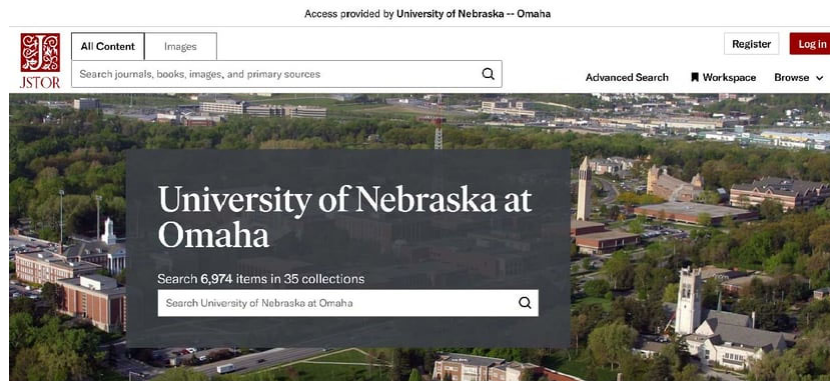
Starbucks at Criss Library

The digitized and born-digital material is arranged by its archival or manuscript collection such as the [UNO Photograph Collection](#), [UNO Newsletter Collection](#), [U.S. Senator Chuck Hagel Archives](#), [Sam Fried Papers](#), and [YMCA of Greater Omaha Records](#).

Through UNO Libraries' website, the nearly 7,000 digital objects are freely available online while being prepared for preservation for future generations. 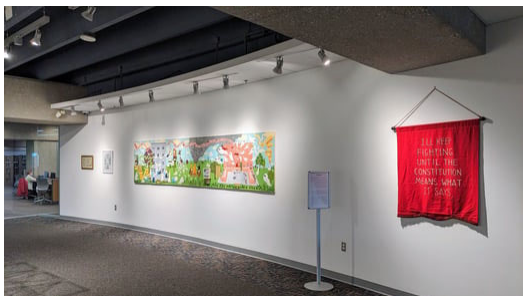
