

- 2. Call to volunteer to drive
- 3. Call to get your questions answered regarding the election

Here's is what the efforts have been by the Black Votes Matter crew:

- Purchased and paid for 1050 yard signs,
- Distributed 1030 yard signs to date,
- Demand for the yard signs continues at a fever pitch,
- Distributed 50 Black Votes Matter buttons,
- Presentations at 2 OPS schools on voting,
- Registered over 150 new voters,
- Distributed and submitted over 175 early votes,
- Presentations to 4 neighborhood associations,
- Presentation to the OHA tower presidents,

- Presentations to 3 OHA tower resident Meetings,
- Presentations to 2 senior homes,
- Distributed 2000 League of Women Voter's Voter Guides,
- Organized 2 Voter registrar trainings (30 Attendees),
- Presentation to UNO Malcolm X Festival,
- Presentation to Empowerment Network meeting,
- Conducted North Omaha candidate development workshops,
- Coordinating the *IMA 10K: Race to the Poll*, (Combined North Omaha clergy and partners):
 - ** Goal to register 10,000 new voters this summer,
 - ** Trained 25 voter registrars,
 - ** Partners include churches from most denominations,
 - ** Partners include League of Women Voters, Activate85, Urban league Young Professionals and more joining,
- Black Votes Matter Omaha Star column (since August, 2015),
- Initiated the North Omaha Ride to the Polls # 402.575.0144.
