This is a review of the short film, *Life* (2021), directed by Mohammad Mohammadian.

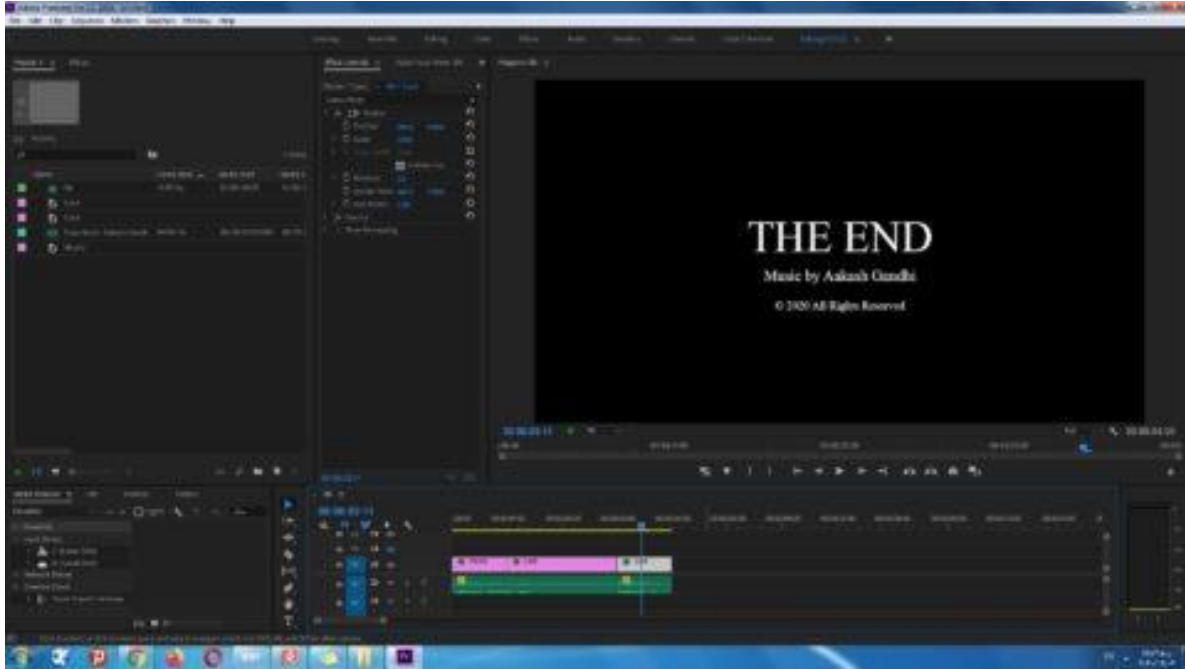
