

NEBRASKA HISPANIC/LATINO POPULATION BY COUNTY

OLLAS OBSERVATIONS

In 1990, the Nebraska population of 1.58 million included 36,969 Latinos. Making up only 2% of the state population, Latinos comprised in very few counties a visible share of their local populations. The map below shows the share of Hispanic/Latino population per county and highlights the top 10 counties with largest number of Latino residents.

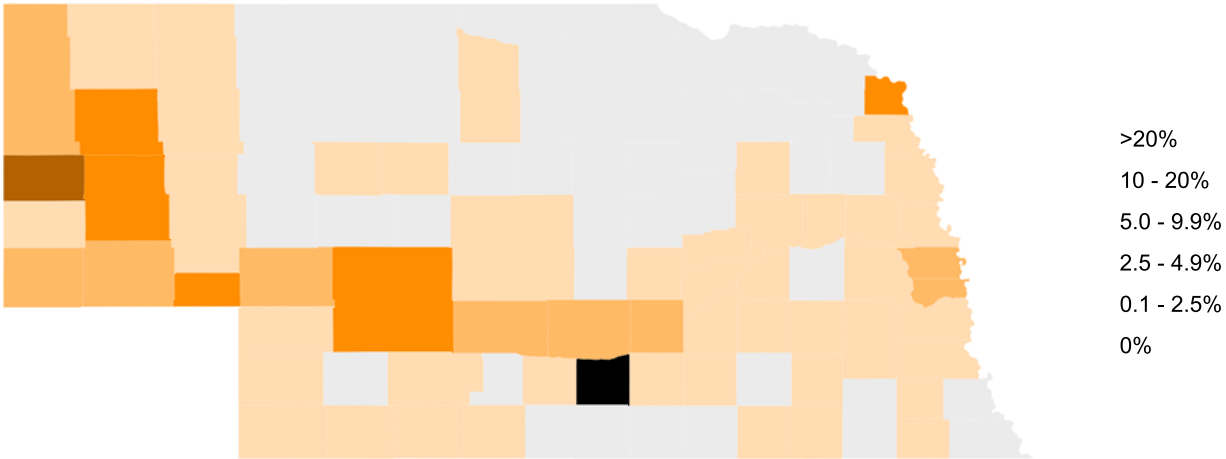
