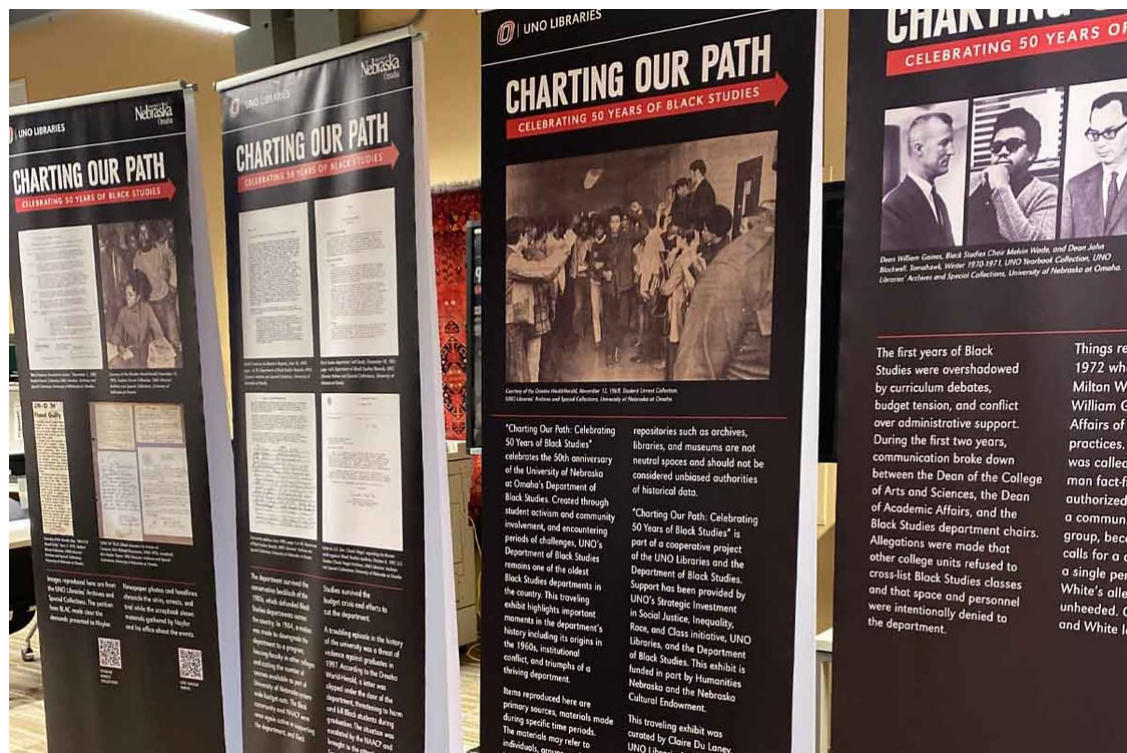

Charting Our Path Traveling Exhibit



Charting Our Path: Celebrating 50 Years of Black Studies is an 8-panel traveling exhibit sharing historical snapshots of one of the oldest Black Studies departments in the nation. The exhibit highlights the department's civil rights origins, attempts to downgrade the department to a program, and the mutual engagement between campus and community.

The exhibit is currently on display at the [Great Plains Black History Museum](#). Located on N. 24th Street, GPBHM's vision is to collect, preserve, and make available to the public materials documenting the Black experience. The UNO Libraries' traveling exhibit will be at the GPBHM until April 1, 2022, after which it will return to UNO Libraries until May 10th, 2022, when it will travel to the W. Dale Clark Library through June of 2022.

UNO Libraries Announces Open Access Publishing Pilot

University of Nebraska at Omaha authors whose articles are accepted for publication in Wiley “hybrid” journals between February 1 and December 31, 2022, may be able to have their work published open access (OA) at no cost to themselves. Associated costs (known as Article Processing Charges, or APCs) for these publications will be covered by the libraries.

As affiliated campuses, University of Nebraska at Omaha, University of Nebraska at Kearney, and University of Nebraska Medical Center join UNL in participating with the [Big Ten Academic Alliance \(BTAA\) libraries](#). The BTAA libraries have reached an [agreement](#) with Wiley for a one-year contract extension with an open access option, as a pilot in collective action toward BTAA’s Big Collection. This agreement begins on February 1, 2022, and runs through December 31, 2022. Over the course of 2022, BTAA will work toward a future agreement with Wiley.
