## ACADEMIC REGALIA

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program. All doctoral degree recipients are indicated by a gold tassel.

## UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM

The University Honors Program is a University-wide program providing maximum educational opportunities for students of high ability through special multidisciplinary seminars and participation in an academic level not generally possible in usual curricular offerings.

The program is an outgrowth of the Arts and Sciences Honors program and was initiated in 1978. It is governed through the office of the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and administered through the Honors Coordinator. UNO colleges which implement Honors Programs include Arts and Sciences; Business Administration; Education; Public Affairs and Community Service; Information Science and Technology; and Communication, Fine Arts and Media.

As part of their Honors Program requirements, students undertake a research project that results in a Senior Honors Thesis. Students and their majors are listed at the end of the list of graduates. Students who have been designated in this booklet as Honors Program students have fulfilled the academic requirements of this program. Honors Program graduates wear blue and scarlet Honors cords.

## WEITZ FAMILY FOUNDATION

The Weitz Family Foundation was established in 2001, based on a life-long commitment to family, community service and philanthropy. Barbara and Wally Weitz, along with their children, serve as directors of the foundation and make decisions about philanthropic gifts through family consensus.

The foundation seeks to support those who advocate its mission of empowering individuals, agencies and organizations that work to improve quality of life and promote an equitable and peaceful society. Particular interests include education, public housing and the arts.

Barbara and Wally met while freshmen at Carleton College in Northfield, Minn. They married shortly after graduation from Carleton in 1970. All three of their children went on to receive degrees from Carleton, as well.

After graduating from Carleton with a bachelor of arts degree in economics, Wally began a career in business. For the next 13 years, he gained experience in security analysis and by working as an analyst and portfolio manager. In 1983, he founded the Omaha money management firm Weitz Funds, which now manages more than \$2 billion in investments.

In addition to earning a bachelor of arts degree in government from Carleton, Barbara went on to receive a master of public administration degree from New York University and a master of social work degree from the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO). She also engaged in doctoral studies in social welfare at the Mandel School at Case Western University in Cleveland.

Barbara became familiar with service learning - the practice of applying classroom lessons in real-world settings to benefit the community - as a former instructor in the UNO School of Social Work. She and several colleagues lent their talents to the innovative use of service learning in social work education, resulting in the publication of the first book on the subject.

Through their foundation, the Weitz family has donated millions of dollars to dozens of nonprofit organizations, including the University of Nebraska Foundation. Recent gifts have benefitted a variety of service learning initiatives at UNO, the Stephenson Internships in the UNO Goodrich Program and the renovation of the former Engineering Building at UNO, which now houses the College of Public Affairs and Community Service.

Along with generous financial support, Barbara and Wally have provided exemplary leadership on social issues affecting the community. They also support innovative, grassroots organizations designed to meet the emerging needs of the community along with well-established, local affiliates of national nonprofits. In collaboration with a small group of major donors, they launched the Building Bright Futures initiative, a community-driven effort addressing the academic achievement of Omaha youth.

Barbara co-authored "The Women and Leadership Report," which provides insight on the status of women's leadership in Omaha and discusses numerous strategies to address the issue. In 2007, she received the WomanSpirit Award from the Women's Fund of Greater Omaha for her efforts and leadership.



# ORDER OF THE TOWER RECIPIENT

## RONALD W. ROSKENS

Ronald W. Roskens has compiled a career of distinction, including service ranging from the field of education to high levels of government. He is the former chancellor of the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) and former president of the University of Nebraska (NU).

Dr. Roskens holds degrees from the University of Northern Iowa and the University of Iowa, where he earned his doctorate in 1958. He also is the recipient of 15 honorary degrees from other institutions of higher learning.

He began his tenure as UNO chancellor in 1972 after serving Kent State University for 13 years as a professor and, eventually, executive vice president. In 1977, he was named NU president and served in that capacity for 13 years.

As NU president, he brought an international perspective to the university, developing exchange programs with universities in Asia, Latin America, Europe and China. Dr. Roskens also negotiated an exchange program with Kabul University in Afghanistan and oversaw the development of the UNO Center for Afghanistan Studies.

In 1990, President George Bush spoke at Dr. Roskens' swearing-in ceremony when he became the administrator of the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID). At that time, USAID had an annual program budget of \$8.1 billion for initiatives on economic and humanitarian assistance to more than 100 countries. Dr. Roskens oversaw a major restructuring of the agency, making it a more streamlined organization. Initiatives he helped implement to focus programs on democratization, the environment, the family and the role of private business in economic development have been widely recognized as bringing USAID more in line with post-Cold War priorities.

At the beginning of 1996, he became president of Global Connections Inc., an international business consulting firm. From 1996 to 1998, he also served as interim executive officer of the Omaha Public Library. He later was appointed honorary Consul General of Japan and elected to the advisory board of the World Food Programme, a United Nations Agency headquartered in Rome, Italy.

Dr. Roskens currently serves as a director of ConAgra Foods Inc., the Silverstone Group, the Russian Farm Community Project and the Capitol Federal Foundation of Topeka, Kan. He also is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations and is a licensed minister in the United Church of Christ.

## ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

### LLOYD E. ROITSTEIN

Lloyd E. Roitstein has been scout executive/president of the Mid-America Council of the Boy Scouts of America for the past 17 years. The largest youth-serving agency in Nebraska, the council is among the nation's largest geographically and in number of youth served. Roitstein has served for 38 years in numerous leadership roles with the Scouts.

An Eagle Scout, Roitstein has been involved in Scouting since age eight. His father was a scoutmaster and member of the council board, and his mother served in a number of leadership positions. Roitstein grew up in Omaha and attended Central High School before enrolling at Omaha University in 1964. He also served in the U.S. Army Reserve while in college.

At the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO), he served on the Student Senate and with the Student Programming Organization and was chair of the Committee for Athletic Promotion. Roitstein also served as the last Ouampi, the mascot when the university's nickname was the Indians. As Ouampi, Roitstein performed authentic American Indian dances, which he learned through Scouting. In 1971, he received his bachelor's degree in education from UNO.

His first position with the Boy Scouts was serving as district executive in Omaha from 1971 to 1974. He later became field director and then director of field service for the Mid-America Council (1974 to 1983) before moving to Belleville, Ill., where he was scout executive for a nine-county area in southern Illinois from 1984 to 1988.

He moved to St. Louis and became area director, serving eight councils in Iowa, Illinois and Missouri from 1988 to 1992, when he assumed his current post. Roitstein is responsible for council operational goals to expand Scouting, strategic planning, endowment development, council funding, board of directors recruitment and other duties. In 2008, he received the Boy Scouts of America's Distinguished Executive Award.

Roitstein was a member of the UNO Alumni Association Board of Directors from 1997 to 2002. He also served as a board member or in other capacities with the Kiwanis and Rotary Clubs, Jewish Press of Omaha, Jewish Federation, ServeNET and Friedel Academy. He also has been a soccer coach and held school, synagogue and homeowner association leadership roles.

His dedication and leadership skills were evident last summer when a tornado struck the council's Little Sioux Scout Ranch in Iowa's Loess Hills, about 60 miles north of Omaha. Roitstein attended to the camp soon after receiving news of the tornado, helping with search-and-rescue missions and providing the Scouts' public response in press conferences and media interviews.

In August, Roitstein accompanied Scouts who were at the Little Sioux Scout Ranch, along with their parents and other individuals, to the White House for a meeting with President George W. Bush. The Little Sioux Scout Ranch is now being rebuilt through a \$1.8 million reconstruction effort.
