve.

While in California, Rhoden worked for various automobile dealerships in Orange County. He returned to Omaha in 1971 to begin his own auto business.

Nearly 25 years later, Rhoden now owns and operates numerous dealerships in Nebraska, Iowa and elsewhere. His Nebraska and Iowa interests also include a finance and insurance company.

His varied business enterprises also include a security service firm in Miami and airports and seaports in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He serves on several area boards, including the UNO Alumni Association Board of Directors.
