PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY

The National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) collects enrollment data through this component of IPEDS each year in order to update several annual publications including its college enrollment projections, the Digest of Education Statistics, and the Condition of Education. IPEDS fall enrollment by age of student offers insight into the relationship between the changing demographics of college-going cohorts and enrollment in different types of postsecondary institutions. The residence data will enable States to analyze State level college attendance rates, student in-migration or out-migration, and the type of institutions that attract their citizens to other States. The survey is being conducted in compliance with the Center's mission "to collect and analyze and disseminate statistics and other data related to education in the United States" (20 U.S.C. 1221e–1, General Education Provisions Act, Sec. 406(b), as amended).

USES OF DATA
