

# Institutional Need for an IR

### What is an IR?

- Collecting, preserving & disseminating scholarship
- Publish & showcase institutional scholarship
- Role of an IR
  - Manage open access to digital content produced by the university
  - Encourages knowledge sharing
  - Permits quick and easy dissemination of scholarship across institutions





### Gold Open Access

Gold or "pay" to publish Open Access

- Articles is made freely accessible online to anyone anywhere immediately upon publication
- Authors, their funders or institution pay an article publication charge for every article published
- Green Open Access
  - "Self-Archiving"
    - Depositing a **free** copy of a digital document on the internet in order to provide open access to it
    - Access without payment to a version of the publication via a repository, often after an embargo period.
