ACADEMIC REGALIA

University Honors Program

The University Honors Program is a University-wide program providing maximum educational opportunities for students of high ability through special multidisciplinary seminars and participation in an academic level not generally possible in usual curricular offerings.

The program is an outgrowth of the Arts and Sciences Honors program and was initiated in 1978. It is governed through the office of the Senior Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs and administered through the Honors Coordinator. UNO colleges which implement Honors Programs include Arts and Sciences; Business Administration; Education; Public Affairs and Community Service; Information Science and Technology; and Communication, Fine Arts and Media.

As part of their Honors Program requirements, students undertake a research project that results in a Senior Honors Thesis. Students who have been designated in this booklet as Honors Program students have fulfilled the academic requirements of this program. Honors Program graduates wear blue and scarlet Honors cords.

Phi Kappa Phi

Members of the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi, the nation's most selective all-discipline academic honor organization, shall be recognized by the navy blue and gold honor cords or stoles.

Omicron Delta Kappa

Active student members of the UNO Circle of Omicron Delta Kappa, the National Leadership Honor Society, shall be recognized by the blue, white and black honor cords, the official colors of the society.

Pi Gamma Mu

Blue and white cords with the blue tassels honor graduating members of Pi Gamma Mu, International Honor Society in Social Science.

History of Hood and Robe

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program. All doctoral degree recipients are indicated by a gold tassel.

At times, Michael Crabb seemed to be everywhere at UNO... and for UNO. He served as the university's student president/regent during 2010-11, which came with a host of meetings and obligations. He balanced those responsibilities with being an active member of his fraternity, serving as a Peter Kiewit Institute Diplomat, taking part in UNO's Emerging Leaders Program and performing on campus and in the community (and on YouTube) as a singer in "Head on Collision," an all-male acappella group.

Last month, Crabb received the Senior Vice Chancellor Leadership Award for his service to the university. He has also been honored with the College of Engineering Dean's Award and the 2010 Robert Bradford Newman Medal for Excellence in Architectural Acoustics.

Crabb, a Suzanne and Walter Scott Scholarship and Regent's Scholarship recipient, graduates today with a bachelor's degree in architectural engineering, with minors in both mathematics and economics. He has earned a nearly perfect grade point average.

This summer he will intern as an analyst for Tenaska Capital Management and then will return to UNO in the fall to pursue a master's degree in architectural engineering. He also plans to apply for a Rhodes Scholarship.

Michael Crabb

awarded the coveted Magnet designation from the American Nurses Credentialing Center, a distinction held by only 6.2 percent of all hospitals. In 2008 it was named by Modern Healthcare magazine as one of the Best Places to Work in Health Care. It also has been recognized as one of the Best Places to Work in Omaha (2003 and 2011).

English also is an international consultant to the Joint Commission Resources/Joint Commission International, a not-for-profit affiliate of the Joint Commission. A resource for health care organizations worldwide, the Joint Commission provides consulting services, educational services and publications to assist in improving quality and patient safety, and to help in meeting its accreditation standards. English served on the faculty for the 2007 Joint Commission International Practicum in Abu Dhabi and the 2008 Joint Commission International Practicum in Singapore. In 2009, English made international visits with the Joint Commission to South Korea, Qatar and Jordan.

Prior to joining Children's, English spent 15 years at Cook-Fort Worth Children's Medical Center in Fort Worth, Texas, where she held a number of nursing administrative positions, including director of nursing and assistant vice president for patient care. She earned a bachelor's degree in nursing and a degree in nursing administration from the University of Texas at Arlington.

English became a fellow in the American College of Healthcare Executives in 2009. She is a member of the American Nurses Association, the Nebraska Nurses Association, Sigma Theta Tau and the American College of Healthcare Executives. Her community involvement includes service on boards for the Center for Human Nutrition, March of Dimes and the Department of Health & Human Services Region 1 Trauma Advisory Board. She was honored by ICAN in 2003 as a woman "Powered by Dreams." In 2008 she was honored at the YWCA Omaha Tribute to Women as one of 10 women in the greater Omaha metropolitan area who have made significant contributions to the community. Midlands Business Journal named her the 2008 Woman of Distinction.

Kathy English

Kathy English earned an MBA from UNO in 1995. She has been Chief Operating Officer of Children's Hospital & Medical Center since 1993. She joined Children's in 1991 as vice president of patient care services. Children's is the only pediatric specialty center in Nebraska, providing treatment and therapies across a spectrum of pediatric specialty and subspecialty services.

During English's tenure Children's has grown dramatically, opening the current hospital structure in 2000 and adding a five-story, 135,000-square-foot Specialty Pediatric Center for outpatient services in 2010. In 2006 Children's was

Prior to becoming ambassador, Fulton was a partner at Williams & Connolly LLP where her practice included complex civil litigation, government investigations, and white-collar criminal defense. In 2004 she was named one of "Washington's Top Lawyers" by Washingtonian magazine.

She is a member of the bars of the District of Columbia and Virginia, the United States Supreme Court, the United States Courts of Appeals for the District of Columbia, the Fourth and Eleventh Circuits, and various United States District Courts. Fulton has handled many complicated matters involving civil, criminal and parallel proceedings in state courts, federal courts and agencies, and in foreign venues. She was an active member of the American Bar Association's Litigation, Criminal Justice and International Law sections. She served as co-chair of the Criminal Litigation Committee of the Litigation Section.

Fulton also has been active in community and nonprofit organizations. In January 2004 she was confirmed by the United States Senate to serve on the board of directors of the United States Institute of Peace and was co-chair of the USIP International Advisory Council. The USIP is an independent, nonpartisan, national institution established and funded by Congress. Fulton was nominated to the USIP board post by President George W. Bush. Fulton also has been active in Bright Beginnings, the Women's Advisory Board of the Girl Scouts of the National Capital area, the Georgetown University Law School Admissions Interview Program, and the South Dakota Farmers Union Foundation.

Prior to entering the field of law, Fulton worked in various positions on Capitol Hill. From 1982 to 1985 she was executive director of Peace Links, an organization dedicated to involving women to end the threat of nuclear war, engage in peace-building, and promote alternative means of resolving international conflicts. She served on the Peace Links board of directors from 1989 to 2000. The National Peace Foundation honored with its Pioneering Peace Builder Award in 2002.

Fulton also earned a JD from Georgetown University Law School.

Ambassador Laurie Fulton

Laurie Fulton earned a bachelor's degree from UNO in 1971, graduating magna cum laude. She was sworn in as U.S. Ambassador to Denmark on July 15, 2009, after being nominated to that post by President Barack Obama.

A native of Sioux Falls, S.D., Fulton has long-standing ties to Denmark. Her maternal grandfather immigrated to the United States from Denmark and served in the United States armed forces in Europe during World War I. Her great-grandfather served in the Danish parliament from 1918 until 1940. Through the years she has visited relatives who reside in Denmark and learned of Danish history and society.
