Administrative-site counts are the official campus data reported to the UN Board of Regents.

New students are new to UNO campus and they can be counted multiple times in the reported new students groups.

Minority includes African American, Asian, American Indian, Hispanic of Any Race, Native Hawaii or Pacific Islander, and Two or More Races.

First generation students are the students whose parents are not graduates of a 4-year institution.

Military-affiliated students include all active duty and veteran students and their dependents on campus.

Adult/Nontraditional students are the students whose age was 25 and above as of census time.

Out-of-state students are the students from outside NE. International students are not included in this count.

Students enrolled in mixed-delivery mode courses are those who enrolled in combination of online, partial online, on or off-campus courses.
