Data Definitions:
Total new students are new freshmen and new transfer students.
First-time Full-time Degree-seeking New Freshmen are the cohort students tracked for campus retention rates reporting.
Minority students include American Indian, African American, Asian American, Hispanics of Any Race, Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islanders, and Two or More Races.
First generation students are the students whose parents are not graduates of a 4-year institution.
Military students include military students and their dependents. Military students were not flagged out prior 2011 in the system, so could not report census data.
International students are the students with a nonresident alien visa.
Transfer students are the students who transfer from another institution to UNO.
Adult/Nontraditional students are the students whose age was 25 and over as of census time.
Non-resident (out of state) students are the students who are US resident from outside Nebraska. International students are excluded from this count.
