Transfer Credit Policies and Procedures



UNO accepts the following credit:

Transfer Credit from Post Secondary Institutions (Transfer Articulation Guide)

Advanced Placement (AP)

College Level Examination Program (CLEP)

International Baccalaureate (IB) Retroactive Credit

Military Credit

The University of Nebraska Omaha (UNO) accepts transfer credits from other post-secondary institutions. See the policies and procedures below to make sure your credits will transfer.

Requirements for Transferring Credits

Before UNO can award a transfer credit, the following requirements must be met:

- Only courses with a grade of "C-" or better will be accepted for transfer from a regionally accredited two- and four-year college or university. (The College of Business Administration requires a grade of "C" or better for transfer.)
- All credit hours transferable are converted to semester credit hours (e.g., one-quarter) hour equals 2/3 of a semester credit).
- Grades earned at another institution do not become a part of the student's UNO cumulative grade point average, unless earned at another University of Nebraska
- University of Nebraska Lincoln (UNL)
- University of Nebraska Kearney (UNK)
- University of Nebraska Medical Center (UNMC)
- A maximum of 64-66 semester credit hours may be transferred from a two-year/junior or community college.
