Survey Highlights

Table 1

Less than 1/3 correctly said there were 3 campuses
About 1/3 thought there was only 1 campus
About 40% thought of 2 campuses

Less than 1/2 thought of UNMC as part of UN while UNL and UNO
recognition was high

Eighty-three percent thought multiple offerings on different campuses
were appropriate
Seventy-one percent thought comprehensive offerings should be continued
Almost 2/3 favored open door admissions policy

Of those that did not feel all campuses should have the same admissions
policy, 75% thought that UNMC should be more restrictive

UNMC had the highest overall ratings for teaching, service, and research
quality

Table 5

About 90% thought that a lot of emphasis should be placed on teaching
on each campus

Over 1/2 felt that research and service should also receive a lot of
emphasis at UNL and UNO

A even greater proportion of respondents thought UNMC should place a
lot of emphasis on research and service than was the case for UNL or
UNO

A slightly greater proportion of respondents (62%) thought UNL should
place a lot of emphasis on research than was the case for UNO (52%)

About 20% thought UNL was getting more than its fair share of the budget while only 3% thought UNO was getting more than its fair share and only 8% thought the entire UN system was getting more than its fair share of the state budget

Table 7

Rating scores show that respondents have the most confidence that the university is meeting the educational needs of Nebraska residents and providing high quality educational programs.

Respondents had somewhat less confidence that the university was making the best possible use of the university budget and still less that it is operating as one university with three campuses rather than as three separate universities.
