The University of Nebraska Omaha (UNO) accepts transfer credits from other post-secondary institutions. See the policies and procedures below to make sure your credits will transfer.

## Requirements for Transferring Credits

Before UNO can award a transfer credit, the following requirements must be met:

- Only courses with a grade of "C-" or better will be accepted for transfer from a regionally accredited two- and four-year college or university. (*The College of Business Administration requires a grade of "C" or better for transfer.*)
- All credit hours transferable are converted to semester credit hours (e.g., one-quarter hour equals 2/3 of a semester credit).
- Grades earned at another institution do not become a part of the student's UNO cumulative grade point average, unless earned at another University of Nebraska campus:
  - University of Nebraska Lincoln (UNL)
  - University of Nebraska Kearney (UNK)
  - University of Nebraska Medical Center (UNMC)
- A maximum of 64-66 semester credit hours may be transferred from a two-year/junior or community college.
