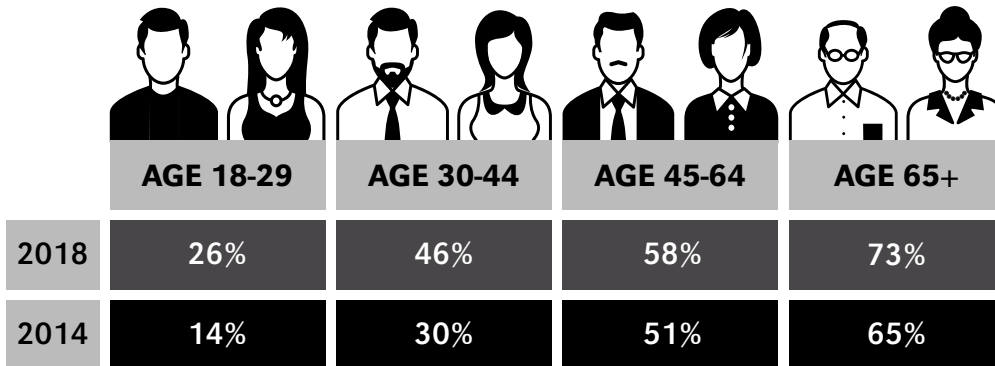

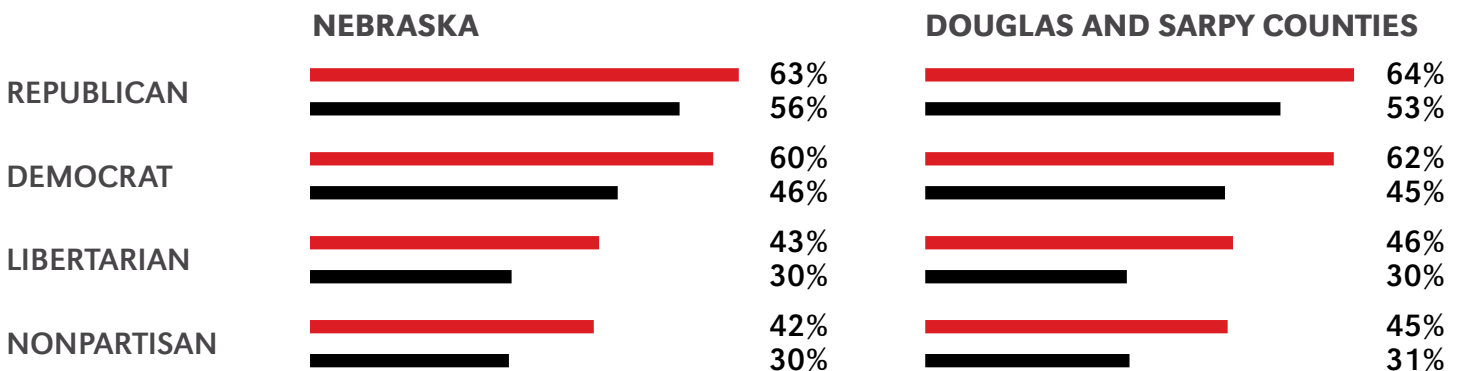
In all age groups, turnout of eligible voters was up from 2014, especially among younger age groups

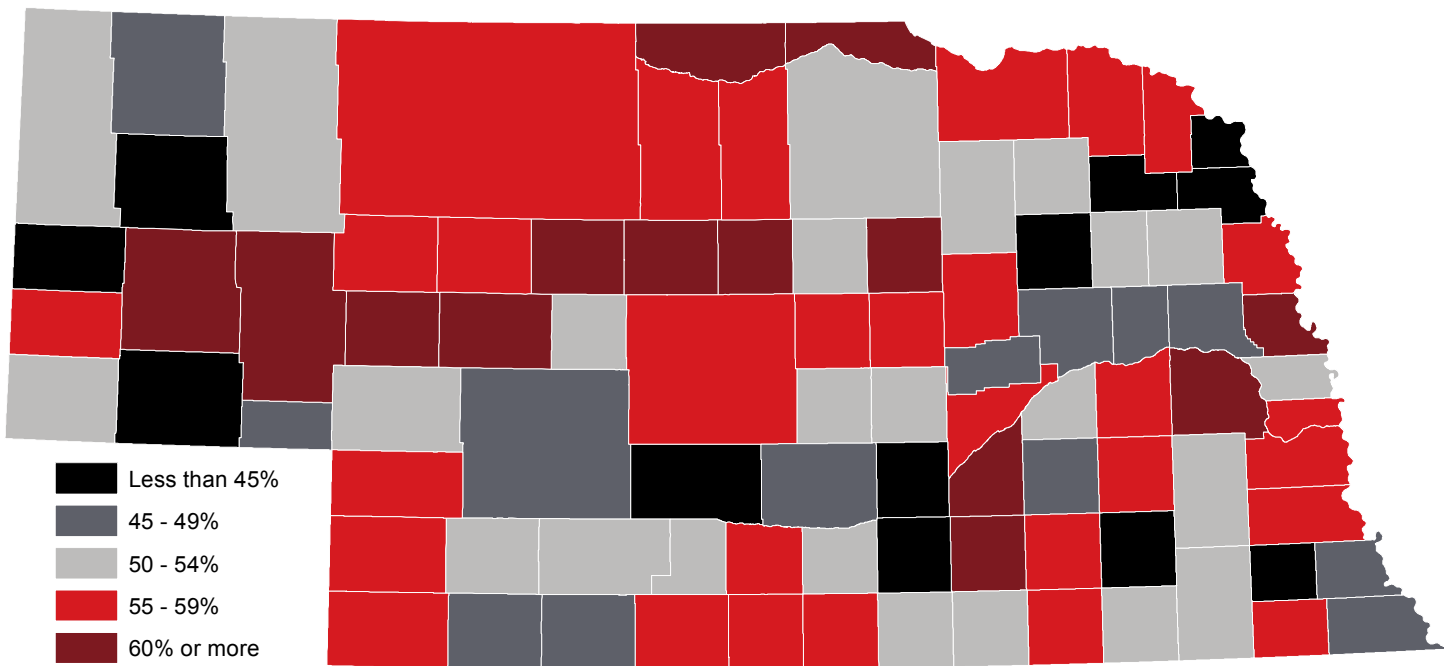
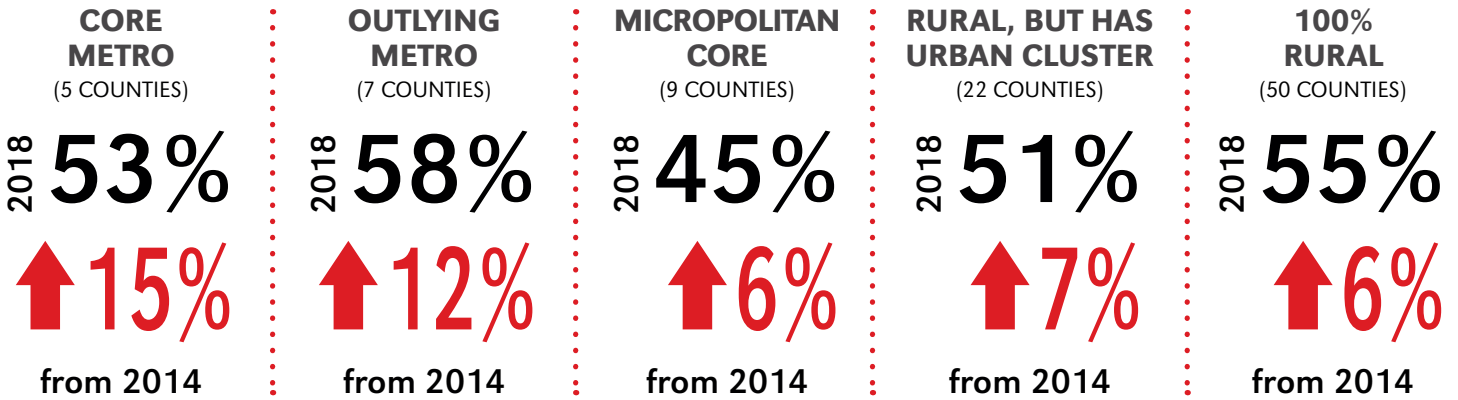
