ACADEMIC REGALIA

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program. All doctoral degree recipients are indicated by a gold tassel.

UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM

The University Honors Program is an all-University program which provides maximum educational opportunities for students of high ability through special multidisciplinary seminars and participation in an academic level not generally possible in usual curricular offerings.

The program is an outgrowth of the Arts and Sciences Honors program and was initiated in 1978. It is governed through the office of the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and administered through the Honors Coordinator. UNO colleges which implement honors programs include Arts and Sciences, Business Administration, Education, Fine Arts, Public Affairs and Community Service, and Information Science and Technology.

As part of their Honors Program requirements, students undertake a research project that results in a Senior Honors Thesis. Students and their thesis topics are listed at the end of the list of graduates. Students who have been designated in this booklet as Honors Program students have fulfilled the academic requirements of this program.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER AND HONORARY DOCTORATE RECIPIENT

ROBERT HEMENWAY

Robert Hemenway's life has been marked by accomplishments as an administrator, teacher and scholar. Since he graduated from the University of Nebraska at Omaha with a bachelor's degree in English in 1963 and from Kent State University with a doctorate in English in 1966, Hemenway has enjoyed a fulfilling career in the education field.

His academic career began at the University of Kentucky as an assistant professor of English, and from there he moved on to the University of Wyoming. Hemenway ultimately returned to Kentucky and became the chair of the department of English in 1981. In 1986, he took over as the dean of Arts and Sciences at the University of Oklahoma, and in 1989, he returned to Kentucky as chancellor of the university's Lexington campus.

Hemenway moved to his present position as chancellor for the University of Kansas in 1995. In this capacity, he oversees the main campus in Lawrence, the Medical Center in Kansas City, Kan., a clinical branch in Wichita, Kan. and the Edwards campus in Overland Park, Kan. In addition, Hemenway maintains his educational roots by teaching an undergraduate English course most semesters. The class is always scheduled at 7:30 a.m. - before he begins his duties as chancellor.

In his time at the University of Kansas, Hemenway has streamlined the university's administration, called for a renewed emphasis on science education and returned the university's focus to being student-centered. He also founded the Wheat State Whirlwind Tour, an annual faculty and staff bus tour that circles the state and visits most of Kansas' 105 counties.

In addition to his academic accomplishments, Hemenway is the author of a biography of Zora Neale Hurston - the Black woman novelist, anthropologist and folklorist. The book was selected as one of the "Best Books of 1978" by the New York Times.

STUDENT COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

BRIAN MULDREW

Brian Muldrew, a student from Carter Lake, Iowa, possesses the qualities teachers love to see in their students - a genuine love of learning, immense curiosity, the desire to excel and a determined work ethic. He is the 2001 recipient of the Political Science Honors Award, and his commencement address is titled "A Deeper Education."

Muldrew graduates summa cum laude with a bachelor of science degree in political science. In the future, he plans to attend law school and become involved in the political arena.

As a student, Muldrew was a member of the Golden Key International Honor Society, Phi Kappa Phi Honor Society, vice president of Phi Gamma Mu Social Sciences Honor Society, and he was the student representative for the political science department. He also was named to the Dean's List each semester at UNOmaha, and he was on the Chancellor's List (4.0 grade point average) for the fall 2000 semester.

In addition to his academic accomplishments, Muldrew works as a chef and caterer, and he is a member of the rock band Names Without Numbers. The band is known for using its music to provide a moral message to youth throughout the Midwest.

ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECIPIENT

MICHAEL DEFREECE

A 1967 UNOmaha alumnus, Michael DeFreece is managing partner at the Omaha office of Arthur Andersen. A Spalding, Nebraska native, DeFreece graduated from then-Omaha University 34 years ago with a bachelor's degree in accounting. That same year he joined Arthur Andersen.

In addition to his managing partner responsibilities, DeFreece has specialized in services to the healthcare and high-technology industries. A certified public accountant, he is a fellow in the Healthcare Financial Management Association and a member of the Nebraska Society and the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

While fostering his professional career DeFreece has been active in various civic endeavors, including participating in activities for the Omaha Chamber of Commerce, the Boy Scouts and the Omaha Regional Community of the Sisters of Mercy. He also has served as a member of the boards of directors for both Mercy High School and Mount Michael High School.

DeFreece was a longtime member of the UNOmaha Alumni Association Board of Directors. In fact, according to association records, he served longer than any other board member in the association's 88-year-history, joining the board in 1981 and serving as its treasurer. He later became chairman of the board, in 1998, before ending his service as past chairman in 1999.

DeFreece was a longtime fund-raiser for the association, first volunteering for the organization's national calling campaigns during the 1970s and later coordinating the internal giving program for UNOmaha graduates at Arthur Andersen. He received the association's Outstanding Service Award in 1999.

The Citation for Alumnus Achievement is presented each year at spring, summer and winter commencements to graduates who have achieved distinction in their careers. Since the Citation's inception 50 years ago the UNOmaha Alumni Association has honored more than 100 UNOmaha graduates with the award. The impressive list includes United States senators, military leaders, educators, artists, businessmen and women, entrepreneurs and many others who represent the best of UNOmaha graduates.

MIKE MILONE

Mike Milone, food services director at the University of Nebraska at Omaha, is the latest recipient of the Chancellor's Medal.

In his 12 years at UNOmaha, Milone has continually met the challenge of providing quality food and service to students, faculty, staff and the general public. He was instrumental in working with consultants on the redesign of the Milo Bail Student Center Food Court and kitchen. In addition to the tireless hours Milone works and his dedication to the job, he is known for the guidance he shows when working with the many students who are employed in his department.

Prior to his time at UNOmaha, Milone was the owner and manager of Kenny's Restaurant for 18 years. During that time, he also managed contracts with two hotels in Omaha and Des Moines, Iowa.

Milone is a certified executive chef with the American Culinary Federation, and he has served as president of the Omaha Restaurant Association, president and executive director of the Nebraska Culinary Association, and he is a member of the National Association of College and University Food Services. In 1997, he was inducted into the Omaha Hospitality Hall of Fame - an organization created to recognize the leaders in the industry and those who helped build Omaha's reputation for quality food and restaurants.

Throughout his food service career, Milone has given seminars and presentations on a variety of topics, including restaurant designs and concepts, hospitality business and accounting practices, cash operations and ice carvings.

In honor of his dedication and service, UNOmaha takes pride in recognizing Mike Milone as the May 2001 recipient of the Chancellor's Medal.

The Chancellor's Medal of the University of Nebraska at Omaha was established to recognize the contribution of faculty and administrative staff who embody the institution's mission and values. It is bestowed only to those within the university community who have demonstrated unusual excellence.

ORDER OF THE TOWER RECIPIENT

ROBERT CAMPOS

Integrity and quality are two components of the philosophy Robert Campos follows in the business world and in his personal life. Under his guidance, Campos Construction Company has grown from the company he started with \$500 to one that handles multi-million-dollar contracts both locally and nationally. All of his employees must follow his vision of high quality work and client satisfaction.

Campos began his construction career in 1961 as an apprentice carpenter with N.P. Dodge - Maple Village. In 1977, he founded his own construction company. He served as president and owner of Campos Construction Company until he sold the company in 2000. Today he serves as community liaison for Jacobs Facilities Inc. - a multi-million dollar company with 31,000 employees.

In addition to his professional duties, Campos is very active in his community. He serves on many boards of directors and advisory boards, including those of the Boys Scouts of America, Omaha Police Foundation, Omaha Community Foundation, UNOmaha Hispanic Leadership Board and the Youth Leadership Omaha Advisory Board.

For his volunteer efforts and business success, Campos has received numerous awards throughout his career. In 2000, he was awarded the School Bell Award from the Omaha Education Association for his distinguished service to public education, and in 1998 he received the Golden Spike Award from the Economic Council of the Greater Omaha Chamber of Commerce. Campos also has been named Nebraska Hispanic Man of the Year, South Omaha Business Leader of the Year and Volunteer of the Year by the Midwest Northeast Voter Registration Education Project. His business has received the Region 10 Construction Firm of the Year Award from the U.S. Department of Commerce, and the National Park Service Minority Contractor of the Year Special Commendation for work on the presidential homes of Abraham Lincoln, Herbert Hoover and Harry S. Truman.

The University of Nebraska at Omaha's highest non-academic award, the Order of the Tower, was first presented in 1964. Since that time, more than 70 individuals have received this honor, which symbolizes an ongoing commitment to the growth and development of the university.

The Order of the Tower is bestowed upon community leaders whose service and/or financial support has made it possible for the university to address the academic, cultural and economic needs of the people of Omaha and the citizens of Nebraska. Recipients of the award embody virtues and attributes valued highly by the university and are recognized as an example to others.
