#### What is Title IX?

Title IX is not just about sports. It is a comprehensive federal law that prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex in any federally funded education program or activity.

- Prohibits sex discrimination in educational institutions that receive federal funding
- The ban includes sexual harassment, sexual assault, intimate partner violence and
- · Applies to students, facultuy, staff ot anyone present on a campus regardless of sexual orientation, immigration status, gender identity, or disability status
- Retaliation for reporting is prohibited by law and covered under Title IX

- · Meet with you privately on campus or at a place of your choice to make a report
- Assist you in receiving hospital, medical, counseling, and other support services even if
- you choose not to pursue criminal charges

  NOT prejudge you, and you will not be blamed for what occurred
- Treat you and your particular situation with courtesy, sensitivity, dignity, understanding, and professionalism
- Consider your situation, regardless of your gender identity and sexual orientation, and regardless of the gender identity and sexual orientation of the suspect(s)
