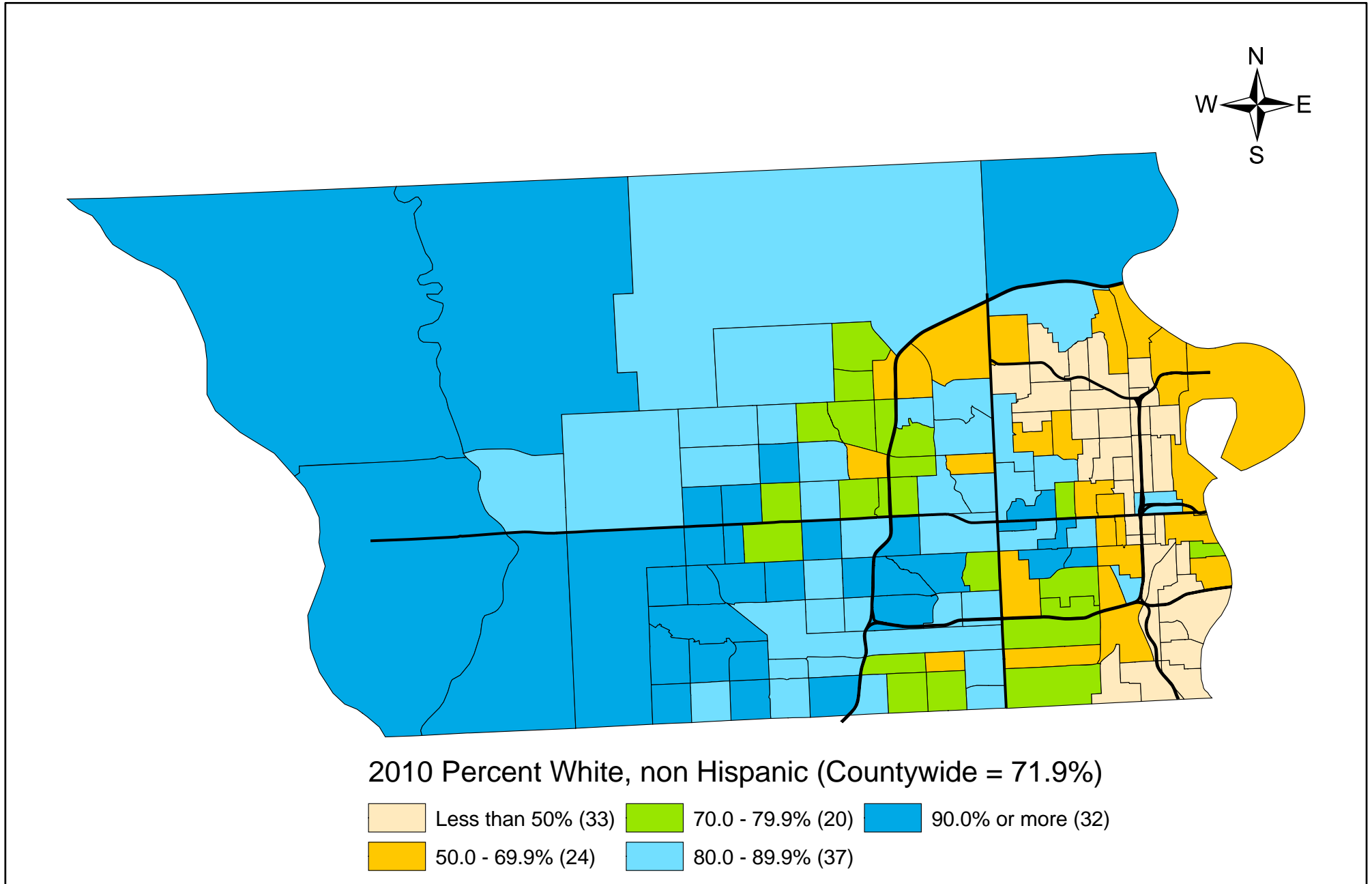

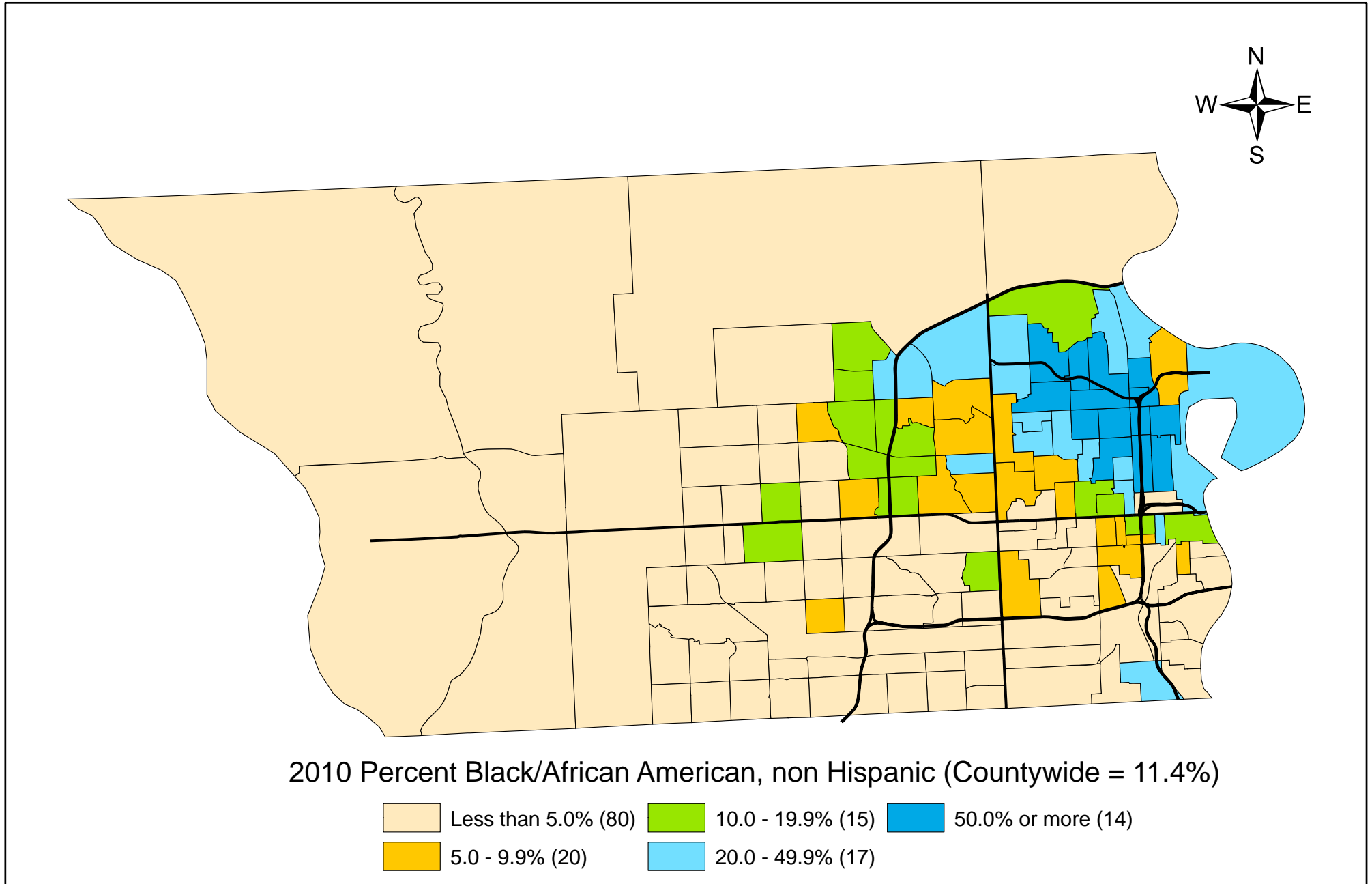
# Percentage of 2010 Population that is White, non Hispanic: Douglas County, NE

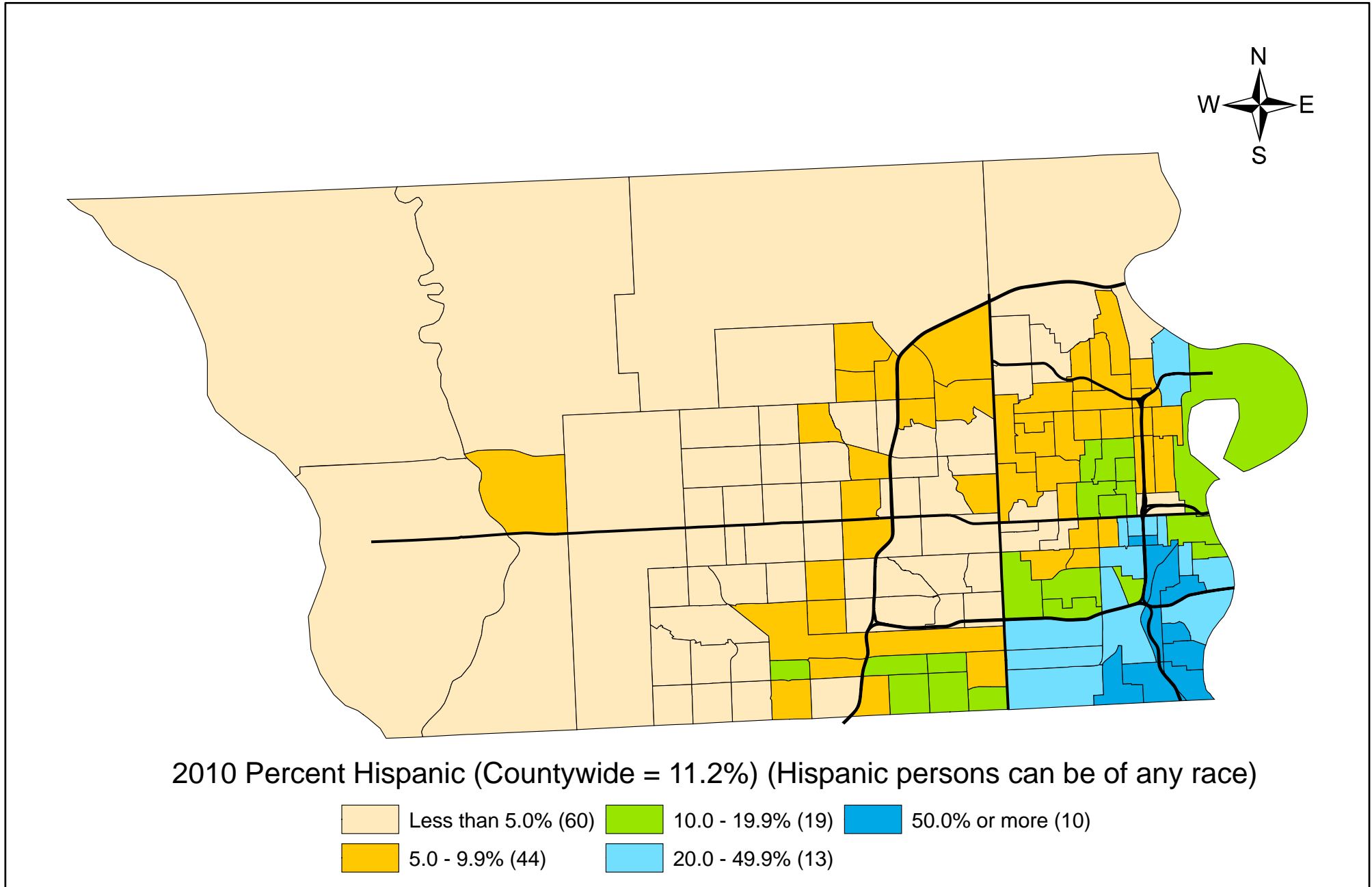
# Percentage of 2010 Population that is Black, non Hispanic: Douglas County, NE

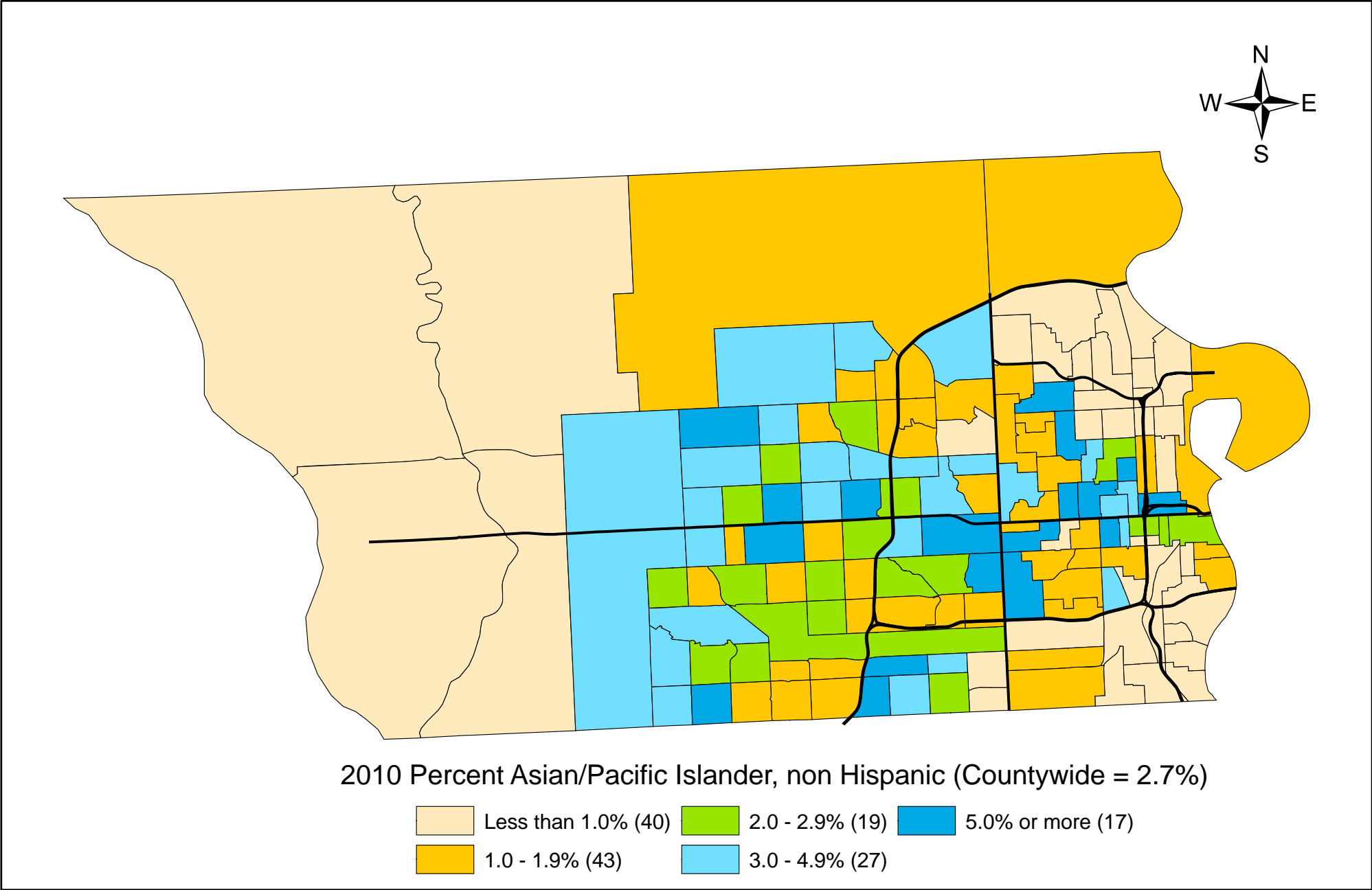
# Percentage of 2010 Population that is Hispanic: Douglas County, NE
