### Covered in Art: A Celebration of UNO Magazine Exhibit

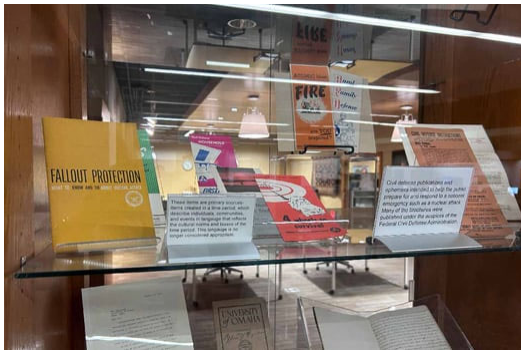
