College and Career Success Course Overview

College and Career Success focuses on three primary themes: student sense of self, student as a learner, and developing linkages with the university community and career plans after UNO. This course is designed to prepare students to meet the individual and interpersonal challenges of college life.

What is a hybrid course?
