ACADEMIC REGALIA

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program. All doctoral degree recipients are indicated by a gold tassel.

UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM

The University Honors Program is an all-University program which provides maximum educational opportunities for students of high ability through special multidisciplinary seminars and participation in an academic level not generally possible in usual curricular offerings.

The program is an outgrowth of the Arts and Sciences Honors program and was initiated in 1978. It is governed through the office of the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and administered through the Honors Coordinator. UNO colleges which implement honors programs include Arts and Sciences; Business Administration; Education; Public Affairs and Community Service; Information Science and Technology; and Communication, Fine Arts and Media.

As part of their Honors Program requirements, students undertake a research project that results in a Senior Honors Thesis. Students and their theses topics are listed at the end of the list of graduates. Students who have been designated in this booklet as Honors Program students have fulfilled the academic requirements of this program.

CHANCELLOR'S MEDAL RECIPIENT

DANIEL KENNY

Daniel Kenny is senior Web architect with information technology services at the University of Nebraska at Omaha. He is responsible for designing and implementing services available via the Web, including E-BRUNO Web registration, business intelligence systems and application security.

In 1993, Kenny joined UNO as a programmer/analyst II in the former Department of Computing and Data Communications. Additionally, he has served as manager of information systems and Web processes for Student Enrollment Services and as a senior systems analyst for information technology services, until being named to his current post in 2004.

Before coming to UNO, he was employed as a technical analyst at Norwest Bank, where he re-engineered manual processes via computer and eliminated the keypunch/card reader machines. His work at Norwest, which was highly customer-centered and incorporated the use of technology to automate and streamline processes, helped prepare him for his service to UNO.

At UNO, Kenny has been instrumental in the implementation of the Better Registration at UNO (BRUNO) touch-tone telephone registration system. With the addition of BRUNO, students' registration time was reduced from two hours of arena style to less than five minutes by phone.

As the Internet expanded, so did UNO's student-based Web services. Kenny has been a vital component of this growth, especially the current E-BRUNO system. Students can now register for classes via the Web in seconds, in addition to changing their address listings, ordering transcripts, paying tuition and fees online, and completing many administrative tasks. This integrated approach of the campus UNO Student Information System with the Web has also been adopted by the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, saving the entire University of Nebraska system tens of thousands of dollars in software costs.

Additional streamlined student Web services that Kenny has helped provide include integrating the Student Information System with the Blackboard course delivery system, online grade posting and accessibility, and e-FAN, UNO's online financial aid award notification system. He also works behind-the-scenes on a variety of other projects that help make the UNO experience more convenient for students.

Active in the university community, Kenny served as a representative on the UNO Computer Usage Committee from 1996-2000 and chaired the administrative subcommittee in 1999-2000. He was honored as a UNO Employee of the Month in 1995 and received commendations from the UNO Student Government in 1999 and 2000. His contributions have led to UNO being named to the top 100 "Most Wired Universities."

Additionally, Kenny was a member of the Nebraska Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (NACRAO) from 1996-2000. He received three certificates of appreciation for service to the NACRAO in 1998, 1999 and 2000. In 2002, he was awarded the Information Technology Services Rave Review commendation. He also helped build Web presence for the Open Door Mission and holds membership in the Association for Computing Machinery and the Nebraska/Iowa Information Builders User Group.

The Chancellor's Medal at the University of Nebraska at Omaha was established to recognize the contribution of faculty and administrative staff who embody the institution's mission and values. It is bestowed only to those within the university community who have demonstrated unusual excellence.

STUDENT COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

JESSICA L. YINCIK

Jessica L. Vincik, an Aurora, Neb., native, graduates today with a bachelor of science in criminal justice. Her commencement address is titled "Foundations for the Future."

While it takes many students four years to complete a bachelor's degree, Vincik finished hers in three-and-a-half years. She also completed an internship with the U.S. Marshals Service during her sophomore/junior year at UNO.

On campus, Vincik was involved with a variety of organizations, including Omicron Delta Kappa Leadership Honor Society (president), Chi Omega Sorority (vice president), Student Government (chief administrative officer), Order of Omega Greek Honor Society (secretary), Emerging Leaders Program and Circle K. She also served as a student orientation leader.

Her honors include membership in Golden Key International Honor Society and serving as a member of the Vice Chancellor's Leadership Council. In addition, she was elected homecoming queen in the fall of 2005 and was named the Student Organizations and Leadership Programs Student Leader of the Month in November of 2004.

Vincik said she is proud to have been involved with the Student Government Senate that worked to contribute funds for the climbing wall in the Health, Physical Education and Recreation Building because it is something that many students can benefit from.

In her free time, Vincik enjoys reading and horseback riding, in addition to attending rodeos and spending time with family and friends.

She plans to attend law school next fall and hopes to someday become a district attorney or attorney general of Nebraska.

ORDER OF THE TOWER

HARLAN NODDLE

The late Harlan Noddle was chairman of the board of Noddle Companies, one of the Midwest's largest developers of community shopping centers and office buildings.

He received a bachelor of arts degree in economics from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln in 1958. From 1959-1961, Noddle was a first lieutenant in the U.S. Army Security Agency.

Upon completion of his military service, Noddle joined American Community Stores Corporation, which operated a regional chain of supermarkets, leased supermarket departments and general-line merchandise stores located throughout the United States and the Caribbean. In the decade he was employed there, Noddle served in a variety of capacities, from managing the Store Planning Department to being named group vice president.

In 1973, he started his own business, Noddle Development Company. Currently, the company has developed or purchased more than 85 shopping centers and five office buildings in 16 states. In all, the projects cover more than 8.5 million square feet. The company offers a variety of development and management services, from site acquisition through financing, construction and property management.

An active community leader, Noddle served as chairman of the University of Nebraska Foundation Board of Directors and on the boards of the Omaha Symphony and Omaha Airport Authority. In addition, he served on the Midlands Region Board of Governors for the National Conference for Community and Justice.

He also was president of the Murray H. and Sharee C. Newman Supporting Foundation and a trustee of the organization. A member of the Executive Committee of the American Israel Public Affairs Committee, he was a past chairman of the Board of Directors of the University of Nebraska Medical Center.

The Order of the Tower is UNO's highest non-academic award. It is bestowed upon community leaders whose service and/or financial support has made it possible for the university to address the academic, cultural and economic needs of the people of Omaha and citizens of Nebraska. Recipients of the award embody virtues and attributes valued highly by the university and are recognized as an example to others.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

PAIGE MULHOLLAN

Paige Mulhollan has been a leading force in the creation of the "metropolitan university" concept and the establishment of the Coalition of Urban and Metropolitan Universities (CUMU). The University of Nebraska at Omaha is a member of the coalition, which currently has a membership of more than 80 institutions throughout the United States and internationally.

CUMU strives to unite institutions that aim for national excellence while contributing to the economic development, social health and cultural vitality of the urban or metropolitan centers they serve. Groundbreaking work completed by Mulhollan has provided the framework for today's modern metropolitan universities, which encourage mutually beneficial activities for students and the communities they reside in.

He earned a bachelor of science in business administration (1956), as well as a master of arts in history (1962), from the University of Arkansas. In 1966, he received his Ph.D. in history from the University of Texas, Austin.

As an advocate for education, Mulhollan has been active in many capacities. He has taught and held administrative positions at several universities, including the University of Arkansas, Kansas State University, University of Oklahoma, Arizona State University and Wright State University. At Wright State, Mulhollan served as president and professor of history from July of 1985 until his retirement in January of 1994.

Mulhollan also has been involved with a variety of professional organizations, including the President's Commission of the National Collegiate Athletics Association, National Advisory Committee to Air Force ROTC, Air Force Institute of Technology Foundation Board of Directors, and the American Association of State Colleges and Universities Board of Directors. He also served on 21 evaluation teams (nine as chair) for the North Central Association and has been a consultant in the Education Programs Division for the National Endowment for the Humanities.

In addition, he has presented at a variety of conferences and meetings across the country and has given more than 100 oral history interviews with personalities associated with the Johnson administration. His publications include articles in *Arizona Electronics* and the *Encyclopedia of American Biography*, among others.

Mulhollan remains active in the community by teaching at Hilton Head Elderhostel and volunteering his time to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and as a member of the Hilton Head Island Land Trust.

ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECIPIENT

JAMES YOUNG

James Young has been president and chief operating officer of Union Pacific Railroad since January of 2004. He earned a bachelor of science degree in business administration from the University of Nebraska at Omaha in 1978.

Young also was elected director of Union Pacific Corporation in February of 2005. He is responsible for the railroad's operation, information technology, and marketing and sales. The largest railroad in North America, Union Pacific has nearly 33,000 route miles, covering 23 states across two-thirds of the western United States. It is the nation's largest hauler of chemicals and moves more than 250 million tons of coal each year. UP also makes \$3.9 billion in purchases, employs 48,000 and has a payroll of \$3.3 billion.

An Omaha native, Young graduated from Omaha South High School. While attending UNO, he also worked at Northwestern Bell. Upon graduating from UNO, he began his career with UP, where he has held a variety of professional, managerial and senior management positions.

In 1995, Young was named vice president of re-engineering and design. He became vice president of customer service planning and quality in 1997, followed by a promotion to senior vice president and corporate treasurer of Union Pacific Corporation in 1998, and senior vice president of finance and corporate controller in March of 1999. In December of 1999, Young was named executive vice president of finance and chief financial officer of Union Pacific Corporation, a position he held until being appointed to his current post.

Active in the community, he serves on the board of directors of Grupo Ferroviario Mexicano, is area chairman of the United Way of the Midlands campaign cabinet and has served on the boards of Girls Incorporated and the Nebraska Council on Economic Education.

One of three UNO graduates on Union Pacific's executive staff, Young is also the third UP employee to receive the Citation for Alumnus Achievement.
