## ACADEMIC REGALIA

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program. All doctoral degree recipients are indicated by a gold tassel.

### UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM

As part of their Honors Program requirements, students undertake a research project that results in a Senior Honors Thesis. Students and their theses topics are listed at the end of the list of graduates. Students who have been designated in this booklet as Honors Program students have fulfilled the academic requirements of this program.

## STUDENT COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

### ERIC O'BRIEN

Eric O'Brien, a native of Omaha, graduates today with a Bachelor of Arts in English, British Literature concentration. His commencement address is titled "The Poetics of Childbirth."

Before resuming his college education, O'Brien worked in promotions at the *Omaha World-Herald*, and as a director and marketing consultant for local theatres.

While at UNO, O'Brien served as president of Sigma Tau Delta, the international English Honor Society, and as an undergraduate writing tutor. He is the recipient of a Marian Basler Scholarship, a Sigma Tau Delta Senior Scholarship and the Student Honor Award for British Literature. Earlier this year, he presented his essay "Cultivating Destiny in Willa Cather's *O Pioneers!*" at the Sigma Tau Delta Annual Convention in Cincinnati, Ohio, and at the UNO Student Honors Symposium.

O'Brien plans to spend much of the summer hiking, wilderness backpacking and cycling. He and his wife, Jessica, are the parents of a two-year-old daughter, Abbey.

In September, the O'Briens will relocate to the West Coast where Eric will begin teaching and graduate study in British Romanticism and ecocriticism at the University of California, Davis.

# ORDER OF THE TOWER RECIPIENT

## J. TERRENCE HANEY

J. Terrence Haney has been a lifelong learner, friend and champion of UNO.

Haney began his career in the insurance industry. In 1964, he was named president and chief executive officer of Insurance Consultants Inc., an employee benefits firm. He earned his credential as a Certified Life Underwriter in 1973 from the American College of Bryn Mawr, Pennsylvania.

At the age of 49, Haney entered the UNO College of Continuing Studies as an undergraduate and received his degree at age 58. He then began work on his master's degree in gerontology and graduated in 1998 at the age of 65.

In 2001, the UNO Department of Gerontology was the beneficiary of a generous gift from Haney and his wife, Judy. The gift established an endowed faculty position and three funds supporting faculty members and eventually student scholarships.

The Terry Haney Chair of Gerontology was created to help the department attract or retain leading experts in gerontology. This endowed position not only helps build the critical mass of high-level faculty in the department, but also brings support for graduate students and research projects involving colleagues in gerontology and other university departments. The three faculty and student excellence funds are named in honor of UNO Professors Bruce Horacek, Chuck Powell and James A. Thorson. The funds initially will provide stipends awarded to gerontology faculty and will then convert to scholarships for gerontology students upon the departure of the honored professors from UNO.

In addition to his work with the gerontology department, Haney has served as an active member of UNO Library Friends. He is also the recipient of the UNO Alumni Association's Outstanding Service Award.

# ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

## LEONARD DE BARROS

Leonard de Barros is senior vice president for Motorola Inc., serving as general manager of Motorola Professional Services, Americas Region. He received his bachelor's degree from UNO in 1971.

de Barros has more than 30 years of experience in the telecommunication and service industry. He has an extensive background in business, research, development, engineering, manufacturing, logistics, marketing and sales.

de Barros joined Motorola in 1972 and has held positions of increasing responsibility in the company's communications, microelectronics, paging and messaging businesses. Following two successful assignments in the Far East, de Barros joined the paging division in 1986 as manager of technical operations. He was appointed Project "Bandit" operations manager in 1988, where his technical contribution to the industry has been featured in several books. Three years later, he was promoted to vice president and director of manufacturing operations for the paging division.

In 1993, de Barros was promoted to general manager of the newly formed global paging infrastructure division. He became general manager of the advanced messaging systems division later that year with the task of developing two-way messaging business/markets for paging. That same year, he was named Hispanic Engineer of the Year for Professional Achievement at the Hispanic Engineer National Achievement Awards Conference.

He was promoted to corporate vice president of Motorola in 1995 and then became general manager of the Advanced Messaging Group. As general manager, de Barros oversaw the worldwide operations of Motorola's Advanced Messaging Businesses, including research, development, engineering, manufacturing, marketing and sales. He also provided support for paging and messaging infrastructure technologies, as well as for two-way personal communications devices.

In June of 1997, de Barros joined the Motorola corporate office in the Americas Region as corporate vice president and president of Motorola in Latin America and the Caribbean. He was responsible for Motorola's overall business in the region and was Motorola's representative with the government there.

In November of 1999, de Barros was promoted to senior vice president of Motorola. He is the second senior officer in Motorola Latin America.

de Barros has attended several management and professional programs during his tenure. In 2001, he graduated from the Northwestern University Kellogg School of Management Executive Program. He is a member of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers and the American Society of Quality Control. He also has five U.S. patents and has received several awards for his inventions and contributions.

# ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

## STEVEN S. MARTIN

Steven S. Martin is president and chief executive officer of Blue Cross Blue Shield of Nebraska and a member of the company's board of directors. He earned his Master of Arts degree in gerontology from UNO in 1992 and has a Bachelor of Science degree from Washburn University.

Blue Cross Blue Shield of Nebraska, an independent licensee of the Blue Cross Blue Shield Association, provides health care coverage or benefit administration to more than 640,000 (one in three) Nebraskans. It is a not-for-profit mutual insurance company.

Martin also serves as president and CEO of the Omaha Life Insurance Co., Corporate Diversified Services Inc. (CDSI) and ProPar Services. All are wholly owned subsidiaries of Blue Cross Blue Shield of Nebraska. In addition, he serves on the board of directors for the Blue Cross Blue Shield Association in Chicago, Ill.; TriWest Healthcare Alliance in Phoenix, Ariz.; and Prime Therapeutics Inc. in Eagan, Minnesota. Martin also serves on the board of trustees of the Nebraska Council on Economic Education.

Prior to joining Blue Cross Blue Shield of Nebraska in March of 2002, Martin was president, CEO and a board member for Prime Therapeutics, a comprehensive pharmacy benefits solutions company owned by five Midwestern Blue Cross Blue Shield plans. It integrates pharmacy claim processing, drug manufacturer contracting, drug utilization analysis, clinical programs and consulting services into Blue Cross Blue Shield plans, as well as other regionally oriented health plans, HMOs and specialty pharmacy benefit organizations.

Martin spent more than 10 years with Blue Cross Blue Shield of Nebraska prior to joining Prime Therapeutics. Previous positions include vice president of Health Services Research and Reimbursement for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Nebraska and senior vice president for ProPar Services.

Additional professional experience includes stints as founding executive director for American HomeCare Inc., a comprehensive home health care company specializing in "high tech" services; regional manager of product development for the health care services division of the Upjohn Company; co-founder and vice president for HealthCheck Inc., a regional occupational and employee health services company; and clinical coordinator for adult inpatient care at the Menninger Foundation of Topeka, Kansas.

He is a certified professional in the Academy for Healthcare Management.

## CHANCELLOR'S MEDAL RECIPIENT

### RITA HENRY

Rita Henry is the assistant to the vice chancellor for Student Affairs at the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO). In conjunction with the planned reorganization of Student Affairs and Academic Affairs, she will assume additional responsibilities as assistant vice chancellor for student services.

Dr. Henry earned her Bachelor of Science degree in Elementary Education, and Human Development and the Family at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln (UNL) in 1973. She earned her M.S. in Human Development and the Family in 1981 and her Ph.D. in Administration, Curriculum and Instruction in 1994, also from UNL.

Prior to arriving at UNO in 1982, Dr. Henry worked in residence life at UNL and as executive director of St. James Children's Home, an agency of the archdiocese of Omaha.

In her current position, Dr. Henry prepares and monitors divisional budgets, works as a liaison between students and university offices, coordinates the Phil Schragger Scholarship Program for Student Leaders, serves as the Judicial Officer and coordinates the freshman honoraries program. She also has served on the Self-Study Team for North Central Accreditation and the Chancellor's Commission on the Status of Women, served two terms as chair of the Staff Advisory Council, and served as a member of a university-wide transition team that brought a new human resources and financial management system to all University of Nebraska campuses.

Dr. Henry serves on the board of directors of the Pacesetter Academy, and is a member of the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators and the Association for Student Judicial Affairs. She has been inducted into Omicron Delta Kappa, a national leadership honorary, and Alpha Sigma Lambda, a continuing studies honorary.

In addition to her campus involvement, Dr. Henry is an active participant in her community. She has served on a variety of committees at St. Pius X church and helps prepare food for the Siena/Francis House each month. She is a former member of the Child Welfare League of America, the Council for Services to Children and Youth, and the board of directors of the Child Abuse Council of Omaha.

# **COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER AND HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT**

## **RICHARD W. RILEY**

Richard W. Riley is the former U.S. Secretary of Education (1993-2001) and former governor of South Carolina (1979-1987). He currently is a senior partner in the law firm of Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough, L.L.P, with offices throughout South Carolina and North Carolina, as well as in Atlanta. Secretary Riley counsels clients and works with partners to develop strategy on complex business, governance, financial and legal matters for local, national and international clients.

With the full support of the firm, Secretary Riley remains an ambassador for improving education in the United States and abroad. He has been appointed Distinguished Professor at his alma mater, Furman University, and serves as advisory board chair of the Richard W. Riley Institute of Government, Politics and Public Leadership there. He also has been named Distinguished Professor at the University of South Carolina, and the College of Education at Winthrop University bears his name. Secretary Riley is also a Distinguished Senior Fellow at NAFSA: Association of International Educators in Washington, D.C., where he maintains his national education office. In addition, he speaks, provides leadership and serves in an advisory and collaborative capacity with many other entities across the nation and abroad that support education improvement.

Secretary Riley earned his bachelor's degree, cum laude, in political science from Furman University in 1954 and received a J.D. from the University of South Carolina School of Law in 1959. He is the recipient of numerous education and other public service awards, as well as honorary degrees from universities and colleges in the United States and abroad.

Secretary Riley has visited Omaha on a number of occasions and was locally recognized for his contributions to education. On his last visit, he was present for the dedication of The University of Nebraska Peter Kiewit Institute. In September 1998, he recognized the UNO College of Education's CADRE Project as an exemplary program in "Promising Practices: New Ways to Improve Teacher Quality."
