ACADEMIC REGALIA

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program. All doctoral degree recipients are indicated by a gold tassel.

UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM

The University Honors Program is a University-wide program providing maximum educational opportunities for students of high ability through special multidisciplinary seminars and participation in an academic level not generally possible in usual curricular offerings.

The program is an outgrowth of the Arts and Sciences Honors program and was initiated in 1978. It is governed through the office of the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and administered through the Honors Coordinator. UNO colleges which implement Honors Programs include Arts and Sciences; Business Administration; Education; Public Affairs and Community Service; Information Science and Technology; and Communication, Fine Arts and Media.

As part of their Honors Program requirements, students undertake a research project that results in a Senior Honors Thesis. Students and their majors are listed at the end of the list of graduates. Students who have been designated in this booklet as Honors Program students have fulfilled the academic requirements of this program. Honors Program graduates wear blue and scarlet Honors cords.

A Mammel Business Scholar, Treinen was named to the Dean's List each semester at UNO and earned a spot on the Chancellor's List twice. He received a Chancellor's Scholarship, the 2009 Beta Gamma Sigma Leadership Award and was named the 2010 Outstanding Student in Marketing. Treinen also was a member of numerous honor societies, including Beta Gamma Sigma, Delta Epsilon Iota, Alpha Lambda Delta, Phi Eta Sigma, Phi Kappa Phi and Golden Key Honor Society.

An interest in creative endeavors, especially advertising and branding, led to his involvement with the UNO Ad Club, Student Marketing Association and American Advertising Federation. He also has enjoyed making a tangible mark on the community by building and painting houses for Habitat for Humanity.

In 2009, Treinen represented UNO in Washington, D.C., at the Beta Gamma Sigma Student Leadership Forum. He values the relationships gained from that event.

Following commencement, Treinen and a group of UNO students will travel to the United Kingdom to experience London and Ireland. After a side trip to Wales, he will begin working full-time at TD AMERITRADE, where he has interned for the past year.

An avid music fan, he has more than 700 CDs in his collection. Treinen also enjoys drawing, painting and computer design. CHANCELLOR'S MEDAL RECIPIENT

NEAL GRANDGENETT

Neal Grandgenett joined the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) Department of Teacher Education in 1989. He currently serves as a professor of education in the College of Education, where he teaches undergraduate and graduate courses in mathematics education and research methods.

Dr. Grandgenett began taking classes at UNO after serving in the U.S. Marine Corps. He received his bachelor of science in education degree from UNO in 1983 and a master of science in education degree from the university in 1986. He went on to earn a doctorate in curriculum and instruction from Iowa State University in 1989.

He has served on more than 60 dissertation and thesis committees at UNO and often helps students with the statistical analyses of their study data. He particularly enjoys working with students who will soon be teachers and strives to help them recognize the special joy and responsibility of helping young people reach their potential.

His research interests include the development and evaluation of technology-based learning environments in mathematics and science, and he has authored more than 100 articles and research papers on these topics.

A frequent grant writer and collaborator, he has received more than \$4 million in external funding while at UNO. He is a current co-investigator on two educational robotics projects funded by the National Science Foundation. He also is a software review editor for the *Mathematics and Computer Education Journal*, published internationally.

Extensively involved in the local community, he routinely helps school districts refine their mathematics courses, provide additional training for their teachers and examine the effectiveness of new curriculums. He also assists organizations and area community colleges with evaluating the effectiveness of their educational programs and analyzing statistical data. Dr. Grandgenett works directly with community-based organizations trying to improve their local communities.

Dr. Grandgenett has received many awards for his teaching, research and service efforts, including the UNO Alumni Teaching Award, UNO Distinguished Research and Creativity Award, Peter Kiewit Professorship, Paul Kennedy Diamond Professorship, Nebraska Technology Professor of the Year Award and the NASA Mission Home Award. A 4th Degree Black Belt in Tae Kwon Do, he teaches Saturday morning martial arts classes at the Nebraska Academy of Martial Arts.

The Chancellor's Medal at the University of Nebraska at Omaha was established to recognize the contribution of faculty and administrative staff who embody the institution's mission and values. It is bestowed only to those within the university community who have demonstrated unusual excellence.

ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

J. TERRENCE HANEY

Lifelong Omahan J. Terrence Haney has led a business career encompassing dedication to education and service to the community. He earned both of his degrees from the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) - a bachelor of general studies degree in 1991 and a master's degree in gerontology in 1998.

Haney graduated from Creighton Prep in 1951, later attending Creighton University. He became a Chartered Life Underwriter in 1972 through studies with Bryn Mawr College in Pennsylvania and has earned insurance- and financial-related certificates on a variety of subjects through other institutions.

In 1999, Haney retired as chief executive officer and principal owner of Insurance Consultants and Pay Flex Systems USA. Founded in 1964, Insurance Consultants is one of the nation's top 10 third party administrators working with employers to administer benefit spending accounts, COBRA and Transit programs.

Haney has contributed to UNO in numerous capacities. With his wife, Judy, he established an endowed faculty position in 2001, along with three funds supporting gerontology faculty. Haney chairs the Department of Gerontology board of advisors and has funded student scholarships. He also has served the UNO Library Friends and was a member of the National Advisory Board for the College of Business Administration and the Origination Committee for the UNO hockey team.

Very active in the community, he has served on the board of directors for or as a member of numerous organizations, including the Omaha Community Foundation, Creighton Prep, the American Red Cross, Girls Incorporated, Roncalli High School, the Creighton University Athletic Booster Club, St. Margaret Mary School Board of Education and the Metropolitan Community College Foundation.

He has established professional memberships in many industry organizations and was a board member and/or past president of the National Association of Health Underwriters, the Omaha Chapter of the American Society of Charter Life Underwriters and the National Association of Health Underwriters.

Haney was recognized as an Honorary Alum of the Year for Roncalli High School and was named Jaybacker of the Year by the Creighton University Athletic Department, eventually being inducted into the Creighton Prep Hall of Fame. He is listed in *Who's Who in America* and *Who's Who of American Education*.

UNO has also presented Haney with the Order of the Tower, the university's highest non-academic award, along with the Hubert Locke Distinguished Service Award and the UNO Alumni Association Outstanding Service Award.
