University Honors Program

The University Honors Program is a University-wide program providing maximum educational opportunities for students of high ability through special multidisciplinary seminars and participation in an academic level not generally possible in usual curricular offerings.

The program is an outgrowth of the Arts and Sciences Honors program and was initiated in 1978. It is governed through the office of the Senior Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs and administered through the Honors Coordinator. UNO colleges which implement Honors Programs include Arts and Sciences; Business Administration; Education; Public Affairs and Community Service; Information Science and Technology; and Communication, Fine Arts and Media.

As part of their Honors Program requirements, students undertake a research project that results in a Senior Honors Thesis. Students who have been designated in this booklet as Honors Program students have fulfilled the academic requirements of this program. Honors Program graduates wear blue and scarlet Honors cords.

Phi Kappa Phi

Members of the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi, the nation's most selective all-discipline academic honor organization, shall be recognized by the navy blue and gold honor cords or stoles.

Omicron Delta Kappa

Active student members of the UNO Circle of Omicron Delta Kappa, the National Leadership Honor Society, shall be recognized by the blue, white and black honor cords, the official colors of the society.

Pi Gamma Mu

Blue and white cords with the blue tassels honor graduating members of Pi Gamma Mu, International Honor Society in Social Science.

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program. All doctoral degree recipients are indicated by a gold tassel.

Student Speaker

Kayla Childress, from Pierce, Neb., graduates today with a bachelor's degree in elementary education with a focus on library media. Her commencement address is titled "Stepping Out."

Childress has been a member of both the Nebraska Educational Media Association and the American Library Association. For a year, she served as vice president for the UNO chapter of ASCD (formerly the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development), an educational leadership organization. During that time, the chapter was able to help an area elementary school that had experienced a fire and needed to rebuild its library. Childress and others organized a UNO book drive for the school.

At UNO she has also received both the University Honors and Lena Hosman Neafus scholarships and has been on the Chancellor's List for her academic performance.

Outside of the classroom, Childress describes herself as a roller coaster junkie. A good day for her involves "falling 300 feet or twirling upside-down repeatedly."

After graduation, she hopes to get a teaching or library media position in the metropolitan area, and then begin work on a master's degree.

Alumni Achievement Award

Robert Batt

An Omaha native, Robert Batt is executive vice president of Nebraska Furniture Mart (NFM). He has been an integral part of the story behind one of America's most successful businesses for nearly 50 years while also supporting the Omaha community through his civic contributions.

Batt is the grandson of Rose Blumkin, who founded Nebraska Furniture Mart in 1937. He began working at the company at 14. He graduated from Omaha Central High School in 1966 then attended UNO. He received his bachelor of science degree in business in 1976. His mother, Frances Batt, attended then-Omaha University in the mid-1930s.

Batt has been active in civic and community organizations at the local, state and national levels. He currently serves on the three-member Nebraska Liquor Commission (representing the 2nd Congressional District), which regulates liquor licenses and collects alcohol taxes. He also is a member of the Sarpy County Sports Commission and the Salvation Army Advisory Board.

Previously, Batt served on the State Comprehensive Capital Facilities Planning Committee, which reviews building projects requested in the state budget. He also served as chairman of the Omaha Personnel Board from 1998 to 2003. His service has extended beyond Nebraska, too. After fires in 1988 ravaged Yellowstone National Park, Batt served as a charter member for the U.S. Concert Committee for Yellowstone to help raise money to restore the park.

He has also maintained involvement with UNO. Recently, Batt assisted with the collaboration on a joint project between NFM's Information Technology Department and UNO's College of Information Science & Technology. The partnership helped develop and build NFM's information technology platform. Batt also has served as an honorary UNO Hockey Coach.

In January 2010, Batt was presented as an Omaha Press Club "Face on the Barroom Floor," an honor bestowed upon Omaha newsmakers since 1971. In his spare time Batt spends time and travels with his wife, Janice, and daughter Sara.

Chancellor's Medal Recipient

James W. Freeman

James W. Freeman joined the University of Nebraska at Omaha in 2003 as the interim director of Multicultural Affairs. He became the department's permanent director in 2005. Freeman, however, has a long history with the university.

The College of Education's Dr. Floyd Waterman recruited Freeman to what was then Omaha University in 1966. Freeman had earlier earned a bachelor's degree in education from Tuskegee Institute in Alabama, where he was also active in the civil rights movement. In Omaha, Freeman became part of the first National Teacher Corps, a federal program that trained teachers for service in

the inner city. Freeman received his Master of Science in Education from Omaha U., during its final year of existence, in 1968. He went on to earn his Administrative endorsement from UNO in 1970.

After earning his master's degree, the Omaha Public Schools hired Freeman. During his 38-year career in the school district he served as a teacher, assistant principal, principal and director of Recruitment. Red-Book Magazine on two occasions recognized Fontenelle Elementary (one of the schools where he served as principal) as being one of the best schools in the nation and the best in Nebraska.

Freeman's passion for working with young people and helping them maximize their opportunities has been key to his work at UNO, where he focuses on the recruitment and retention of under represented students. He works in collaboration with faculty, staff and the greater Omaha community to provide students with the necessary knowledge and skills to be successful. His daily work involves counseling, encouraging, mentoring and convincing students to do their best and to aim for more.

In the community, he is a sought after public speaker, mentor, advisor and volunteer. He currently sits on the boards of both the metropolitan area YMCA and the Urban League of Nebraska. He has received several awards for his work and service, including the Norbert & Charlene Schuerman Outstanding Principal Award, the 1st Annual Charles B. Washington Educators Award, the Nebraska State PTA Advocacy Award, the Community Outreach Award-National Council of Negro Women, the Lifetime Service Award-Metro Community College, the Whitney M. Young, Jr. Memorial Award "For Promoting Racial Harmony", the Distinguished Alumni Award-UNO College of Education and the African American Leadership Award.
